Much smaller. Okay.

Oh yes, it's more like a star.

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00:02:32,760 --> 00:02:33,760

Uh-huh.

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00:02:33,760 --> 00:02:39,760

Well, in fact, anybody who's just walking out there and would see it now with the naked eye,

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00:02:39,760 --> 00:02:42,760

it would look almost like a star except for the flashing.

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00:02:42,760 --> 00:02:43,760

I see.

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00:02:43,760 --> 00:02:46,760

And there's only one of those out there?

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00:02:46,760 --> 00:02:51,760

Well, when they first started watching it, my husband and my kids saw it first.

They said it was moving along in the sky and then sort of backed up.

A little one.

Okay. What color are these little ones?

The color is the little one.

He said it's a little one sort of like the big one, only it's more green on it.

Now, what time did you first spot those?

Do these smaller objects, are they operating closer to the larger object?

Well, you see, that happened since I came in and before I went out, so I'll have to ask my daughter.

Okay.

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00:04:20,760 --> 00:04:25,760

Is that little one, is it pretty close to the big one or where is it then?

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00:04:25,760 --> 00:04:27,760

At the bottom.

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00:04:27,760 --> 00:04:30,760

She said it's lower to the ground.

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00:04:30,760 --> 00:04:32,760

Okay.

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00:04:32,760 --> 00:04:34,760

And where did you get our number?

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00:04:34,760 --> 00:04:35,760

From the police station.

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00:04:35,760 --> 00:04:37,760

Police, okay.

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00:04:37,760 --> 00:04:44,760

Okay, well we sure appreciate this report and we're going to check it out and if we come up with any information on this, we'll get back to you and let you know.
