Is this a person or a recording?

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00:00:04,000 --> 00:00:07,000

No ma'am, this is a human person.

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00:00:07,000 --> 00:00:12,000

Okay, I just called the weather bureau and got a recording and I freaked out here.

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00:00:12,000 --> 00:00:15,000

I'm calling from Little Rock, Arkansas.

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00:00:15,000 --> 00:00:16,000

Yes.

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00:00:16,000 --> 00:00:22,000

And talk to the FAA this evening and they gave me your address and phone number there.

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00:00:22,000 --> 00:00:28,000

I saw a couple of UFOs about a week ago, a little over a week ago.

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00:00:28,000 --> 00:00:32,000

It was Tuesday, March 22nd.

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00:00:32,000 --> 00:00:42,000

And I have been sitting here for about four hours trying to trace down somebody else who saw it.

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00:00:42,000 --> 00:00:47,000

And so far I didn't get any confirmation except the other person was in the car with me.

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00:00:47,000 --> 00:00:51,000

But would you like to hear what I saw?

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00:00:51,000 --> 00:00:55,000

I'd like to get a complete rundown starting right from the beginning.

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00:00:55,000 --> 00:00:56,000

Okay.

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00:00:56,000 --> 00:01:00,000

This was on March 22nd.

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00:01:00,000 --> 00:01:10,000

And it was in the evening around, well I guess probably around 8 o'clock, federal standard time.

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00:01:10,000 --> 00:01:18,000

I was in with a friend going from Crossett, Arkansas.

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00:01:18,000 --> 00:01:22,000

We have a map that's in the southeast part of the state.

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00:01:22,000 --> 00:01:23,000

Okay.

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00:01:23,000 --> 00:01:35,000

And we were going on highway 82 toward Lake Village, which is just a little, a couple miles,

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00:01:35,000 --> 00:01:46,000

about four miles to the north and about 20 miles, no it's longer than that, about 12, 8, 14, 20.

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00:01:46,000 --> 00:01:50,000

Oh, about 30 miles to the east, something like that.

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00:01:50,000 --> 00:01:58,000

And it was really clear that night there was a crescent to the west behind us.

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00:01:58,000 --> 00:02:06,000

And there are only just little small towns in that whole area of the state.

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00:02:06,000 --> 00:02:15,000

And so it's very clear in Little Rock you can't see the Milky Way anymore because of the street lights and everything.

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00:02:15,000 --> 00:02:18,000

But there you can see the Milky Way.

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00:02:18,000 --> 00:02:23,000

And I was real, you know, and everything was just more stars than I'd seen in a long time.

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00:02:23,000 --> 00:02:25,000

So I was really looking at stars.

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00:02:25,000 --> 00:02:39,000

And I saw this one star that I thought looked sort of funny and I thought, well, it must be an airplane because it was changing color like red to green and back again, you know, just kept changing red, green, green, red or whatever.

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00:02:39,000 --> 00:02:40,000

Right.

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00:02:40,000 --> 00:02:42,000

And it was pulsating.

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00:02:42,000 --> 00:02:45,000

Not blinking, just pulsating.

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00:02:45,000 --> 00:02:48,000

And I said, okay, Brenda, do you see what I see?

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00:02:48,000 --> 00:02:50,000

And she says, yeah, that shows the funny looking light.

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00:02:50,000 --> 00:02:54,000

And I said, now, if that's an airplane, it's got to be moving.

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00:02:54,000 --> 00:02:57,000

So we watched it for a few minutes and I said, that has to move.

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00:02:57,000 --> 00:02:59,000

That's, you know, not an airplane.

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00:02:59,000 --> 00:03:02,000

And she says, you're right, that's not an airplane.

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00:03:02,000 --> 00:03:05,000

And I said, well, have you ever seen a star do something like that?

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00:03:05,000 --> 00:03:07,000

No, never seen a star do something like that.

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00:03:07,000 --> 00:03:11,000

So when we were going through in that area is tiny woods.

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00:03:11,000 --> 00:03:14,000

So we lose sight of it from time to time.

