C E N T R E V I L L E

This picturesque town with a population of 2018, is the county seat of Queen Anne's County on Maryland's Eastern Shore. Within an hour's drive are sites for nearly every major defense contractor, bases for every branch of the Armed Forces, forty eight federally funded research laboratories, numerous "think tanks", three known National Security Agency sites, The Central Intelligence Agency Headquarters, The Pentagon and the Nation's Capitol. It is not surprising that numerous government, military and corporate officials make the Centreville area their home when they retire.

The Centreville location despite all the preceding is extremely isolated. Bordered by the Corsica and Chester Rivers, it is separated from the Chesapeake Bay by the Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge island. It lies east of the Broadneck Peninsula and Annapolis area which suggests a possible destination for some of the extensive helicopter traffic. It is believed that the United States Naval Academy keeps a fleet of seven helicopters in Centreville. While there is no evidence of a hangar or Naval facility there, helicopters have been observed by researchers flying over the area on several occasions.

The area is a vast expanse of farmland, fields, woodlands, estates, coves, creeks and protected wildlife preserves. One can travel the rural roads all day and rarely see vehicles or people. It is so ideal an area that the Soviet Union purchased 45.52 acres of Pioneer Point in Centreville in 1972 on which to construct a recreational retreat.

Another more sinister aspect to the Centreville area was

uncovered during the course of our research. While on field investigation with Bob Oechsler in February 1989, researcher Lenward Hebert interviewed a local county policeman at the Centreville Sheriff's Office. Officer Lee Clough related a chilling and unusual account. Several months earlier (Fall 1988) a man in northern Queen Anne's County called to report that he was being harrassed by a UFO that was shining bright lights through the windows of his home and he was in fear for his life. The report was apparently discounted and no officers were dispatched to investigate.

About one week later the Police received a call from the local postal carrier who was concerned about a resident who had failed to collect his mail. Officers arrived on the scene to find a man in a semi-conscious state and called for Paramedic assistance. The man was dispatched to a local hospital where he died shortly after arrival according to accounts related to Bob Oechsler by Officer Clough. The connection between the UFO complaint and the deceased resident was surmised to be the product of informed speculation on the part of the Sheriff's Office. When we attempted to gain access to the police reports, we were denied based on policy reasons.

Officer Clough failed to return further calls on the matter and the Sheriff has been inaccessible. It is possible that the department is concerned about negligence in failing to respond to the original complaint and have thus decided not to cooperate in our investigation.

UFO sightings throughout the Eastern Shore area have been common during the course of our investigation. Expanding outside

of the Centreville area revealed more interesting discoveries of interrelated activities.

T H E S O V I E T C O M P O U N D

Originally the Pioneer Point tract was part of a 1600 acre estate. The Soviets purchased the land from Charles Rist on March 2-4th, 1972. Rist had purchased it from the United Nuclear Corporation. Since that time 1.2 million dollars in improvements have been made. The parcel designated USSR on the plat map includes an odd parcel (P16) which is approximately 7 acres and deeded to the United States State Department! Parcels #9 and #17 are deeded to the Jesuits of Georgetown. These parcels totaling about 11 acres sit next to the jointly occupied USSR/USA compound.

The question that arises is why would the USSR, despite great local debate and criticism, purchase property and then allow the US government to own and occupy a portion of it? Upon inspection of the facility it is clear that one fence encompasses the site. The State Department acreage seems to be clearly incorporated into the compound. No separate facility identifiable as belonging to the US Government can be seen. So it seems that instead of a Soviet recreational facility for the express use of Soviet embassy personnel and their families is in reality a shared site, a co-operative facility between the USSR and the USA.

A 35 room mansion centers the property. Another facility of 20 rooms sits near the water. There is a dock with speed boats and a two lighted tennis court areas, a pool, an underground area evidenced by pipes and a ground-level roof, and a dozen large chalet type (approx. 3000 sq. ft. each)

structures painted odd pastel colors. In the parcel designated State Department there appears to be enough acreage for the odd chalets and the smaller mansion known as Mostly Hall. News articles state that the USSR purchased Mostly Hall.

On March 4, 1989 a researcher traveled to Pioneer Point. He visited with Father Collins, head of the Jesuit Community at Georgetown University. Father Collins said that each summer the compound hosts summer camp for embassy personnel children. The Soviet Ambassador visits on weekends frequently. When Gorbachev was in the US, he too visited the compound more than once. The CIA maintains a constant surveillance (at least once a week) of the compound via helicopter and light plane which photograph the area according to Father Collins.

