Directly overhead.

15

I saw their faces looking out the windows at me, man, pointing at me with their fingers.

16

We're not talking about one, it's about three-crafts.

17

I mean, there's nothing like this ever happened to me in my life.

18

You know what I'm saying?

Yeah.

This shrouded a crowd of mist.

21

Just there they hovered about 300 feet from me, the closest one.

26

Are they large or small?

But no wings or tails.

Cigars shape.

32

There was three of them flying in formation side by side.

When they stopped over me, the closest one to me raised up so that the next one to him

Come look too.

87

I was not able to move.

88

I tried to scream.

89

The minute they ceased with looking at me, so to speak, and started to move off without

90

making a sound.

91

And there was no change in these lights that were shining out from behind.

92

They were just like headlights and fog, okay?

93

The sky is totally clear here.

There's not a cloud in the sky.

100

Speak up.

101

None, okay?

102

These things were clouded in the shroud of mist.

103

It's a gar shaped pot on the end of them, green glows on the top shining headlights out

104

00:05:08,000 --> 00:05:12,000

the back of these pots just like headlights in the fog of a car.

105

00:05:12,000 --> 00:05:17,000

I'm standing on top of the hill with my binoculars looking for them to come back.

106

00:05:17,000 --> 00:05:19,000

People are passing me going, you saw it too.

107

00:05:19,000 --> 00:05:21,000

I'm going, yeah, I saw it too.

108

00:05:21,000 --> 00:05:22,000

What did you see?

109

00:05:22,000 --> 00:05:24,000

And I told them what I saw.

110

00:05:24,000 --> 00:05:27,000

I told Blayman Air Force Base they gave me your number.

111

00:05:27,000 --> 00:05:28,000

Who else has reported this?

112

00:05:28,000 --> 00:05:30,000

Am I nuts or what's going on out here?

113

No, what time did you see it?

114

00:05:32,000 --> 00:05:33,000

I don't know.

115

00:05:33,000 --> 00:05:34,000

I had about nine o'clock.

116

00:05:34,000 --> 00:05:35,000

Okay.

117

00:05:35,000 --> 00:05:36,000

I don't know, man.

118

00:05:36,000 --> 00:05:37,000

I lost all track of time.

119

00:05:37,000 --> 00:05:39,000

I lost all track of anything like that.

120

00:05:39,000 --> 00:05:44,000

I mean, I was so immersed in what was happening here.

121

The last thing I was going to worry about was looking at a goddamn clock.

122

But two people that stopped to talk to me, who live in the same area as the hillsargs

123

that I do and live on the lake here with me, they stopped and they saw me standing on

124

top of the hill in the dark, standing on top of my car with binoculars.

125

They stopped and they go, you saw it too, didn't you?

126

00:06:01,000 --> 00:06:03,000

They rolled down the windows and they go, you saw it too.

127

00:06:03,000 --> 00:06:04,000

I said, yeah, I saw it.

128

00:06:04,000 --> 00:06:05,000

And they go, what did you see?

129

00:06:05,000 --> 00:06:09,000

I said, three cigar shaped aircraft hovering in a mist of fog.

130

00:06:09,000 --> 00:06:10,000

No noise.

131

00:06:10,000 --> 00:06:12,000

They said, that's exactly what we saw.

132

00:06:12,000 --> 00:06:14,000

We saw it cross over Highway 7.

133

00:06:14,000 --> 00:06:18,000

We pulled off our car, our truck, up the side of the road, show up on motor show up.

134

00:06:18,000 --> 00:06:20,000

Our headlights got out with our cameras.

135

00:06:20,000 --> 00:06:22,000

And you don't really bug me about it.

136

00:06:22,000 --> 00:06:28,000

They told me they were unable to remove the lens caps off their camera.

137

00:06:28,000 --> 00:06:29,000

That was the only thing I could do.

138

00:06:29,000 --> 00:06:30,000

Do you know those people?

139

00:06:30,000 --> 00:06:31,000

Yeah, I do know them personally.

140

00:06:31,000 --> 00:06:32,000

They're my neighbors.