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00:03:14,000 --> 00:03:23,000

We got to Montrose, which is about two thirds of the way toward Lake Village.

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00:03:23,000 --> 00:03:29,000

The road goes very straight and there's nothing in there but fields, open fields.

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00:03:29,000 --> 00:03:40,000

And so we kept it in steady sight for, oh, I don't know,

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00:03:40,000 --> 00:03:46,000

but altogether maybe a good 20 minutes, probably longer than that.

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00:03:46,000 --> 00:03:51,000

But clear uninterrupted vision, at least a good 15 minutes, I think.

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00:03:51,000 --> 00:03:55,000

And we got to a point where we've gone back and actually measured it

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00:03:55,000 --> 00:04:03,000

and it was two and a half miles outside the city of the town of Lake Village

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00:04:03,000 --> 00:04:08,000

because you could see the lights of Lake Village on the horizon.

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00:04:08,000 --> 00:04:15,000

And going past the, honestly, corner of my eye, I was sitting in the passenger side.

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00:04:15,000 --> 00:04:20,000

I saw something glowing and I looked, glanced at you how you do a double take.

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00:04:20,000 --> 00:04:23,000

And I looked back and I said, oh my God, Brenda, do you see what I see?

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00:04:23,000 --> 00:04:29,000

And it was a yellow, a round yellow light.

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00:04:29,000 --> 00:04:32,000

And I had the feeling of a globe or a sphere.

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00:04:32,000 --> 00:04:37,000

It looked like, it didn't look like a flat, it looked like it had depth to it.

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00:04:37,000 --> 00:04:41,000

And there were no rays and no halo.

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00:04:41,000 --> 00:04:45,000

And so since then I've been lucky to see something that looked like it.

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00:04:45,000 --> 00:04:48,000

And the clearest thing I could see that was, you know, close to things to it

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00:04:48,000 --> 00:04:54,000

would be like a frosted lamp, you know, that we have a globe-shaped lamp

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00:04:54,000 --> 00:04:58,000

that's frosted, not transparent, but translucent.

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00:04:58,000 --> 00:05:00,000

And a yellow light inside it.

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00:05:00,000 --> 00:05:03,000

And the whole thing was just the same color, yellow.

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00:05:03,000 --> 00:05:09,000

Bright, bright and tense, about the same intensity as a headlight, but no rays and no halo.

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00:05:09,000 --> 00:05:18,000

So it moved, it seemed to be hovering at about tree top level and moving slightly.

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00:05:18,000 --> 00:05:21,000

And we stopped the car just as quickly as we could.

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00:05:21,000 --> 00:05:24,000

And at the end of this field were some trees.

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00:05:24,000 --> 00:05:28,000

She's gone back and measured and she says where we stopped was a half mile,

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00:05:28,000 --> 00:05:33,000

or not quite a half mile, about a third of a mile from the trees.

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00:05:33,000 --> 00:05:35,000

They were at the end of the field.

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00:05:35,000 --> 00:05:36,000

Yes.

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00:05:36,000 --> 00:05:42,000

So the UFO or the yellow light was between us and the trees.

And it was hovering at tree top level and just barely moving.

We had to stop the car and get out to look and make sure that it was really moving.

But it really was.

We watched it long enough to be sure it was.

And we turned off the car motor so that we could hear an engine.

If there was any, you know, motor sound.

And there was.

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00:06:06,000 --> 00:06:10,000

It was the spookiest quiet I have ever seen or heard, I mean.

And, okay, when we first, we're reconstructing it, when we first sighted the yellow globe,

And we wanted to get a closer look.

And it was like, in the instance that we said that, it just zapped off.

It was like one second, you know, now it's there and now it's gone toward the horizon.

I mean, we could still see it, but it was just, God, I've never seen anything move so fast.

And it was at the horizon and it began to go toward the left, toward our left, you know.

And about that time I said, well, what's happened to the red and green thing?

You know, we had taken our eyes off of it and been watching this yellow thing.

