The first one was sighted by a Riverside Sheriff's Officer down in Desert Hot Springs,

four or five miles from here.

6

00:00:29,000 --> 00:00:38,000

And the second sighting tonight was reported by a little over 250 people swapping the radio station with telephone calls

7

and the police department and the Sheriff's Office.

8

00:00:41,000 --> 00:00:44,000

All of them reporting basically the same thing.

9

00:00:44,000 --> 00:00:47,000

You know, dealing with basic same description.

10

The reason I have taken this assignment is because I saw the damn thing myself.

11

And it just blew me away.

12

00:00:54,000 --> 00:00:56,000

I mean, I've never seen one of these before.

13

I've been around in a class since I was five, six years old.

14

And I've been in the airplane in the Marine Corps.

15

And this thing was doing things that aerodynamically were impossible.

Okay, can you give us a description of what happened?

Yeah.

18

I'd say it was approximately 30 feet long.

19

It had three easily spaced lights.

20

Two really close greens.

21

00:01:26,000 --> 00:01:29,000

Another one is flashing.

22

00:01:29,000 --> 00:01:34,000

There was no sound emitting from it whatsoever.

23

00:01:34,000 --> 00:01:41,000

And no pilot is going to cut his engine at 600 feet above a pop and wait the city like this.

24

You know, and if he did drop like a rock anyway.

25

00:01:47,000 --> 00:01:50,000

There's no trouble up there, up drafts up here at all.

26

00:01:50,000 --> 00:01:52,000

No gliders can even get in here.

27

If he turned it off from the mountain above it's here, he'd just go right down the mountain.

28

There's nothing to carry him over.

29

That's why gliders don't even, you know, don't even work out out here.

I'm going to have to compare with the Palm Spring area.

Where are you at anyway?

32

Washington.

Washington, D.C.?

No, no, just Washington State.

I made about 60 calls and I tried to get information.

See if anybody else has cited this thing.

I called FAA Palmfield down here and Palm Springs Tower closed up at 10 o'clock.

So they couldn't get anything at all anyway.

Yes.

I called Monterey Force Base, which is a fact base on here, say where it's in Neymar County.

Jesus, LA Tower, Ontario Tower.

Nothing, you know.

43

00:02:37,000 --> 00:02:39,000

Nobody's seen anything.

44

Monterey Force Base only want to talk about it.

45

Which could mean anything.

I have to get out of here and say something.

47

What can I say?

250 of them had a minimal mess.

It's called in reporting this.

And the switchboard still went up like a beacon out there.

What time did that show up?

Well, the finding I saw was at 2250.

55

1050 this evening.

How long did it hang around?

57

Well, what I was watching, it was about 30 minutes.

58

I mean, I was driving along the highway.

59

And they stopped out here in front of my office.

60

Got out of the car.

61

It stood there with my mouth hanging down to my ankles.

62

Because this thing was flying right over us.

63

Okay?

64

No noise at all.

65

00:03:31,000 --> 00:03:33,000

Nothing.

66

I mean, even if a prop had cut his power,

67

he still didn't have props bent.

68

And he still didn't have some kind of emitting sound.

69

Anything was emitting nothing.

70

I mean, I could hear the wind blow out here.

71

No sound at all.

72

And like I say, people with great minds,

73

straight people and everything else have called in reporting this.

What's the estimate of size?

It's got the three lights on it and they're flying sideways.

81

You know?

And there's no fuselage set up like an airplane would have.

83

You know, it looks like a set of wings.

84

Well, and that's what first moved my mind.

And I've never experienced this before.

Well, of course what you described to me fits the Mark pattern of things that have been seen in the past.

Now, did you get any calls on the last sighting we had down here?

About two and a half weeks ago, reported by our Real Estate Sheriff's Officer in Desert Hodgspray.

We did one on March 22nd.

170

00:09:26,000 --> 00:09:28,000

Two of the objects came over.

171

00:09:28,000 --> 00:09:30,000

We've seen all three of them in California.

172

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:31,000

Yeah.

173

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:33,000

Yeah, we had a lot of calls on that.

174

00:09:33,000 --> 00:09:35,000

Okay, what was the design of that one?

175

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:37,000

Did anybody give you any kind of description of it?

176

00:09:37,000 --> 00:09:44,000

No. The only thing that the witnesses described was two bright, white lights moving in tandem.

177

They did not see a fuselage and there was no defined shape of any kind.

178

00:09:49,000 --> 00:09:54,000

So, this has been the same thing over the other two lights.

179

00:09:54,000 --> 00:09:58,000

Yeah, these were extremely bright, very brilliant.

180

That's something that I wish I had seen. I was asleep when they saw that crazy thing.

181

They saw the same thing up around St. Lockheedon Valley, around 5.30 that same morning.

182

Yeah, I know one of the Sheriff's officers had saw that I'm a law enforcement student right now.

I'm getting the hell out of this investigating reporting garbage.

I'm going into law enforcement so I get my degree.

So, when you were talking about ridicule and stuff like that for people reporting it,

You know?