141

00:06:32,000 --> 00:06:33,000

I don't know them personally.

142

00:06:33,000 --> 00:06:37,000

We live in Lake of the Ozarks for a lot of people, our vacationers.

143

00:06:37,000 --> 00:06:39,000

They come down here only on the weekends during the summer.

144

00:06:39,000 --> 00:06:41,000

Lake of the Ozarks, I don't know where you from.

145

00:06:41,000 --> 00:06:42,000

Little else, 206 area coast.

146

00:06:42,000 --> 00:06:43,000

Washington?

147

00:06:43,000 --> 00:06:44,000

Okay.

148

00:06:44,000 --> 00:06:45,000

I don't know these people.

149

00:06:45,000 --> 00:06:47,000

I've never met them before personally.

150

00:06:47,000 --> 00:06:49,000

They are full-timers here like we are.

151

00:06:49,000 --> 00:06:50,000

Okay.

152

00:06:50,000 --> 00:06:53,000

Lake of the Ozarks is 110 miles long.

153

00:06:53,000 --> 00:06:55,000

We've got 1,400 or some odd miles of shoreline.

154

00:06:55,000 --> 00:06:57,000

It's a vacation capital in the West.

155

00:06:57,000 --> 00:06:59,000

So a lot of people, they retired and they lived down here.

156

00:06:59,000 --> 00:07:01,000

These people are retired a couple.

157

00:07:01,000 --> 00:07:04,000

A lot of people, they're only down here on weekends during the warm months.

158

00:07:04,000 --> 00:07:05,000

Okay.

159

00:07:05,000 --> 00:07:06,000

These people lived down here.

160

00:07:06,000 --> 00:07:08,000

They stopped and got out and tried to photograph it.

161

00:07:08,000 --> 00:07:11,000

And the only thing that really bugged me about what they said was, is they go,

162

00:07:11,000 --> 00:07:13,000

but we couldn't get the lenses off our camera.

163

00:07:13,000 --> 00:07:14,000

Why couldn't they?

164

00:07:14,000 --> 00:07:17,000

Now this really bugged me because I'm going to tell you what, buddy,

165

00:07:17,000 --> 00:07:20,000

whatever these three things were,

166

00:07:20,000 --> 00:07:24,000

and I'm not necessarily a believer in Jesus and I'm not necessarily a believer in UFOs.

167

00:07:24,000 --> 00:07:28,000

But I'll tell you what, I saw three things as big as jet airliners,

168

00:07:28,000 --> 00:07:32,000

over 300 feet above my head atop the trees here in the woods around my house.

169

00:07:32,000 --> 00:07:35,000

And they over there without a sound and a cry to mist,

170

00:07:35,000 --> 00:07:40,000

and as they stopped dead, the mist thinned out enough that I could see that there was windows

171

00:07:40,000 --> 00:07:42,000

going down the side of these things.

172

00:07:42,000 --> 00:07:43,000

You know what it gave me?

173

00:07:43,000 --> 00:07:46,000

The idea of like a carnival cruise or something, you know?

174

00:07:46,000 --> 00:07:51,000

And these things were looking at me, out the windows, in all three cracks.

175

00:07:51,000 --> 00:07:53,000

I was like on display all of a sudden.

176

00:07:53,000 --> 00:07:54,000

Did you hear any sound?

177

00:07:54,000 --> 00:07:55,000

No sound.

178

00:07:55,000 --> 00:07:57,000

Not a sound.

179

00:07:57,000 --> 00:08:01,000

And none of us that saw it down here, and I've got quite a few witnesses,

180

00:08:01,000 --> 00:08:04,000

not necessarily just people that are in my household and my family around here,

181

00:08:04,000 --> 00:08:08,000

but other witnesses that all live in these houses around here.

182

00:08:08,000 --> 00:08:10,000

There's a bunch of us that saw it.

183

00:08:10,000 --> 00:08:14,000

And I called white men and they told me their phone was ringing off the loud.

184

00:08:14,000 --> 00:08:17,000

They even accepted my collect call about it to hear what I had to say.