The Father says he has never seen a helicopter land on the premises. They arrive in cars, he states. Peter G. Sheaffer owns all the surrounding property to Reed Creek, except parcels sold to private corporations or individuals. The Father stated that Sheaffer deeded some land to the Dupont Corporation and that he has since bought some of it back. Father Collins thought Sheaffer was a realty company. Pheasant and quail for the wildlife preserve are kept in an area of land between the compound and Jesuit parcel.

The Father said that the only time he saw CIA people was on the occasions of Gorbachev's visits. Father Collins stated that there are approximately 2,000 Soviet Embassy personnel who utilize the compound supposedly for recreational purposes. He has visited the compound frequently and finds his Russian

neighbors to be friendly and introverted.

The researcher also visited another neighbor. The lady of the house was asked a variety of questions. She stated that she had only known the compound to be Soviet occupied. She verified the summer camp. After being asked about the helicopters she became reticent and went into the house. The unusual man connected to the missing children society who made the alien claims carries a set of heavy wooden bead rosary typical of the kind carried by the Jesuit order. Is this another coincidence?

The compound is surrounded by a ten foot fence. Surveillance cameras and motion detectors and are in evidence. The motion detectors which are placed everywhere, including next to the dumpster, are of the same color (light blue) and design as those found at the Navy's David Taylor Research Center. We are informed that the largest privately owned satellite tracking system in the country, is located at this Soviet/USA compound.

There are no guards, no identifying flags, banners or signs. One half of the compound is hidden from view. There are no satellite dishes, no helipad, no airstrip could be seen from road. At no time was any researcher stopped or otherwise warned. If anything the totally relaxed manner of security is surprising.

On February 25, 1989 Bob Oechsler called the State Department in Washington, DC. Explaining that he was interested in bidding on property located near the Soviet parcel, Bob wanted to know what restrictions, if any, might apply. Specifically he asked about helicopter traffic, road access etc. A response was

promised. On March 3, 1989 another call was made to the Real Property Division of the State Department. The helpful employee said that there appears to be no listing of Centreville property on her computer. She advised that the query would need to be handled by the Protocol Department. Why isn't this property listed on the computer?

On February 26, 1989 researcher Lenward Hebert, accompanied by Bob Oechsler, entered the compound in an effort to observe the facility and possibly take some photographs. The gate was opened and there was no guard immediately noticeable. This time the Soviets perked up at once and responded as though they assumed the worst. A man yelling in Russian ordered the researchers off the property. Another man wearing a Washington Redskins hat appeared on the front porch of the Mansion with a woman and waved and smiled as the researchers drove away. It is still impossible to verify through the State Department who owns and uses what part of the compound. The estate remains an enigma.

Whatever the true purpose of the Pioneer Point compound, the strategic value is undeniable. We also found an interesting news article revealing that at one time, during the late sixties, the Soviets maintained a recreational facility nearby while awaiting the finalization of the Pioneer Point compound. This site was on Wye Island just south of their present location. Today Wye Island is implicated in another provocative scenario. It is part of a sprawling multi-million dollar facility which serves the varied needs of corporate America and where some of the most intriguing elements of the UFO cover-up were unveiled.

Russians live high on Shore

CENTREVILLE, Md.(AP)— Diplomats from the Soviet Union's Embassy are living in such grand style at their Eastern Shore retreat that one neighbor is led to wonder if they aren't capitalists after all.

After buying the luxurious estate at Pioneer Point for more than \$1 million, the Russian delegation went about stocking it with comforts that would have made a czar envious.

They acquired two yachts, imported a high-powered Russian speedboat for waterskiing, installed air conditioning, improved the tennis courts and touched up the swimming pool.

Their little resort also includes two mansions, 40 tree-shaded acres and sandy beaches along the Corsica and Chester Rivers.

It was formerly owned by arch-capitalist John Jacob Raskob.

One nearby Russian-watcher commented, "You'd think they were capitalists."

Most of the residents living near the Russian estate, however, don't seem to mind the presence of these rarely seen neighbors. "They leave us alone, and we leave them alone,"

said one Queen Annes County commissioner.

A furniture storeowner finds them good customers. "Always pay cash," he said.

Victor Ivanov, resident manager of the estate, says the resort is used for relaxing Soviet diplomats and their families, who come up 50 at a time from Washington.


They play different sports: tennis, soccer, ping-pong, fishing, waterskiing and swimming, Ivanov said. And the girls do wear bikinis, he adds, because they're "good for sunbathing."

The Russians also conduct themselves properly in social situations, local residents attest.

RED ROUT ■ Soviet athletes have lot to learn before becoming baseball powers

There has been some concern about the Soviet Union overtaking the United States in baseball, as it has done in sports like basketball, hockey and gymnastics.

