Have you been in any calls from down in the Sacramento or northern California area?

18

Ok.

Well, things have been rather quiet really for several years and up until about, well,

20

night before last I guess, when everything broke loose in California.

21

And we had several calls from the Sacramento Stockton area, also from Orange County and

22

Los Angeles County.

In fact, our calls were pretty frequent from about 3 a.m. right through to about 7 a.m.

24

that morning.

That would be the morning of the 22nd.

Ok, March 22nd.

What was it they were reporting?

Ok, well in or the Los Angeles and Orange County area there were two very brilliant

objects moving across the sky from southwest to northeast.

They were flying in tandem at what was described by some of the helicopter passers about medium

33

And they were flying in a horizontal flight trajectory, high rate of speed, and then they

Huh.

And they did not leave a trail like a meteor would.

And then up around the San Joaquin Valley area, or San Joaquin County area, around 5.15, there

minutes two brilliant white objects maneuvering over the snitch here in Nevada, mountain range.

They were not stationary, they were definitely on the move, just moving around, performing

And we also had another call from the Colusa area where a couple, around 3.23 in the morning,

48

That's about all we had for that particular morning, and then of course we have a few

What does your center get into interpretation of these things?

Do you just log these?

No, when we complete the investigation, in any case, we evaluate the information, run

57

it through a data reduction system, take that and catalog it into the data bank, and then

this information is compared with past reports specifically, the unknowns for the past 20

59

years to see how they compare, and then of course this massive data which is accumulated

60

is used in our various research programs.

How do these recent findings compare with once it has been reported in the past really similar?

Well, okay, they come in three different categories.

63

They've got the disc shaped object which fits right into the description category for that

particular type of object, and then the one in central California where the two lights

were maneuvering around, this is very common.

The only problem there is all the witnesses see is a light, and they don't see any superstructure

67

of any kind of a vehicle.

Then the ones that passed over Southern California why this is quite common for rapid over flights,

69

and what we refer to as high flyers, which cannot be or do not fit into the category of

Okay, so they all fit into different patterns that have been reported in the past.

Okay, what kind of, what do you do with the information after you've broken it down and

compared with the past?

Is it put any opinion used for it to anybody, or what do you do with the stuff after you've

76

evaluated it?

Okay, well that depends on the priority, the type of case.

It's a real close approach case or a landing, why then we try to get a field investigator

79

in and do all the on the spot investigations that they can do, but the data itself is used

80

in, we have constant research projects going, we make a very close study of the behavior

81

pattern of these objects and specifically in relation to the witness.

82

Then we watch for changes in patterns such as the type of vehicles that are being seen,

83

where the activity is concentrated, what they might be watching.

84

If they get a heavy rash or reports from a specific area, then we try to determine just

85

exactly what they're doing there, what the purpose is, the type of surface features that

86

00:06:50,360 --> 00:06:59,360

they might be checking on or geological studies of some kind, or are they watching people

87

00:06:59,360 --> 00:07:01,360

or certain people.

88

But we try to watch for these patterns, these patterns have formed in the past and we just

89

watch for repeats as well.

90

I suppose it's too early to say whether these are deciding to amount or give an evaluation

91

to them or interpretation or have them.

92

It's a little early yet, we're still gathering data, we're searching for more witnesses,

93

but I think that the one up in the northern part of California would fall very well into

the UFO category or we would classify it as an unknown because the actual vehicle itself

95

was seen.

Okay, you can bring many of those?

97

Yes, yes we do.

98

Okay, are you, I wonder if I could ask you just a little bit about the organization and

99

the structure of it?

Sure.

How are you set up, are you funded by donations or what do you get there operating?

102

No, we have a permanent staff of 12 volunteers and they foot all the bills, they just split

103

it up so it's self-funded, we don't have to rely on anyone, there's no strings attached

104

to the organization, we're free to operate in whatever direction we want to go.

105

And these volunteers also may in the center and do all the book work and the various research

106

projects.

Well that's interesting, how long have you been in operation?

108

Well the center itself has been in operation for about two and a half years.

109

Apparently you've got the word out fairly well, since as I say the police have been here for

110

calls to you, you know, specifically of other lands that share up to 15 California centers,

111

perhaps Calusa, is that 101, is that your vestige?