185

00:08:17,000 --> 00:08:22,000

I said, I called and I said, hey, I said, I don't know if they know what's going on,

186

00:08:22,000 --> 00:08:26,000

but operator, I said, you tell them this is a collect call from a person who just had,

187

00:08:26,000 --> 00:08:29,000

although this sounds movie, of course, a kind of second kind.

188

00:08:29,000 --> 00:08:31,000

And they accepted my collect call and talked to me,

189

00:08:31,000 --> 00:08:34,000

transferred me to some big shot up there, right in the Air Force Base at the radar.

190

00:08:34,000 --> 00:08:35,000

Okay.

191

00:08:35,000 --> 00:08:39,000

And he goes, yeah, he says, our phone's ringing off the wall from Kansas City to Camdenon.

192

00:08:39,000 --> 00:08:44,000

Now, I live about 20 miles as the bird flies out of Camdenon.

193

00:08:44,000 --> 00:08:49,000

Okay, when these craft took off, did they missed reappear around them?

194

00:08:49,000 --> 00:08:51,000

It never left them.

195

00:08:51,000 --> 00:08:52,000

Okay.

196

00:08:52,000 --> 00:08:54,000

It was like continuously there.

197

00:08:54,000 --> 00:08:56,000

What color was that missed?

198

00:08:56,000 --> 00:08:57,000

Like fog.

199

00:08:57,000 --> 00:08:59,000

Like white, off, off white?

200

00:08:59,000 --> 00:09:00,000

Yeah, very white.

201

00:09:00,000 --> 00:09:01,000

Okay.

202

00:09:01,000 --> 00:09:02,000

It's night, we have no moon.

203

00:09:02,000 --> 00:09:03,000

It was grayish-white.

204

00:09:03,000 --> 00:09:04,000

Okay.

205

00:09:04,000 --> 00:09:08,000

But it like, when, I'm standing outside in my driveway, looking out across the lake,

206

00:09:08,000 --> 00:09:10,000

something all of us, I mean, it was really weird.

207

00:09:10,000 --> 00:09:12,000

It was like something told me, turn around.

208

00:09:12,000 --> 00:09:18,000

And my body all of a sudden reverts around and as it does, I look up in the sky and just like out

of the movie,

209

00:09:18,000 --> 00:09:20,000

like a polar guy or something.

210

00:09:20,000 --> 00:09:21,000

This isn't even real.

211

00:09:21,000 --> 00:09:25,000

I don't know how I can even talk to you about this, but I got to talk to somebody.

212

00:09:25,000 --> 00:09:31,000

This cloud of mist, deem fog, whatever you want to call it, just comes rolling up over the tops of the trees.

213

00:09:31,000 --> 00:09:35,000

And it's so thick and so loaded, it's gulping the tops of the tree limbs.

214

00:09:35,000 --> 00:09:43,000

And I'm looking at it, and as I look at it, I see these three things that look like car headlights on a row.

215

00:09:43,000 --> 00:09:47,000

They're facing to west, but they're moving east.

216

00:09:47,000 --> 00:09:49,000

And I'm going, what the hell?

217

00:09:49,000 --> 00:09:53,000

There's no cars up there that couldn't be doing that.

218

00:09:53,000 --> 00:09:55,000

And all of a sudden, they cease to move.

219

00:09:55,000 --> 00:09:59,000

And when they cease to move, the fog began to thin.

220

00:09:59,000 --> 00:10:00,000

Okay.

221

00:10:00,000 --> 00:10:03,000

As the fog thinned, you could see lights.

222

00:10:03,000 --> 00:10:04,000

You could see the shape.

223

00:10:04,000 --> 00:10:06,000

You could see these craft.

224

00:10:06,000 --> 00:10:12,000

Now, I don't know what color they were, but they appeared in the dark sky.

225

00:10:12,000 --> 00:10:17,000

And at this time, the reason I say I think they were dark green

226

00:10:17,000 --> 00:10:24,000

is because these lights shining out the back of them were so bright that they illuminated the mist.