If yesterday's game between the Soviets and the Naval Academy is any indication, don't worry.

The USSR national baseball team opened its three-week tour of the United States with a 21-1 loss to Navy. The game itself was not a pretty sight. Navy won as the

Russians had eight errors, eight walks, eight wild pitches and four hit batsmen.

"We didn't play like we could have," Soviet manager Alexander Ardatov said through an interpreter after the game at the U.S. Naval Academy.

Navy took advantage of a flood of Soviet errors and walks, scoring 10 runs on three hits in the first inning en route to the exhibition victory.

"You could see they were nervous," Navy catcher Tim Peifley

said. "They're not used to playing in front of this many people. But we're not either."

"I wish I could have communicated with them to tell them to keep their heads up (while in the batters box)," he added.

Centerfielder Chris Angle went 2-for-2 with two runs scored and three RBIs to lead Navy. Despite the 21 runs, just one of Navy's 12 hits was for extra bases.

The Soviets, who had three hits, scored their only run in the fifth inning on their first hit of the

game, a double by Leonid Komeyev to score Sergey Zhigalov. Zhigalov reached first on a fielder's choice and scored on the double.

The friendship and fellowship of the Soviets' appearance here was far more noteworthy.

The Soviets, decked out in crimson jerseys with gold numerals, red caps and white pants and shoes, looked like many of the college teams that might have visited Navy at Max Bishop Field.

Feds say 'nyet' to Soviet group's visit to local school

A planned visit to a nearby county high school by a contingent from the Soviet Embassy was rejected last week by the State Department.

The reason: The high school, Archbishop Spalding, is in a 25-mile "sensitive zone," off limits to Soviets.

"I'm not sure about this, just disappointed," said Eric McLoughlin, Spalding's director of development. He was called by a State

Department official Monday.

"The State Department was very nice about it and said, 'It's the kind of thing that we do to them and they do to us,'" she said. "All of Saint Anselm's County is in the closed area."

Ms. McLoughlin spent months arranging for the three- or four-hour visit, scheduled to take place next week.

The Soviets would have been greeted by the students at an assembly before touring the school visit

ing several classes and settling down to an all-American cheeseburger lunch and making the return trip to Washington, D.C.

"I thought it would be a giveaway, they would say they would do a lot for the spirit of U.S. Soviet relations," she said.

It also would have given the 375 students at the school a cultural lesson they would not likely forget.

After a phone call and a series of

letters to the embassy this summer, Ms. McLoughlin finalized the visit about the time school started.

"They asked me where the school was, I said 'Severn,' and they asked where, so I told it's just a place where people work," Ms. McLoughlin said.

"I never really thought about (the NSA) We're just used to having them here, it's like it's just a place where people work," Ms. McLoughlin said.

The State Department apparently was unaware of the planned visit until Monday afternoon of a couple of newspapers reported the visit.

Now, instead of bringing the Soviets to the county, the school may bring the county to the Soviets — Ms. McLoughlin is trying to persuade a visit to the embassy.

"The kids would really enjoy that, the atmosphere in our school is so good, we would be happy to host them," she said.

"I know we'll be able to get a business trip the Soviet team to the school, but to get out for extra money and take that, there would be kind of a loss."

R E M I N G T O N F A R M

This enormous facility is actually larger in size (over 3,000 acres) than Eastern Neck National Wildlife Refuge. It was previously owned by the Remington (fire arms) family. It was purchased by the Dupont Corporation which apparently proceeded with extensive improvements. The precise details and dates have yet to be verified. Years ago, once or twice a year, the Remingtons sponsored a public event with tours and activities. This practice has ceased as the Farm has become more isolated in recent years.

The Remington Farm is not incorporated and therefore no corporate records can be checked and the facility remains very private and off the record. This information needs much more verification at the present time. There is a small portion of the parcel that is a miniature wildlife tour. A 2.3 mile road has numbered points of interest and then you are directed back to the main road. The tour takes about ten minutes. It is estimated that about 200 acres can be observed, the rest is obscured by a heavy tree line.

No other roads were observed. And the parcel, regardless of the other properties, is in itself totally isolated. We noted that a good portion of the property borders on Langford Creek. We have reports from boaters who, while moored on the creek, thought they were observing the Soviet compound which in fact is about 1/4 mile South and on another creek (Corsica) entirely.

From the former Kent County Zoning Commissioner we have learned that the facility has public access (the tour) with some

conference and educational facilities. Researchers observed these facilities labeled "Conference" area as well as a small creekfront caretaker house and maintenance area.