112

Yes, we were notified by the Calusa Sheriff's Department.

113

There are a few, we don't know exactly how many but we know that there are some, we have

114

sent out some literature, spot mailings in hopes that they would cooperate as well and that's

115

all we can hope for.

I see, you feel that's what brings the context to you.

117

Right, this is our effort to make contact with the people who have these experiences.

118

I suppose that's why the county Sheriff's Office here has people contacting one of the

119

Southern California centers, probably it's just something that came in the mail from

120

00:09:56,360 --> 00:10:07,360

a post-it or something else like that.

Has there been, you say it's been really quiet for the last couple of years, is there, do

122

00:10:12,360 --> 00:10:20,360

these things, the sightings tend to run in cycles such as more, you just had several

123

over one or two day period, is that the way things typically go and then, and then think

124

00:10:27,360 --> 00:10:28,360

for a while?

125

Well, off and on, yes.

126

I mean, let me put it this way, there's no marked pattern.

127

The last large rash of the UFO reports occurred in 73 and it's just been tapering off continuously

128

since then now with periodic spurts of reports here and there, like from California.

129

But the one that we have, what we call a flap condition or a sudden activity which goes

130

on for maybe weeks in a particular given area, why then we keep track of all this and try

131

to see if there's a marked pattern between that and the last one and the previous one

132

00:11:11,200 --> 00:11:12,200

and so forth.

133

But we have not found such a pattern and we don't have an answer as to why it's the

134

way it is.

135

We've tried to compare close planet oppositions and various astronomical positions of solar

136

systems and so forth in comparison to ours and we just haven't found any marked pattern

137

of any kind.

So there are reasons for coming and going that are just completely unknown.

139

Okay, one of the things that the people down in San Diego County, Southern California told

me was that their course are convinced that these are research flights from other places

141

in space but they seem to be convinced that these flights are originating from within

142

00:12:12,480 --> 00:12:13,480

our solar system.

143

Is that one of the premises you're operating on or does anybody have to feel that way?

144

No, no, considering the probes that NASA has made into the solar system we're quite sure

145

00:12:25,760 --> 00:12:31,880

that the ports of origin are not from our system.

146

00:12:31,880 --> 00:12:36,880

I mean we could be wrong on this but we're going by what NASA has come up with, actual

147

00:12:36,880 --> 00:12:46,800

data and so we feel that if they are interplanetary then they are probably coming from other solar

148

00:12:46,800 --> 00:12:51,400

systems, nearby solar systems and if you really want to get out, way out in the right field

149

00:12:51,400 --> 00:12:56,240

why we could even imagine that they would be coming in from other galaxies.

150

Of course the astronomers, you know they put up a big fight against such a theory because

151

of the tremendous mileage involved in distances but our science is very, very young and who

152

used to say that we will not develop means of travel that could cover those distances

153

and practically no time at all.

You operate on any premise that these are some sort of just voicings of discovery from

155

other places or some sort of research or some sort of study missions that these beings

156

are just going to take a look at their, maybe do the equivalent of photograph or study it

157

00:13:48,360 --> 00:13:51,360

or something of this sort.

How do the people in your group view what they have learned so far?

159

Well, okay we, of course these sightings have been made for thousands of years and we feel

160

that there is a constant program being carried on by alien visitors from many parts of origin

161

and that some may be just flybys and come in just out of curiosity, others may be conducting

162

00:14:25,360 --> 00:14:32,360

constant surveillance of the advancement of mankind on this planet.

163

But we do feel that there is a definite purpose when they come here they appear just by their

164

behavior pattern to be here for a purpose.

165

We have seen in our various research projects that there appears to be various levels of

166

technology involved. We feel that some of the visitors are more advanced through science

167

and technology than others. We have made a very close study of the various types of vehicles

168

00:15:14,360 --> 00:15:20,360

and the types of apparent propulsion systems that they are using and it is obvious that

169

00:15:20,360 --> 00:15:33,360

some of them are more sophisticated than others.