227

00:10:24,000 --> 00:10:25,000

Okay?

228

00:10:25,000 --> 00:10:26,000

The fog or whatever.

229

00:10:26,000 --> 00:10:30,000

The fog gave the appearance that these craft were a dark green color,

230

00:10:30,000 --> 00:10:31,000

but they could have been dark blue.

231

00:10:31,000 --> 00:10:32,000

They could have been dark anything.

232

00:10:32,000 --> 00:10:35,000

They weren't dark, and they could have, but they were a dark color.

233

00:10:35,000 --> 00:10:37,000

They were undoubtedly dying.

234

00:10:37,000 --> 00:10:39,000

Any shadow of a doubt, they were cigar shaped.

235

00:10:39,000 --> 00:10:44,000

There was no cockpit windows as cockpit windows would be in a jet as we know it.

236

00:10:44,000 --> 00:10:49,000

The only windows went down the side like an airliner's windows.

237

00:10:49,000 --> 00:10:58,000

And then there was pods on the back that really resembled pods that a jet engine would have on the back of like a 727 or something.

238

00:10:58,000 --> 00:10:59,000

Okay.

239

00:10:59,000 --> 00:11:10,000

And on top of them, there was a round circle of green glowing light, not real intensely bright, but glowing, edmill green.

240

00:11:10,000 --> 00:11:16,000

Obviously like some kind of a round dome shaped projectile that sat on top of the made light.

241

00:11:16,000 --> 00:11:21,000

Now out of the back of these pods, now the pods were pointed on the front.

242

00:11:21,000 --> 00:11:22,000

And the mist was enough.

243

00:11:22,000 --> 00:11:26,000

I can't describe the exact appearance of them, but they looked more or less like they were pointed on the front.

244

00:11:26,000 --> 00:11:32,000

I couldn't see a dark spot in the front of them like an air intake as a jet engine as we know it.

245

00:11:32,000 --> 00:11:42,000

But the back of them was definitely flat as far as I can see because this beam of light came out that looked just like a headlight in the far of an automobile.

246

There was no tails on them. There was no wings. They made no noise.

247

00:11:47,000 --> 00:11:54,000

And whatever was on board was taking out the windows like people looking out the windows of a bus. You know what I'm saying?

248

Did you have a chance to count the number of those lighted openings?

249

00:11:57,000 --> 00:12:00,000

Well, there again.

250

00:12:00,000 --> 00:12:08,000

I couldn't move my body. I couldn't even... I'm 20 feet from a plate glass window, a picture window, for where everybody was sitting and you're watching TV.

251

00:12:08,000 --> 00:12:17,000

I wasn't... for some reason, and this is what scares me the most, or what's got me upset the most, is I wasn't able to scream to anybody in the house.

252

00:12:17,000 --> 00:12:20,000

My body froze. That's too... I wasn't able to move.

253

00:12:20,000 --> 00:12:24,000

As these things hovered there, they're still in the air.

254

00:12:24,000 --> 00:12:26,000

I couldn't move until they started to move away.

255

00:12:26,000 --> 00:12:30,000

When they started to move away, then all of a sudden I could move again.

256

00:12:30,000 --> 00:12:37,000

There was at least to give you a minimum... 15-20s minimum.

257

00:12:37,000 --> 00:12:38,000

Okay.

258

00:12:38,000 --> 00:12:40,000

I'd say 30s maximum.

259

00:12:40,000 --> 00:12:45,000

Windows down the side, directly resembling total windows of a jetliner.

260

00:12:45,000 --> 00:12:49,000

But to be honest with you, I'm so upset from the situation.

261

00:12:49,000 --> 00:12:52,000

I can't tell you if they were square around.

262

00:12:52,000 --> 00:12:53,000

Okay.

263

00:12:53,000 --> 00:12:58,000

And the light was coming out of them so brightly that it would be hard to tell you if they were square around.

264

00:12:58,000 --> 00:13:02,000

There was an incredible light coming out of the inside of the thing.

265

00:13:02,000 --> 00:13:10,000

But the light undoubtedly showed the fact that there was beings, creatures, whatever you want to term it, behind each and every window.

