And we had the police check it out, and they thought possibly it was a low-flying aircraft may have crashed, you know, because of the redness of the booster effect, I guess.

I have the gentleman that his name and the telephone number, and I just want to call him.

At approximately 8.35 p.m., my wife and son heard a whining noise going over the top

62

of our house, heading in the east-west direction.

63

Uh-huh.

And it was following a new expressway that we were having built across our area.

Now, my wife only heard the whining.

66

I was in the house and my son started hollering and calling for me.

I ran out approximately 300 feet down the driveway onto a main road where there are

I saw a ball of red fire with a tail, a trail, like a vapor trail and a jet, only red, like

Uh-huh.

Uh, it was heading due west.

Okay, I thought it could have been a booster or perhaps a plane in trouble, but my wife

And all I saw was a ball going forward.

My son said that it was right above the tree top and he saw it and I said, well, what kind

He said it wasn't an airplane, it was a ship.