170

00:15:33,360 --> 00:15:41,360

Have you ever gotten any reports of actual sightings by witnesses of the inhabitants of any of these

171

00:15:41,360 --> 00:15:48,360

crafts that you recently did?

172

00:15:48,360 --> 00:15:54,360

No, the occupants, no we haven't.

173

00:15:54,360 --> 00:16:02,360

So these cameras remain just a little bit out of distance to avoid people at least to the point where they can see

174

00:16:02,360 --> 00:16:14,360

what was going on, who was inside and so forth.

175

00:16:14,360 --> 00:16:22,360

Does this give people problems that are looking for ways of explaining this?

176

00:16:22,360 --> 00:16:30,360

In other words, if we set a probe to Mars, a man probe or something that is discovered right there

177

we would probably make some attempt to get out and look at it under a magnifying glass.

178

A lot of people say well why don't they get out and shake hands with this or take a picture of this

179

00:16:43,360 --> 00:16:50,360

and we can see them. Is this a hard thing to explain?

180

00:16:50,360 --> 00:16:56,360

Not really, it used to be but we've come up with, the mystery isn't what it was five years ago

181

00:16:56,360 --> 00:17:02,360

as far as we're concerned because we've come up with a lot of information on our research.

182

00:17:02,360 --> 00:17:13,360

We feel that the problem of contact between aliens and earth people involves

183

00:17:13,360 --> 00:17:21,360

magnetics, biomagnetics.

184

00:17:21,360 --> 00:17:28,360

Evolution, we feel that there's an evolutionary gap. In other words, any race of people who are highly involved

185

00:17:28,360 --> 00:17:35,360

let's say five or ten thousand years beyond us, it is going to be, I don't think there's going to be

186

00:17:35,360 --> 00:17:41,360

any comparison relating to their physical and mental development compared to ours.

187

00:17:41,360 --> 00:17:57,360

Our science is finding that the human body has a regular biomagnetic system associated with it.

188

00:17:57,360 --> 00:18:04,360

They're just getting into this, they don't know too much about it but they know that it's there.

189

00:18:04,360 --> 00:18:17,360

We feel that any alien being who is far advanced beyond us in evolution that their biosystem,

190

00:18:17,360 --> 00:18:25,360

the magnetic system, the biological clock and the whole bit, cannot blend with ours.

191

00:18:26,360 --> 00:18:35,360

There could be a communication problem also. Now there have been claims where individuals have said they have made contact.

192

00:18:35,360 --> 00:18:46,360

Well we can believe part of these because we believe that there are some people on this planet who are much more advanced

193

00:18:47,360 --> 00:18:52,360

through this biological system than others and they may be able to make contact.

194

00:18:52,360 --> 00:19:04,360

Now we also believe that the system that controls or makes these vehicles move also involves magnetic fields of some kind

195

00:19:04,360 --> 00:19:15,360

which if they come into contact with the biomagnetic system around the human body could be either fatal or cause serious injuries.

196

00:19:15,360 --> 00:19:25,360

And this we feel is one of the reasons that there are very few close approaches to witnesses when we compare the number of sightings

197

00:19:25,360 --> 00:19:33,360

that have actually been made. But it's a new science, I'm speaking of our regular orthodox field now,

198

00:19:33,360 --> 00:19:38,360

it's a new science and they're making some very mind boggling discoveries in this.

199

And we feel this definitely has something to do with the UFOs.

200

Do you have a system there at your center of some sort of grading system that you reported with sightings

201

00:20:12,360 --> 00:20:18,360

of a UFO that you can give a certain amount of credence to it? Is there some way you can verify it?

202

How do you determine which calls are strictly based on nothing other than somebody's imagination?

203

00:20:26,360 --> 00:20:32,360

Which ones do you tend to give more relief in?

204

00:20:32,360 --> 00:20:38,360

In other words if you get one from an Air Force pilot or something and they give it a little bit more,

205

00:20:39,360 --> 00:20:45,360

I think it's a little more substantial than one you might give somebody sounds like he's a gas or something.

206

00:20:45,360 --> 00:20:50,360

Oh yes, yes. We would naturally give more priority to qualified observers.

