It hovered over our about, I would judge it from the landscape here somewhere over Talley Lake.

And I wondered if you wanted an idea of what I saw through my scope.

8

Any interest to you?

9

00:00:37,000 --> 00:00:39,000

What did this thing look like?

10

00:00:39,000 --> 00:00:41,000

It was a severe.

11

00:00:41,000 --> 00:00:46,000

Rather like to be translucent.

12

00:00:46,000 --> 00:00:51,000

With some little lights in the severe itself,

13

00:00:51,000 --> 00:00:55,000

with a sparkle something like you'd see in a Christmas tree light.

14

00:00:55,000 --> 00:00:56,000

Oh yes.

15

00:00:56,000 --> 00:01:02,000

And at the time it was when it would stay stationary,

16

00:01:02,000 --> 00:01:10,000

it would have a halo which was exactly like the fluorescent light, the circular fluorescent light.

17

00:01:10,000 --> 00:01:14,000

And as it rose or descended, as it rose especially,

18

00:01:14,000 --> 00:01:22,000

this tubular light around the, when it was stationary, right on the diameter of the severe.

19

I see.

20

00:01:23,000 --> 00:01:29,000

And as it rose, the circular light, the tubular looking light,

21

00:01:29,000 --> 00:01:34,000

went one down to the bottom of the severe.

22

00:01:34,000 --> 00:01:39,000

And when it disappeared from sight which appears like it was moving horizontally away from us,

23

00:01:39,000 --> 00:01:40,000

it disappeared.

24

00:01:40,000 --> 00:01:46,000

About the light that contract and disappears and hits the bottom of the severe.

Okay.

26

00:01:47,000 --> 00:01:49,000

Now what color was this?

27

What color did it maintain during this observation?

28

Well, when it was in horizontal position was the tubular light around the diameter.

29

And the severe was, I say, it was just an outline.

30

It was rather almost translucent as if there wasn't as much reflection coming off.

31

00:02:09,000 --> 00:02:11,000

It did whatever else is on it.

32

00:02:11,000 --> 00:02:12,000

Yes.

33

00:02:12,000 --> 00:02:16,000

It was brilliant.

34

00:02:16,000 --> 00:02:19,000

And then, it was at the diameter of the severe.

35

But as it rose on the horizon, the light kept getting dimmer and dimmer.

36

Okay.

37

00:02:32,000 --> 00:02:33,000

Which direction were you looking?

38

00:02:33,000 --> 00:02:40,000

I would say that this band of light around the diameter of the brilliance would be about

39

one-twentieth the diameter of the severe that I observed.

40

00:02:43,000 --> 00:02:44,000

Okay.

41

00:02:44,000 --> 00:02:46,000

And which direction were you looking?

42

00:02:46,000 --> 00:02:51,000

I was looking due west, approximately due west.

43

00:02:51,000 --> 00:02:52,000

Okay.

44

00:02:52,000 --> 00:02:55,000

Now, and this object came up from the horizon?

45

00:02:55,000 --> 00:03:01,000

When I first noticed it, it was in the horizontal position just above the horizon.

46

00:03:01,000 --> 00:03:05,000

We're down in Little Valley and we had mountains out there about 5,000 feet.

47

00:03:05,000 --> 00:03:06,000

Yes.

48

00:03:06,000 --> 00:03:10,000

It was somewhere 5,000, 6,000 feet, where it was 3,000.

49

00:03:10,000 --> 00:03:11,000

Okay.

50

00:03:12,000 --> 00:03:16,000

And it disappeared going vertically straight up?

51

00:03:16,000 --> 00:03:17,000

No.

52

00:03:17,000 --> 00:03:21,000

In, well, I would say it's been inclined rising.

53

00:03:21,000 --> 00:03:28,000

But because of the getting smaller, as this band of light receded to the bottom of the

54

severe, everything kept getting smaller.

55

00:03:30,000 --> 00:03:34,000

So, the movement was rising as it was going away.

56

00:03:34,000 --> 00:03:35,000

Okay.

57

00:03:35,000 --> 00:03:38,000

But it was, it was 9.15 last night.

58

00:03:39,000 --> 00:03:42,000

And it was at least 10 minutes and it could be 15 minutes.

59

00:03:42,000 --> 00:03:47,000

It seemed to be hovered over what I, you know, just guessing on what's the diameter

60

and so forth.

61

00:03:48,000 --> 00:03:52,000

The tally like Montana, which is rather, is right out there in the flathead forest.

62

Right.

63

In a rather isolated area.

64

Okay.

65

00:03:57,000 --> 00:04:01,000

Now, if you were using a ordinary one-foot ruler and holding it at arm's length out there,

what would you estimate the diameter of that thing was?

67

Well, I thought about that in relation to, let's say, the size of my scope and so forth.

68

It was not less than 100 feet, I would say.

69

00:04:16,000 --> 00:04:19,000

Now, you have to get the distance on that, of course.

70

Right.

71

Now, where is it so far?

72

00:04:22,000 --> 00:04:23,000

Right.

73

00:04:23,000 --> 00:04:28,000

I'm, I worked for the U.S. government for 31 years and civil engineer.

74

I tried to think about this after I'd seen it.

75

I called the sheriff's office by his name.

Yes.

I just called him and there was no other sighting of it, and I thought I'd called him.

a mile off of one of the main logging roads here, where one of the trunks logs in from

Yes.

And, you know, we are in the mountains, but I couldn't say no, I didn't hear anything.

Did your wife see this too?

87

Yes, she was the one that noticed it.

88

In fact, tell you the truth, I was sleeping on the fireplace.

She woke me up because of this brilliant light that was just above the horizon as we looked

west over our mountains.

There were no other stars in the sky.

92

Okay.

93

You had a cloudy condition then?

94

Yes.

Okay.

Did this thing, did the light from this thing illuminate the clouds at all?

97

Well, to some extent, there was around the whole thing, there was a halo or an aura.

98

Yes.

00:05:42,000 --> 00:05:47,000

But still the distinction of the, the clear light object was quite distinct.

There was a depth and outline where it ended.

101

Okay.

As far as the little lights that you, that seemed to be scattered around the severe were,

103

they could be glanced from metallic, the reflection from metallic objects.

Okay.

You feel that the main light source on that was the tube rotating around it or was it

106

around the horizontal?

107

I could see it was rotating, but it looked as, it was exactly as if it was one of these

108

00:06:15,000 --> 00:06:17,000

circular fluorescent lights.

Right.

110

00:06:18,000 --> 00:06:19,000

Okay.

111

00:06:19,000 --> 00:06:24,000

And I'd say about one-twentieth the diameter of the outline of the figure whatever it was.

112

Okay.

113

00:06:25,000 --> 00:06:28,000

One, yeah, about one-twentieth I think it could be, right?

114

00:06:28,000 --> 00:06:30,000

That's it, it's brilliant, brilliant.

115

So when it was at the center on the diameter.

116

Okay.

117

00:06:35,000 --> 00:06:36,000

And it was horizontal.

118

00:06:36,000 --> 00:06:39,000

It was around, horizontal at that time.

119

And all that remained that way.

120

Okay.

121

00:06:43,000 --> 00:06:47,000

Well, sir, we sure appreciate this report and we'll get on it right away and if we come

up with any additional information on this, why I would get back to you and let you know.