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00:07:46,000 --> 00:07:50,000

So it looked back up, looked for it and it had moved.

And we watched it move across our line of vision.

It had been at about a 30 degree angle high and at about 11 o'clock.

And it moved over across our line of sight to about 12.30.

And the yellow one moved, you know, from a two o'clock to about that 12.30.

You know, first it moved away from us toward the horizon, the yellow one did.

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00:08:13,000 --> 00:08:16,000

And then it moved along the horizon and it began to blink out.

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00:08:16,000 --> 00:08:19,000

Like it would blink out and then on again and then out and then on.

And when it got directly underneath the red and green thing, it blinked out.

We didn't see any more.

And in the same instance that it blinked out, the red and green light lifted up and got smaller.

In other words, it appeared to go higher and further away.

We got in the car and we could still keep the red and green light inside.

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00:08:38,000 --> 00:08:46,000

It took us about five, no more than 10 minutes, but probably five minutes to get to where we were going in Lake Village.

And we could still see it in the sky, although it seemed to be somewhat higher and somewhat stanger than when we had seen it before.

And yet we seemed to be closer to it, somewhat closer to it.

It was like it was hanging at a little bit higher altitude over the Mississippi River maybe, which is about, the Mississippi from Lake Village is about 10 miles.

Lake Village is right on a horseshoe lake called Lake Chico that was left from when the Mississippi changed course.

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00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:28,000

It's about 15 miles or so from Greenville, looks like, something like that.

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00:09:28,000 --> 00:09:33,000

Anyway, we went inside and had to go to our meeting and so on.

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00:09:33,000 --> 00:09:35,000

And when we got back out, it was gone.

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00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:46,000

When we got back over to the cross that we called the Sheriff's Office, and I said, has anybody seen anything?

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00:09:46,000 --> 00:09:50,000

Reported seeing anything in the sky, and I said, well, I did.

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00:09:50,000 --> 00:09:52,000

And I told him about it.

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00:09:52,000 --> 00:10:01,000

And he said, well, there are a couple of state troopers monitoring you and they say that somebody over near Dermott saw something and reported something earlier tonight.

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00:10:01,000 --> 00:10:08,000

Well, Dermott is 15 miles, well, maybe a little longer than that, maybe 25.

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00:10:08,000 --> 00:10:10,000

I don't know, I can't tell on this map.

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00:10:10,000 --> 00:10:16,000

It's an area map, not a state map, but 15, 20 miles, something like that.

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00:10:16,000 --> 00:10:22,000

Do just about do north of where we were when we saw it.

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00:10:22,000 --> 00:10:32,000

Well, I haven't really had any chance to check up on this since then because I've been working in out of county and whatnot.

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00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:37,000

But this afternoon I've been making a whole lot of phone calls.

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00:10:37,000 --> 00:10:44,000

I'm still not set, but I still haven't gotten a hold of the guy that I talked to at the Chico County Sheriff's Office that told me that.

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00:10:44,000 --> 00:10:47,000

The guy that answered the phone when I called that night.

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00:10:47,000 --> 00:10:49,000

I'm going to try to get a hold of him again tonight.

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00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:55,000

I've got a sergeant in the state troopers trying to check this out and find out who is the state troopers on duty.

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00:10:55,000 --> 00:11:03,000

I've called radar facilities and the nearest radar facility is the Long Range at Texarkanna, which is about 180 miles away.

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00:11:03,000 --> 00:11:05,000

I don't think they could have seen anything.

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00:11:05,000 --> 00:11:13,000

I called the Fort Worth monitoring station and they said, even if we'd seen anything, we wouldn't have any record of it.

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00:11:13,000 --> 00:11:24,000

I've called a couple of radio stations and they, Arkansas Radio Network says, well, there was something reported the week before that,

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00:11:24,000 --> 00:11:31,000

but it was confirmed as a meteor and the Dermott police don't know anything about it and the Dermott newspaper doesn't know anything.

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00:11:31,000 --> 00:11:35,000

I'm really getting frustrated, you know, but I haven't given up yet.