207

00:20:50,360 --> 00:20:58,360

But this doesn't mean that a farmer out in the country couldn't come up with something just as valid

208

00:20:58,360 --> 00:21:06,360

because when an individual calls in and within about the first minute or two of that individual describing what they have seen,

209

00:21:06,360 --> 00:21:10,360

we can just about tell whether it's a hoax call or not.

210

00:21:10,360 --> 00:21:15,360

The descriptions are just completely outside of the ordinary light descriptions,

211

00:21:15,360 --> 00:21:19,360

but when they start describing vehicles and they can see superstructure and so forth,

212

00:21:19,360 --> 00:21:24,360

we know what to look for in their description.

213

00:21:24,360 --> 00:21:32,360

If they have a very, very good background in the subject of UFOs, then they could perpetrate a hoax without any problem.

214

But we have found that at least 95% of the people that report objects to us are diehard non-believers.

215

They have never had any interest in the subject and they know nothing about it.

216

00:21:47,360 --> 00:21:53,360

So when somebody calls up and they've got a quivering voice and they've had hell scared out of them

217

00:21:53,360 --> 00:21:59,360

and they start describing something which fits right into the category of all the data that we've collected,

218

00:21:59,360 --> 00:22:06,360

then we can be sure that the report is valid.

219

00:22:06,360 --> 00:22:20,360

And then of course this is backed up by field investigators making on-the-spot investigations too.

220

00:22:20,360 --> 00:22:31,360

Okay.

221

00:22:31,360 --> 00:22:34,360

Okay, then how do you field check something here?

222

00:22:34,360 --> 00:22:36,360

Just look further with the suicide video.

223

00:22:36,360 --> 00:22:41,360

Maybe check with law enforcement people or something to see if other people will call me in there.

224

00:22:41,360 --> 00:22:43,360

How do you know about it?

225

00:22:43,360 --> 00:22:50,360

Well, whoever goes out to do the interviewing will, depending upon where the individual lives,

226

00:22:50,360 --> 00:22:57,360

they'll check neighborhoods and check with the news medias and check with law enforcement.

227

00:22:57,360 --> 00:23:02,360

Anybody else, any other agency that might have got a call, they'll go to them and check it out.

228

One of the main things is to get as many witnesses to any one incident that we can.

229

00:23:14,360 --> 00:23:19,360

Do you have someone manning your phone there 24 hours a day?

230

00:23:19,360 --> 00:23:23,360

Yes, sir. This phone is answered by one of our staff around the clock.

231

00:23:23,360 --> 00:23:27,360

There's no answering machines. There's no telephone answering service,

232

00:23:27,360 --> 00:23:32,360

and very experienced people are here at all times.

233

00:23:32,360 --> 00:23:41,360

One question. Are the people who are the volunteers, are they specialized in any particular field themselves

234

00:23:41,360 --> 00:23:45,360

as far as jobs or locations or are they just people who are interested in UFOs?

235

00:23:45,360 --> 00:23:47,360

Well, they've all got a great interest in.

236

00:23:47,360 --> 00:23:55,360

And background in the subject, we have a physicist and there's a professional astronomer and we have an MD.

237

00:23:55,360 --> 00:24:02,360

And then there's a couple people associated with electronics and the rest are just ordinary laymen.

238

00:24:02,360 --> 00:24:06,360

How about yourself? What do you do?

239

00:24:06,360 --> 00:24:08,360

No, I'm retired.

240

00:24:08,360 --> 00:24:11,360

Can I get your name?

241

00:24:11,360 --> 00:24:15,360

No, I'd rather not. Just a member of the staff.

242

00:24:15,360 --> 00:24:22,360

Okay, I can just say that you're one of the people who mans the phones on a regular basis.

243

00:24:22,360 --> 00:24:33,360

Okay, good enough. Do you have any records on the number of calls you have gotten from the right in California over the years today?

244

00:24:33,360 --> 00:24:39,360

Maybe I should ask you this, how large an area do you get calls from?

245

00:24:39,360 --> 00:24:42,360

Just the west coast, primarily.

246

00:24:42,360 --> 00:24:53,360

Do they come in any way of knowing about how frequent the calls from Northern California are in comparison to other areas?

247

00:24:53,360 --> 00:25:02,360
