It was really rather unnerving to tell you the truth.

It was almost a crescent shape, half moon type shape.

And it seemed to be changing, well, it was completely perpendicular to the earth at the time we spotted it.

And then it seemed to be changing directions as though it was going in a vertical angle.

Yes.

And it kept going lower and lower as we were approaching it.

And we kept talking it up too while we were getting closer to the moon, thinking it was the lunar eclipse.

And by the time we approached Burlina, which is in Corralas, New Mexico, it's very northwest in the city.

It's a suburb of Albuquerque.

By the time we approached that, it seemed to have completely dissipated onto the horizon.

We couldn't see it anymore.

But we were very close to it because by the time we reached Rio Grande Boulevard, which is back to the middle of Northwest Valley,

it was very large.

But it was very low to the ground by the time too.

Did it maintain its same shape?

When it was almost present shape when we first spotted it, it started getting narrower and almost to the point of a quarter moon shape.

Okay, was this just all solid light?

Yes, solid light is all we saw from it.

That's what we kept thinking it was a moon.

Was it white?

Pardon me?

White light?

White light, glowing white light.

It gave a yellow cast. It appeared to be a gallerish moon.

Okay.

Did it maintain that color at all times?

It never changed that.

Did you watch this until it went out of sight?

We watched it until we couldn't see it anymore.

I'm not sure if it went out of sight at that point, but when we were at an angle, there were trees and what were covering it.

But it was that low by that time.

Okay, and you're sure you were facing west?

Oh yes, we were facing northwest is what it was.