266

00:13:10,000 --> 00:13:12,000

Looking out and pointing.

267

00:13:12,000 --> 00:13:15,000

Sir, I mean, there were several of them that were pointing at me.

268

00:13:15,000 --> 00:13:18,000

Right, well, I got them in exhibit at the zoo.

269

00:13:18,000 --> 00:13:20,000

An aquarium.

270

00:13:20,000 --> 00:13:22,000

And they stopped their dead end.

271

00:13:22,000 --> 00:13:25,000

And what really got me was they hovered into a stair step position.

272

00:13:25,000 --> 00:13:27,000

The closest one moved up.

273

00:13:27,000 --> 00:13:29,000

The middle one moved down a little.

274

And they moved down in stair steps so that all three craft...

I looked at all three rows of windows, then all three crafts, and I could see these occupants, whatever you want to turn them, turn them in, in all three windows.

And all three sets of windows going down these crafts.

And they were looking at me.

283

They were staring at me.

I don't know, you know, you read about these things in the papers and instead.

And I'm going to tell you what, I have never in my life experienced anything like this tonight.

343

But my whole attitude just got a total rearrangement tonight because I know I'm not nuts.

344

I know what I saw.

345

00:16:54,000 --> 00:16:57,000

I'm a stone sober.

346

00:16:57,000 --> 00:17:01,000

I don't do drugs or anything like that.

347

00:17:01,000 --> 00:17:04,000

I'm a man of four kids.

348

00:17:04,000 --> 00:17:05,000

I know what I saw.

349

00:17:05,000 --> 00:17:08,000

And I know what my retired neighbors across the way saw.

350

00:17:08,000 --> 00:17:11,000

I know what my mother saw and what all the rest of his guys are on this part of the lake saw.

351

00:17:11,000 --> 00:17:14,000

We all saw the same thing, whatever this thing was.

352

00:17:14,000 --> 00:17:17,000

I guarantee you, the Air Force don't have no machines like this.

353

00:17:17,000 --> 00:17:19,000

My brother loves in the Air Force big time.

354

He sent me pictures of the SR-71 Blackbird before they were even supposed to exist.

355

And then they moved into this stair step position so that all three of them could look out the windows of all three of these crafts.

And they stood there and stared at me.

I don't know how long that was.

423

I don't know whether they stared at me for 15 seconds or whether they stared at me for 15 minutes.

424

Because the problem was I walked, I just loaded the fireplace with wood.

425

00:20:44,000 --> 00:20:47,000

I put on my coat and I walked out the bottom story of my house.

426

00:20:47,000 --> 00:20:49,000

Everybody else was upstairs.

427

00:20:49,000 --> 00:20:52,000

I walked out and went out to the driveway.

428

So I don't know how long I was standing out there in the driveway with them staring at me.

429

Because, but I do know that I was trying to yell and scream for everybody inside the house and I was not able to.

430

And I was not able to yell and scream until they got through with looking at me, so to speak, and started to move away.

In a minute, I mean the very instant that those crafts started to move away and started initiating

And then that's when my brother and I went up on top of the hill.

441

He got scared.

442

He was so scared he came back down out.

443

He wouldn't even wait up there with me.

444

00:21:48,000 --> 00:21:50,000

Okay, how many other people saw that?

445

00:21:50,000 --> 00:21:51,000

What's the total number?

446

00:21:51,000 --> 00:21:54,000

Well, in my family alone, 10.

447

00:21:54,000 --> 00:21:55,000

Okay.

448

00:21:55,000 --> 00:21:56,000

Because everybody's here this week.

449

00:21:56,000 --> 00:21:57,000

I mean, I have four kids.

450

00:21:57,000 --> 00:21:58,000

My brother's got three.

451

00:21:58,000 --> 00:22:00,000

I mean, I'm not a young, I'm not 20 years old.

452

00:22:00,000 --> 00:22:01,000

Okay.

453

00:22:01,000 --> 00:22:02,000

What is your age?

