Would you like to talk about it now?

Yes, I would like to very much.

7

00:00:14,000 --> 00:00:18,000

Okay, I guess I could start from where it all took place.

8

00:00:18,000 --> 00:00:23,000

I was out with a friend of mine, seven or 18.

9

00:00:23,000 --> 00:00:27,000

And we went out and we were going to have a concert,

10

00:00:27,000 --> 00:00:31,000

like a live concert recorded on the radio that night.

11

00:00:31,000 --> 00:00:35,000

So we went out and parked by the slums like we were listening to that and just talking.

12

Our stand-in made that count with the slums.

13

00:00:38,000 --> 00:00:43,000

And as we were sitting out there, we saw a light in the sky like a star is sitting there.

14

But it would lightly, but noticeably change color from a light to a green to a red,

15

but not exactly on that same order sometimes.

16

We just keep changing like that, rotating like it would be white turning to a green,

17

instead of white and a green.

18

And we went over on this third road down farther to see if we could get a better look at.

19

And we trowled down these third roads and all these turns.

20

We didn't know where we were going.

21

00:01:13,000 --> 00:01:15,000

We ended up in this field.

22

That's when we started building these new houses.

23

00:01:17,000 --> 00:01:21,000

And we went out, we got out, turned on the lights, went over.

24

00:01:21,000 --> 00:01:24,000

We stood at the corner of the slot and looked out at it through the trees.

25

And we noticed it was just sitting there.

26

And when we were closer to it, it looked like we could see the colors changing, the more vivid.

27

We figured it was just to start with a lot of atmosphere and find out or something.

But then we wondered how come it was only for about, oh, maybe a 30 area foot span, just like dust.

46

47

And then when we tried to follow that thing back, we took a bunch of different roads, like paved streets onto some dirt roads again.

52

You could brush it away with your hands when we had the lights on.

55

It would fall away to it.

57

But when we got out in it, it was like a static feeling, kind of like it was.

58

I don't know.

59

00:03:29,000 --> 00:03:31,000

We both had the chills.

60

00:03:31,000 --> 00:03:33,000

They just couldn't be as scary.

61

00:03:33,000 --> 00:03:38,000

When we got out, it was like, I don't know, like a light feeling.

62

00:03:38,000 --> 00:03:41,000

So not lightheaded.

63

00:03:41,000 --> 00:03:43,000

It would be hard to describe.

64

00:03:43,000 --> 00:03:47,000

My whole body weight felt like.

65

00:03:47,000 --> 00:03:52,000

And so we looked at it, and we figured, did it move or not?

66

00:03:52,000 --> 00:03:54,000

Did it go more north?

67

00:03:54,000 --> 00:03:58,000

And so we figured we'd go back and stand at the corner of the lot again.

68

00:03:58,000 --> 00:04:00,000

So we were looking at it through the trees.

69

00:04:00,000 --> 00:04:03,000

And this time, it wasn't even close to the trees.

70

00:04:03,000 --> 00:04:09,000

It was probably another 20 degrees higher than it was before, up in the air.

71

And so now that's when we figured it must not be as far as it was still just in there.

And this took place in about maybe a half hour.

Just like it came like a strobe light.

85

And it wasn't going real fast.

86

Like maybe 3 beats a second.

87

And then it just disappeared.

88

00:05:04,000 --> 00:05:05,000

And that was gone.

89

00:05:05,000 --> 00:05:08,000

So we stayed, watched it longer.

90

00:05:08,000 --> 00:05:10,000

And nothing happened.

91

00:05:10,000 --> 00:05:15,000

We would start to get forward, start to leave, see if we could catch it moving again.

92

And we'd just get interested again.

93

00:05:18,000 --> 00:05:20,000

And we'd turn around and go back.

94

00:05:20,000 --> 00:05:22,000

And the third time that we went back for it,

95

00:05:22,000 --> 00:05:26,000

we saw a big red cubicle light.

96

00:05:26,000 --> 00:05:29,000

It was oblong.

97

00:05:29,000 --> 00:05:33,000

It was long, square, with a pretty definite shape to it.

98

00:05:33,000 --> 00:05:35,000

And it was a really bright and tense red.

99

00:05:35,000 --> 00:05:38,000

Probably 300 yards.

100

00:05:38,000 --> 00:05:41,000

Just over a few in the hills.

101

00:05:41,000 --> 00:05:42,000

Just sitting there.

102

00:05:42,000 --> 00:05:45,000

And it started to go lower.

103

00:05:45,000 --> 00:05:49,000

And then go off toward left until it dropped behind the hill.

104

And we went over there.

105

00:05:51,000 --> 00:05:53,000

We took the roads up, as close as we could find.

106

And when we got out there, we would, we timed it every 7 seconds.

107

There would be a flash of white light.

108

And we could tell no distinct place it was coming from.

109

So we'd sit in our car and the light would flash every second.

110

And we'd look up at the little star again.

