Maydock, and the serpent in UFO, they've been connected by every writer and UFO researcher

Any way that we're in that, it would jam through one of the cameras over here.

Yeah, for example, some of the best sellers have been, for example, the teachings of Don

137

Juan by Carlos Castaneda.

138

Now, you can find every UFO description you've ever heard in Carlos Castaneda's books, which

139

is a completely different area, but I think that's where the answer is going to be found.

140

Well, you know, speaking of the answer being found, I'm getting...

141

Well, you're coming at UFOs from an entirely different perspective than I think I'm accustomed

143

to, which is aliens from other parts of the galaxy and the universe.

144

And you're saying that perhaps as we get to know man and sort of man's parapsychological

145

character a little more, that we're going to understand that UFOs are just simply a projection

146

of a human being as opposed to any extraterrestrial sort of phenomena.

147

But cars are in.

148

Both.

149

Both.

150

They're both involved.

151

I prefer...

152

You see, on UFOs, I prefer the interdimensional theory, which to me is the most logical.

153

I don't see how you can get out of it, because, for example, there are UFO landing sites.

154

But strangely enough, the landing sites are rather strange.

155

They happen at the same places where there's usually water, swamp, which is actually almost

156

00:08:40,320 --> 00:08:45,320

like animal behavior too, like UFOs that follow airplanes or animals do that.

157

See, they all follow ships all over the world.

158

We're going to give you a chance to talk about this a bit more.

159

Peter Uker, who was the editor of the Canadian Psychic Researcher magazine that, among other

166

things, investigates UFOs and UFO sightings, has got a question for you.

167

Mr. Uker, I'd like to ask you how you check out a sighting when you hear of a report.

168

Well, as much as I'd like to, I'm going to be very honest with you.

169

00:09:20,320 --> 00:09:23,320

It's not possible to check all sightings out personally.

170

00:09:23,320 --> 00:09:25,320

It's literally impossible.

171

00:09:25,320 --> 00:09:29,320

And one of the drawbacks to it is that the UFO does never wait for you to get there.

172

By the time you get there, it's probably a Kalamazoo or something.

173

00:09:33,320 --> 00:09:36,320

That's why you have to concentrate on the witness.

174

00:09:36,320 --> 00:09:39,320

And of course, you look for landing traces of deaths involved.

175

00:09:39,320 --> 00:09:43,320

It's a potential kind of a sighting, but usually when they say, well, just the light in the sky,

176

00:09:43,320 --> 00:09:45,320

there isn't really much more you can do with it.

177

00:09:45,320 --> 00:09:47,320

You pretty well leave it just the way it is.

178

00:09:47,320 --> 00:09:48,320

What are you going to do with it?

179

00:09:48,320 --> 00:09:50,320

Do you give any lighting tests, yes?

180

00:09:50,320 --> 00:09:54,320

Oh, yes. When the stories get that deep, you have to.

181

00:09:54,320 --> 00:10:00,320

What is, you know, when you talk about sightings, what is a story that you, perhaps,

182

00:10:00,320 --> 00:10:05,320

the most convincing in your experience that UFOs...

183

00:10:05,320 --> 00:10:10,320

Either way, the personal, for example, that convinces you more than any other story that you've heard,

184

00:10:10,320 --> 00:10:13,320

that there is real credibility in UFOs.

185

00:10:13,320 --> 00:10:18,320

Well, of course, the one that stands out all the time is the Betty and Barney Hill one.

186

00:10:18,320 --> 00:10:26,320

And of course, the new one with the three ladies in Kentucky is, I think, it's just as valid.

187

00:10:26,320 --> 00:10:29,320

But, for example, I don't believe the Travis Walton story.

188

00:10:29,320 --> 00:10:31,320

I mean, what happened to the three ladies in Kentucky?

189

00:10:31,320 --> 00:10:35,320

Well, they were driving along and then they started studying strange things,

190

00:10:35,320 --> 00:10:40,320

and, you know, then the car started behaving strangely, and they lost time.

191

00:10:40,320 --> 00:10:43,320

That's how usually only it's remembered is because they lost time.

192

00:10:43,320 --> 00:10:45,320

And were they still off the stories?

193

00:10:45,320 --> 00:10:50,320

Oh, yeah, they all matched, and all three supply detected tests, hypnosis, and the stories all matched.

194

I think it's just as valid as the Betty and Barney Hill.

195

Let's take a question. Good morning. You're on the air.

196

Good morning. I was wondering if your guest was familiar with the book called Missionaries Extraordinaire.

197

Yes, I am.

198

00:11:01,320 --> 00:11:09,320

You are. What did you think of the way that they seem to explain whether this UFOs are logical in their sense and their explanation?

199

You're talking about Bow and Peep, right?

200

00:11:11,320 --> 00:11:12,320

Yes.

201

00:11:12,320 --> 00:11:13,320

Yeah, and I don't believe them.

202

I wonder about that.

203

00:11:14,320 --> 00:11:20,320

Because I tell you why. What they say you can find in a novel called Flutterhouse 5.

204

All right, we have another question for you.

205

Okay, Mr. Yooker, you're thinking why are there so many studies in the Northwest in any other part of the country?

