What type of maneuvers or motions did they make while they were up in the sky?

142

Well, they would, like, split from one patch and, you know, then go a little ways and start.

143

Were these movements quite fast?

144

00:07:34,000 --> 00:07:36,000

Yeah, real fast.

145

00:07:36,000 --> 00:07:37,000

Okay.

146

00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:45,000

Have you had any other reports like this?

147

00:07:45,000 --> 00:07:46,000

No, no, I haven't.

148

00:07:47,000 --> 00:07:48,000

Did you hear any sound?

149

No sound.

150

Nothing at all?

151

153

30 East.

30 East, okay.

And then you got to Paradise and you watched in there for a while and then...

I can't, I'm really bad at measurements.

Wow, the measurements aren't necessary, just to...

They wouldn't ever be that far apart.

184

195

Like a z between them?

In other words, you could see that, could you see the whole z at the same time or was it just a series of flashes?

198