454

00:22:02,000 --> 00:22:03,000

34.

455

00:22:03,000 --> 00:22:08,000

But then I stood up on top of the hill with my binoculars and I'm looking around the horizon.

456

00:22:08,000 --> 00:22:12,000

And this pickup truck drives up and sees me standing there and they stop.

457

00:22:12,000 --> 00:22:17,000

They rolled down the window and the first thing they said to me was, you saw it too, didn't you?

458

00:22:17,000 --> 00:22:20,000

And I said, yeah, I saw something.

459

00:22:20,000 --> 00:22:21,000

What did you see?

460

00:22:21,000 --> 00:22:23,000

And we go, oh, we don't know what did you see?

461

00:22:23,000 --> 00:22:26,000

And they were like real apprehensive, you know?

462

00:22:26,000 --> 00:22:29,000

And I said, well, I'm not sure what I saw.

463

00:22:29,000 --> 00:22:32,000

I said, but I saw something float through the sky.

464

They said, sort of, read.

465

They said, how many of them did you see?

466

I said, I saw three.

467

I said, sort of, read.

468

00:22:39,000 --> 00:22:41,000

I said, in a crowd of myth, they said, yeah.

469

I said, where'd you see them?

470

00:22:42,000 --> 00:22:46,000

And then they opened up a little more after it was obvious that we had both agreed on what we had saw.

471

And they said they were sitting down around Climax Springs and they saw the crafts hover across the seven.

472

00:22:51,000 --> 00:22:53,000

This is a retired couple now.

473

00:22:53,000 --> 00:22:55,000

They're both gray-haired.

474

00:22:55,000 --> 00:22:57,000

And they proceeded to tell me that they shut off them.

475

00:22:57,000 --> 00:23:06,000

When they saw them, they realized that something was strange with the crafts, the fact that the lights were shining the opposite direction, that the crafts were moving.

476

00:23:06,000 --> 00:23:11,000

That they stopped their trucks, shut up the lights, put in the box, shut off the motor and got out.

477

00:23:11,000 --> 00:23:17,000

When they realized that they heard no engine noise, they tried to get their cameras.

478

00:23:17,000 --> 00:23:25,000

For some reason, and this is what the strangest thing that struck me about what they said was, they go, but we couldn't get our lens caps off the cameras.

479

Now, that seems real strange.

480

I don't know whether they really got pictures or whether they really couldn't get their lens caps off the cameras.

481

So I believe them.

Maybe I believe them in the sense that they couldn't get the lens caps off their cameras.

Because I know as long as those things stood for however long that was, they stood there and hovered away from me.

485

I was not able to move a screen.

486

00:23:49,000 --> 00:23:51,000

I'm 20 feet from the place last one was at my house.

487

00:23:51,000 --> 00:23:54,000

Where everybody's sitting in the living room watching TV.

488

00:23:54,000 --> 00:23:58,000

And if I'd have been able to screen, they could have heard me instantly.

489

00:23:58,000 --> 00:23:59,000

They'd have heard me yelling.

490

00:23:59,000 --> 00:24:02,000

Down here in this part of the country, it's so quiet, we've got no traffic.

491

00:24:02,000 --> 00:24:04,000

There's no road noise. There's no airplane noise.

492

00:24:04,000 --> 00:24:08,000

I mean, it's dead flat. Somebody screams a half mile away. You can hear them.

493

00:24:08,000 --> 00:24:12,000

And I couldn't screen. These people couldn't get the lenses off their cameras.

494

00:24:12,000 --> 00:24:14,000

Do you see them quite often?

495

00:24:14,000 --> 00:24:17,000

I've never seen them before in my life. They live on Colfin Bend 11.

496

00:24:17,000 --> 00:24:19,000

Now, let me explain to you what that means.

497

00:24:19,000 --> 00:24:23,000

On every cove of the lake, one side of the cove will be Colfin Bend 2.

498

00:24:23,000 --> 00:24:26,000

The next side of the cove is Colfin Bend 3. Okay?

499

00:24:26,000 --> 00:24:27,000

Okay.