206

00:11:32,320 --> 00:11:35,320

Not really. Actually, the heaviest place is West Virginia.

207

00:11:35,320 --> 00:11:38,320

I'm sorry about that.

208

00:11:39,320 --> 00:11:44,320

I have to say that I asked that young lady.

209

00:11:44,320 --> 00:11:46,320

So I'm guilty.

210

00:11:46,320 --> 00:11:51,320

Well, the reason is that they used to be a lot of sightings in the Northwest.

211

00:11:51,320 --> 00:11:52,320

Yes.

212

00:11:52,320 --> 00:11:54,320

There used to be a lot up here.

213

00:11:54,320 --> 00:11:58,320

Does this mean that there is some kind of meeting ground for UFOs?

214

00:11:58,320 --> 00:12:01,320

They sort of huddle here and then fly up elsewhere?

215

00:12:01,320 --> 00:12:02,320

Oh, yeah.

216

00:12:02,320 --> 00:12:07,320

There are places where they show up just about all the time, like Warminster, England.

217

00:12:07,320 --> 00:12:12,320

If a visitor goes over to England, they should go to Warminster because of your chances of seeing a UFO.

218

00:12:12,320 --> 00:12:13,320

It's unbelievable.

219

00:12:13,320 --> 00:12:20,320

They're about almost 99% sure of seeing one in Warminster, England, which is the highest activity in the world.

220

00:12:20,320 --> 00:12:23,320

But Washington State, by the way, you deserve congratulations.

221

00:12:23,320 --> 00:12:26,320

This is the 30th anniversary of the modern UFO in two days.

222

00:12:26,320 --> 00:12:29,320

We should go out and celebrate.

223

00:12:29,320 --> 00:12:35,320

But whether UFOs are on the Washington also depends on the weather because I think they do affect the weather.

224

00:12:35,320 --> 00:12:41,320

For example, I think Canada is getting high UFO activity right now because this is where the weather patterns are.

225

00:12:41,320 --> 00:12:48,320

So if you start getting drought in certain places or flooding in other places, it's possible that the UFO is connected to a certain degree to it.

226

00:12:48,320 --> 00:12:50,320

Good morning, here on the air.

227

00:12:50,320 --> 00:13:01,320

Yes, I have some friends that are into astro travel where they can go from one place to another, not physically, but in their mind.

228

00:13:01,320 --> 00:13:03,320

And they have friends perceived in there.

229

00:13:03,320 --> 00:13:12,320

Now I was wondering if, as far as UFOs, is your interdimensional idea that you were talking about, if they might not be doing the same thing?

230

Actually, not being there, but just being perceived.

231

00:13:15,320 --> 00:13:17,320

That's quite possible.

232

00:13:17,320 --> 00:13:27,320

For example, you can probably, the way to attack what you're suggesting is to say that what's the purpose of evolution, if by chance the purpose of evolution,

233

00:13:27,320 --> 00:13:36,320

the ultimate development of evolution is where man becomes pure energy, then should you become pure energy, then you can turn into any shape that you want to.

234

Another question from the audience, Fort.

235

Is there any evidence that there's been a government or military cover-up of UFOs?

236

00:13:44,320 --> 00:13:47,320

I don't push that very much.

237

00:13:47,320 --> 00:13:55,320

Because if the major scientists of the world don't understand it, how the government is going to understand it, I'll never know.

238

00:13:55,320 --> 00:14:03,320

What about the air force, for example, in I forget, I think it was sometime in the 60s, early 60s, they canceled Project Blue Book,

239

00:14:03,320 --> 00:14:08,320

which was the way they had documented and kept track of all UFO sightings.

240

00:14:08,320 --> 00:14:15,320

Did you see that shutting off a Project Blue Book as an effort on the part of the air force to sort of cover up?

241

00:14:15,320 --> 00:14:17,320

No, I don't think the air force really knows anything.

242

00:14:17,320 --> 00:14:23,320

If anybody knows anything about UFOs, believe it or not, it's the U.S. Navy, because they do UFO research.

243

00:14:23,320 --> 00:14:26,320

The air force doesn't.

244

00:14:26,320 --> 00:14:29,320

Okay, let's take another question. Good morning, you're on the air.

245

00:14:29,320 --> 00:14:34,320

Yes, I'd like to know if there's anything one can do to make one's life more receptive to sighting the UFO.

246

00:14:34,320 --> 00:14:40,320

Absolutely, but that's going to take me too long on the air. If you can call me privately, I'll tell you about it.

247

00:14:40,320 --> 00:14:41,320

Could you give us a hint?

248

00:14:41,320 --> 00:14:46,320

No, because it has to do, for example, the best day of the week to see a UFO is a Wednesday.

249

00:14:46,320 --> 00:14:52,320

The best time to see one is 10 p.m. and the closer to the 24th of the month, the better.

250

00:14:52,320 --> 00:14:58,320

And also, depending on what you learn about UFOs, you increase your chances of seeing a UFO.

251

And like I said, it also depends on your last name.

252

00:15:00,320 --> 00:15:03,320

Have you ever tried your own technique, so you don't want to see one.

253

00:15:03,320 --> 00:15:08,320

I don't have time.

254

00:15:08,320 --> 00:15:21,320
