Uh, they say they observed the item with flashing lights, uh, going from red, blue, and white.

And, they're pretty sure it came down about two miles directly south of where they were

No, at first they thought maybe it was somebody out in the field and

Were most of these in the north, northeast, in the sky?

Uh, that's where I first saw them to the northeast and I went over to Armington

129

and talked to the city officer over there and while we were there we'd come up with

five or six of them, two of them to the north and rest of them all in the south.

Okay, the only reason I ask is because as the early morning, we get into the early

132

morning hours now we, uh, there's more and more of these, what is known as magnitude

133

one stars showing out in that area.

Uh-huh.

135

And of course the atmosphere causes these things to flash multiple colors.

136

Yeah, I was kind of wondering if that's what it was, but, uh, CB people up here just going nuts.

137

Yeah.

00:06:28,000 --> 00:06:31,000

Uh, when one call goes out, you know, then everybody looks.

139

We, um, we had, uh, I listened to the CB, I couldn't get any names or anything, but

140

there's a lot of people that claim the items came fairly close to them and they swear up

141

and down they work, stars, planets, airplanes or helicopters.

142

Okay, well we sure appreciate this report.

Well, if we come up with anything on it, we'll get back to you and let you know about it.