500

00:24:27,000 --> 00:24:29,000

And you have lots and lots and lots of coves.

501

00:24:29,000 --> 00:24:32,000

Get out your map of Missouri. Look up Lake of the Ozarks, Central Missouri.

502

00:24:32,000 --> 00:24:37,000

Just west of Jefferson City. Just south of Sedalia in Columbia.

503

00:24:37,000 --> 00:24:39,000

Just north of Springfield. Lake of the Ozarks.

504

00:24:39,000 --> 00:24:41,000

And you'll get the picture.

505

00:24:41,000 --> 00:24:44,000

Although the map will not show you how many coves the lake actually has.

506

00:24:44,000 --> 00:24:49,000

Because the lakes are like 110 miles long, but we've got 1456 miles of shoreline.

507

00:24:49,000 --> 00:24:51,000

That tells you we've got a lot of coves.

508

00:24:51,000 --> 00:24:53,000

So the map doesn't tell you how many coves.

509

00:24:53,000 --> 00:24:56,000

Now, in our area, there's Colfin Bend.

510

00:24:56,000 --> 00:24:58,000

And the first cove is Colfin Bend 1. The other side of the cove.

511

00:24:58,000 --> 00:25:00,000

The north side of the cove is Colfin Bend 2.

512

00:25:00,000 --> 00:25:03,000

Then the next cove you come to, the south side of the cove is Colfin Bend 3.

513

00:25:03,000 --> 00:25:05,000

The north side of the cove is Colfin Bend 4.

514

00:25:05,000 --> 00:25:06,000

Saddie?

515

00:25:06,000 --> 00:25:07,000

Right.

516

00:25:07,000 --> 00:25:10,000

Well, I'm Colfin Bend 7. These people live on Colfin Bend 11.

517

00:25:10,000 --> 00:25:11,000

Okay.

518

00:25:11,000 --> 00:25:15,000

They live just, you know, they live four coves and so up for me, whatever the case may be.

519

00:25:15,000 --> 00:25:20,000

But they definitely stopped and tried to photograph it.

520

00:25:20,000 --> 00:25:23,000

But they tell me they weren't able to.

521

00:25:23,000 --> 00:25:26,000

Now, I don't know whether they were just telling me that because they really weren't able to.

522

00:25:26,000 --> 00:25:29,000

But they couldn't get the lenses.

523

00:25:29,000 --> 00:25:33,000

They said they were not able to remove the lenses from the cameras.

524

00:25:33,000 --> 00:25:39,000

And I know that I wasn't able to yell to my family inside the house until the case of the crash started to move away.

525

00:25:39,000 --> 00:25:42,000

The minute they started to move away, my body could move again.

526

00:25:42,000 --> 00:25:45,000

And man, the first thing I did was run into the house and start screaming,

527

00:25:45,000 --> 00:25:47,000

God, everybody get out of here now and look at this.

528

00:25:47,000 --> 00:25:50,000

And I brought five to four adults out there.

529

00:25:50,000 --> 00:25:54,000

And of course, one of the children is way too young.

530

00:25:54,000 --> 00:26:04,000

But the other six of the children also had to, in fact, the children that ranged in ages from six to ten were so scared I had to really give some rationalized

531

chances for what it meant.

532

00:26:07,000 --> 00:26:09,000

These are children that go to church.

533

00:26:09,000 --> 00:26:12,000

They don't understand what UFOs are about.

534

00:26:12,000 --> 00:26:14,000

Me and myself, I don't go to church.

535

00:26:14,000 --> 00:26:16,000

But my mother and the rest of them are ruling.

536

00:26:16,000 --> 00:26:18,000

They're just going to church every weekend, fable school.

537

00:26:18,000 --> 00:26:22,000

But their comprehension is Jesus was born two thousand years ago.

538

00:26:22,000 --> 00:26:28,000

And they don't grasp things like the fact that somebody else on the planet makes us look ignorant.

539

00:26:28,000 --> 00:26:33,000

And I'm going to tell you what, after tonight, I believe it will harm somebody somewhere out there.

540