111

00:06:10,000 --> 00:06:12,000

And it would be the same place.

112

00:06:12,000 --> 00:06:15,000

Nothing changed for that.

113

00:06:15,000 --> 00:06:19,000

So we got out of the car and we could see if we could find out where the light was coming from.

114

And as we got out, it started going around the light with flash.

115

00:06:23,000 --> 00:06:27,000

Like it was, like it was almost even time with us.

116

00:06:27,000 --> 00:06:31,000

We got in the car and it would flash 5 seconds later.

117

00:06:31,000 --> 00:06:33,000

And then 7 seconds from that it flashed again.

118

00:06:33,000 --> 00:06:36,000

It started regular flash.

119

00:06:36,000 --> 00:06:38,000

So we had the radio turned off.

120

00:06:38,000 --> 00:06:41,000

I always thought about, like I've been read a lot about UFOs.

121

I heard about the thing.

122

00:06:43,000 --> 00:06:45,000

Messed up your reception.

123

00:06:45,000 --> 00:06:49,000

I wasn't even thinking about that, which we should have had the radio turned on.

124

But we did have the car going once.

125

00:06:52,000 --> 00:06:58,000

And the night before, I just had it tuned up and thinking how good it was running when we were sitting.

126

127

00:07:03,000 --> 00:07:07,000

Or a really bad noise, but like that.

128

It would be hard.

129

00:07:09,000 --> 00:07:11,000

It wasn't a hum.

130

00:07:11,000 --> 00:07:14,000

It was like vibrating, but the car wasn't vibrating.

131

00:07:14,000 --> 00:07:18,000

And it was kind of a low, not too low pitch noise.

132

00:07:18,000 --> 00:07:20,000

It wasn't a real high pitch.

133

00:07:20,000 --> 00:07:22,000

And I shut off my car.

134

00:07:22,000 --> 00:07:27,000

And it still did it for about 2 seconds after my car was turned on.

135

00:07:27,000 --> 00:07:30,000

And we got really scared then.

136

00:07:30,000 --> 00:07:35,000

We didn't know if we should stick around when we were hanging on to each other.

137

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:39,000

So we went out of the light again.

138

00:07:39,000 --> 00:07:41,000

And I think there was nothing we could do.

139

00:07:41,000 --> 00:07:42,000

We got out of there.

140

00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:43,000

So we left.

141

00:07:43,000 --> 00:07:48,000

And we just had that string, like, you know, airy feeling.

142

00:07:48,000 --> 00:07:50,000

Like we didn't know what was going on.

143

00:07:50,000 --> 00:07:52,000

And we got to the phone.

144

00:07:52,000 --> 00:07:53,000

I called my mom.

145

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:56,000

She said I'd be home later because we wanted to go back once more.

146

00:07:56,000 --> 00:08:01,000

So when we came back over the hills, took the dirt roads again.

147

00:08:01,000 --> 00:08:03,000

That was the very first time.

148

00:08:03,000 --> 00:08:07,000

And when we got over the hill, there was a white.

149

00:08:07,000 --> 00:08:08,000

It wasn't red.

150

00:08:08,000 --> 00:08:11,000

It was a bright white intense light.

151

00:08:11,000 --> 00:08:15,000

That was, it didn't have a definite oblong shape.

152

00:08:15,000 --> 00:08:17,000

But if you could tell, it was like a square.

153

00:08:17,000 --> 00:08:21,000

But it didn't have no definite really size to it.

154

00:08:21,000 --> 00:08:23,000

And it went straight up.

155

00:08:23,000 --> 00:08:24,000

And then it just was gone.

156

00:08:24,000 --> 00:08:27,000

I could move it up a little to the left.

157

00:08:27,000 --> 00:08:29,000

Just going straight up.

158

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:33,000

And there, like, we didn't see no trace of where it went or how it disappeared.

159

00:08:33,000 --> 00:08:35,000

Like it just wasn't there.

160

00:08:35,000 --> 00:08:39,000

And then we saw that bright, white flashing light again.

161

And it was a really high intense, like it seemed really close.

162

Like it was directed at us because when it would flash, we couldn't see anything else.

163

Except the flashing light.

164

00:08:50,000 --> 00:08:54,000

It was reflecting off the car enough to light up the inside of our car.

165

And then that disappeared.

166

00:08:56,000 --> 00:09:02,000

And suddenly as it came out, and we sat there for a while to see what would happen again.

167

And the star that we saw in the first place was still sitting up there.

168

And we took off, not knowing what to do, watching the star.

169

And that little bright intense strobe light again was up next to the little star up in the sky.

170

00:09:19,000 --> 00:09:22,000

We could barely see it blinking up there once again.

171

00:09:23,000 --> 00:09:25,000

And we went home.

172

00:09:25,000 --> 00:09:30,000

And as we went home, we drove through the city, what's in light.

