at a lower altitude, a grayish white mass that had no fire to it whatsoever and it looked

at the time that it was coming at a slow speed but as it came across directly under the quarter

moon but at much lower altitude I could see it and just crystal clear it was a grayish

mass like with no glow, no fire to it but then I realized it was traveling at a high

It looked like a massive amount of land or a body of you know a planet or something that

I was in the Air Force for about eight years as a radar operator and I've seen lots of aircraft.
