And it'd be west of Lake Kemp

north of the river. And it's, we've had reports on it

11

anywhere from all five to ten miles

12

you know, the other side of the lake. The gatekeeper reported it

13

oh, I'd say ten or twelve times

back last month and then the Grand Jury

foreman called in a little bit ago and he saw it on his way in

to lock up and the family was in the car and they called my attention

to it. They all seen it. And it was just

a wife called it an orange ball

which it was getting, it wasn't too far above the ground when I seen it already.

But I was called it an orange ball and it was

kind of, I didn't have a lot of time to look at it but it kind of looked like it might have been on fire.

Smoked behind my, I got 11 year old, he thought he'd seen something fall off it.

And so the reason I reported it, I thought it was

It seemed like it was just falling at the rate of something like an airplane

would fall off. That's why I reported it because I wasn't afraid to maybe something was down on the airplane.

I'm not much to believe in UFOs and all that. I just figured it was an airplane down.

Okay, what time did you see that? I believe it was about

It's a whole lot around it either because it's more concentrated in that one area.

I see. Okay. Was this coming straight down?

76

Yeah, I would say pretty much straight down. Okay. It kind of looked like it was on a

77

glide, you know. Uh-huh. And did that color change

78

at all in the time that you watched it? Just a minute.

Did the color

80

change during the time that you were observing it? No, I'd say it was.

It just looked like I don't be able to change much. Gary down my 11-year-old, he thought

that he'd smoke behind it. But I'd say it was just the fire color

falling from, or orange-y, falling all the way out. Okay.

How were the sky conditions that night? Clear, I believe.

Okay. The sky was...

Yeah, there were stars out. Because, you know, looking around, I mean, there just was no...

87

I've seen a lot of falling stars and all that. There's no...nothing like a star at all.

88

And of course, the star is pretty fast going down this thing. I mean, you had enough time to look at it.

Okay, did you hear any sound of any kind? No. Okay.

And how many witnesses saw that?

It was kind of an orange bloke, you know. Okay. And do you feel this was

154

quite far away? Oh, I'd say

155

It's up pretty high. What, too high? It seems to be too high, you know.