173

00:09:30,000 --> 00:09:36,000

And we noticed that when we got to the stoplight, like there, they got pink lights out here as per street lights.

174

00:09:36,000 --> 00:09:41,000

That's the glare, and we cut out every star except for the ones we thought was the star.

175

00:09:41,000 --> 00:09:44,000

And that would be up higher than most of the other stars around.

176

00:09:44,000 --> 00:09:49,000

The lower stars, none of the stars would even show up.

177

00:09:49,000 --> 00:09:51,000

And we went home.

178

00:09:51,000 --> 00:09:56,000

I took him home, and I took myself home.

179

And we watched, and I was watching all the way home.

180

185

Northy end.

186

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:40,000

Now when that bright light went into that vertical climb, was that a perfect vertical climb?

187

00:10:40,000 --> 00:10:44,000

Yeah, it was. It didn't have no tilt to one side or another.

188

00:10:44,000 --> 00:10:46,000

Okay, was that a high speed?

189

00:10:46,000 --> 00:10:51,000

No, it wasn't. When we both saw it, it was traveling very slow.

190

00:10:51,000 --> 00:10:55,000

We saw the red light at the first, before it went down.

191

00:10:55,000 --> 00:11:00,000

It was a bright, focused red light that we could really make out.

192

00:11:00,000 --> 00:11:08,000

And the white light was a lot more blurred, but still held the same shape, but with a lot less detail too.

193

Did you ever see the source of where this flash was coming that was making the car?

194

No, we did. That's where we got out of the car to see where it would be.

195

And it would light up the trees all along the side of the grass in the field.

196

197

198

203

Like light-headed, we had a tingly sensation.

204

Like my hair would feel like it was standing up, I'm sure it even was.

205

And it was a light feeling.

206

Like I wasn't taking my own thoughts really, like I was in the days with what was going on.

207

00:12:12,000 --> 00:12:13,000

Okay.

208

00:12:13,000 --> 00:12:18,000

Like we would be grabbing each other and saying, look, look, because we were sure, I guess,

209

00:12:18,000 --> 00:12:20,000

ourselves that it was going on.

210

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:24,000

And finally we calmed down and started just trying to talk about it.

211

And it really was happening, as we both see it.

212

Did anything unusual happen to the car or what was going on?

214

But did that vibration in your opinion feel kind of like the high frequency sound wave?

218

It wasn't high, I can remember that.

219

It wasn't the high-pitched, I guess.

220

00:12:54,000 --> 00:12:57,000

I know it felt more internal than extra.

221

Uh-huh.

222

00:12:59,000 --> 00:13:03,000

And yeah, I guess that's the best I can describe.

223

It wasn't a buzz, it was the closest it could be.

224

Okay, well that flashing was going on.

225

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:15,000

Did you have any mental sensations of any kind?

226

Uh-huh.

227

00:13:18,000 --> 00:13:23,000

We had just that kind of feeling all the time going through this.

228

And we did notice when we left the area, the feeling would go away.

229

We came back and started to get to a stand.

230

Okay, did you notice any unusual odor in the air?

232

No, there wasn't any odor.

233

Okay.

00:13:40,000 --> 00:13:41,000

I don't know.

235

00:13:41,000 --> 00:13:43,000

We checked for that.

236

00:13:48,000 --> 00:13:51,000

Oh, awful during that.

237

00:13:51,000 --> 00:13:55,000

The second time we went up to it, I drove the car up on a hill.

238

00:13:55,000 --> 00:13:58,000

I had one headlight out.

239

00:13:58,000 --> 00:14:03,000

And out of the one headlight on, we were pointed up toward the sky where the sky was.

240

And I flashed one light on to the bright and then to the moth.

241

00:14:07,000 --> 00:14:08,000

Uh-huh.

242

00:14:08,000 --> 00:14:11,000

And then I hit the one light and then flashed the bright and then to the moth.

243

00:14:11,000 --> 00:14:16,000

And I did that for a series of minutes, probably about.

244

How close do you feel any one of those objects came to you?

245

00:14:22,000 --> 00:14:29,000

Oh, the area we were in and the area it lit up, it would have to be within a hundred yards.

246

00:14:29,000 --> 00:14:30,000

Okay.

247

00:14:33,000 --> 00:14:36,000

Did you take up any sound while all this was going on?

248

00:14:36,000 --> 00:14:38,000

Just that one time.

249

00:14:38,000 --> 00:14:41,000

We had a window throw down.

250

00:14:41,000 --> 00:14:43,000

Character not.

251

00:14:43,000 --> 00:14:45,000

Okay.

252

00:14:46,000 --> 00:14:51,000

Then when you were driving home, did you have any problems with the car?

253

00:14:51,000 --> 00:14:53,000

No, I didn't.

254

00:14:55,000 --> 00:15:06,000

Um, this morning though, when my mother came out to the car, she noticed that the tires had that light leech to a white.

255

256

275

276

But I didn't think we drove that much.