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00:11:35,000 --> 00:11:37,000

We're going to track down somebody who saw that, you know.

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00:11:37,000 --> 00:11:44,000

But the two of us did see it and we kept, you know, saying, I think this is what I saw.

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00:11:44,000 --> 00:11:46,000

Did you see that? Yeah, that's what I saw, you know.

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00:11:46,000 --> 00:12:00,000

We think that the yellow line was probably about the size of a small vehicle because the tape that I cut that night,

I said if you could put your thumb up, you know, like you hold your arm out and you would put your thumb up,

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00:12:08,000 --> 00:12:16,000

your thumbnail could, you know, it would be about the size of that or the size of a coin held up against, you know, held at arm's length.

It was kind of like the moon, you know, only it was like down, you know, down a tree top, or the field, you know,

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00:12:27,000 --> 00:12:33,000

and moving off at these incredible speeds, you know.

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00:12:33,000 --> 00:12:41,000

And I, you know, I'm not sure exactly how far we were away, but it had to be less than a third of a mile.

Maybe a quarter mile.

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00:12:47,000 --> 00:12:52,000

We never did see anything that looked like, I mean, we couldn't see any outline of a craft or anything like that.

Just the round.

Okay, and getting back to the shape, you described that as being similar to the glass cover for a lamp.

We didn't see any. It's just fields there. You know, it's just fields and trees and, now she, Brenda said that when she, when she was driving back, whatever night it was this week, that she looked over in the direction that the yellow light came from to see if she could see anything.

Back over there. And it's the only thing that she could see with a little cluster of small lights,

which I, well, we still don't know what that is.

There are no roads back there. You know, it's just nothing but bayou and fields.

And we want to check that out a little bit more closely. But at this point, we sure can't say that we, you know, we can't, we just, there doesn't seem to be anything back there.

Okay. Would that be an area where they have livestock pasture?

Yeah, there could be livestock. It's pretty much agriculture though, not too much.

264

I mean, if somebody had a, had a, if somebody owned a lot of land there, they might have some cows and horses and stuff too, but it's mostly fields.

Okay. Do you have any estimate just how long you watch both of those objects?

267

00:21:55,000 --> 00:22:05,000

Yeah, I think we watched the red and green light for, had to be at least 15 minutes, maybe 20, maybe longer.

Somewhere outside of, okay, let's see. We can reconstruct this. Somewhere outside of CrossFit.

269

00:22:15,000 --> 00:22:28,000

I mean, outside of Hamburg, let's say now, you go out of CrossFit and Hamburg is about 15 miles away. And Montrose is about another 20 miles beyond that.

270

00:22:29,000 --> 00:22:36,000

So somewhere between Hamburg and Montrose is where we started, where we first spotted the red and green light.

271

00:22:36,000 --> 00:22:43,000

And we saw it on and off going around curves and through, through the piney woods there.

272

But from the time we hit Montrose on, we observed it without interruption. That would be at least a good 10, 15 minutes without interruption.

Okay.

The yellow light, I don't know, it happened so quickly. It's probably at least 30 seconds, maybe as long as two minutes.

275

I don't think it was any longer than two minutes. I really can't reconstruct it any closer than that. I've tried to and I just, I don't have that close to time.

Okay. Have you had anything strange happen to you since then?

No strange dreams about what you saw?

Usually there were two yellow lights in conjunction with the red and green ones.

319

Yes.

320

00:26:37,000 --> 00:26:51,000

And they moved in such a familiar pattern or such a repeated pattern that a lot of people could get to where they just watched that pattern, and they would see them fairly regularly.

321

And Brenda said she had seen at one time something that said, look in that direction and you'll see something, and she had seen something.

322

It was never that clear.

323

What we saw was just so, we saw it for so long and so clearly, and with the two of us verifying what we were seeing with each other, it makes us believe we're out of man.

324

You've got our number from the FAA in Little Rock.

325

Yeah.

326

00:27:18,000 --> 00:27:20,000

Would that be from the tower?

327