There is supposed to be a large elegant recreational/conference resort accessed by helicopter. During our visit we observed a large Chinook type helicopter approaching what appeared to be Remington property. Although we observed the helicopter from a great distance, it was quite low (300 feet) and descending out of sight. Once again Remington Farms suggests a possible destination for some of the helicopter traffic from the Western shore.

We did not find any large recreational facility nor any other roads or signs leading to the property. It is very isolated. It is in fact a perfect spot for a government/private/Soviet, or a corporate/government facility if one does exist. If the military presence and strange activities on the Eastern Shore are related, then perhaps this corporate learning/recreational facility functions as a sort of an East Coast Bohemian Grove.

T H E S H E A F F E R W I L D L I F E P R E S E R V E

A careful examination of the plat map shows 356.18 adjoining acres known as Peter G. Sheaffer property. The property not only adjoins the Soviet compound, but it surrounds it. "NO TRESPASSING" signs discourage the curious from entering the preserve. Despite all efforts we were unable to view the entire parcel. Eventually we learned that the preserve offers an extremely limited private party hunting service. This service is provided from October through March. No more than twelve hunters are allowed on the property on pre-arranged dates. Quail are raised and hunted on the premises.

Sheaffer is apparently Sheaffer Pen. Once again we observed a corporate involvement in sensitive areas. The Sheaffer/Eton company had previously belonged to Textron. Textron is an enormous, publicly held conglomerate with corporate headquarters in tiny Rhode Island. Among other companies, Textron owns Bell Helicopter.

In August of 1987, Textron placed Sheaffer/Eton with Gefinor, a Swiss holding company. A call to Sheaffer/Eton corporate headquarters in Pittsfield, Massachusetts revealed that no information about Sheaffer/Eton could be disclosed, according to Ed Burns the information officer.

We wondered about the preserve.' Why would the Soviets allow American hunters armed with rifles to shoot game within inches of their private retreat? Why is there nothing more substantial than a chain link fence separating the two properties? We

noticed an unusual feature of the preserve. Robin Cove which is about twenty acres in size shows a permanent bulkhead where it opens onto the Chester River. A call to the Army Corps of Engineers in Baltimore revealed that no permit for the bulkhead is on file. They agree the bulkhead is there as it appears on aerial photographs. They claim that due to an overwhelming workload they would be unable to look further into the matter.

Then we learned something else. During a routine interview with the manager of a local bank, we learned that a Pokerty Farm (Pogardy Farm as he remembered it) is located on Sunset Drive near Centreville. The Pokerty or Pogardy Farm is the government facility for psychic research mentioned previously in the report. The manager explained that he had been given the farm name several months earlier during a rotary club meeting. He stated that he called the telephone number he had received and was told that his services were not needed. Unfortunately he had discarded the telephone number. We found Sunset Drive. It is an unmarked dirt road at the southern end of the Sheaffer preserve. However, we were unable to locate the farm.

On subsequent visits researchers observed the Sheaffer property. We noted numerous vans, cars and trucks entering and leaving the preserve. Their numbers indicated more activity than the private hunting party restriction that they claim. We also learned from Tax Assessment Office records, that \$21,000.00 in improvements had been reported. This figure is odd in light of the bulkhead which, according to the former Kent County zoning director, would cost between 1 million and 2 million dollars.

In February 1989 a researcher visited the Sheaffer Preserve. As soon as he entered the property he was approached by a man who told him to get off the preserve. Although the researcher protested that he only wanted literature about the hunting party service, the man repeated that he was to get off the property at once. The researcher did notice that all three vehicles parked by the preserve office bore dark green diamond stickers. The emblem which appears on the windshield is somewhat flattened in shape and positioned horizontally.

The Sheaffer Wildlife Preserve remains an enigma. Perhaps a local farmer and owner of a competing hunting service summed it up best, "they say they're a hunting service but as long as I've known them they haven't been much interested in having people on the place to hunt or anything else. I could give them a lot of business, but they don't want anything to do with it. I don't know what those people do over there."

E A S T E R N N E C K N A T I O N A L
W I L D L I F E R E F U G E

There are a number of interesting features about this 3000 acre island which is accessible from its northern most tip by a tiny wooden bridge. Only approximately 10 total acres are available for public access, nearly all of the island is off limits. No Trespassing signs warn off any curious expeditions into the woodlands. One of our hardy research investigative crews ventured beyond the cabled barrier into the restricted area all the way to the western shore of the island where they were immediately confronted by security personnel wearing Department of Natural Resources uniforms and were escorted completely off of the island.

The federal government purchased the island property from the state of Maryland in 1963. In an unusual and perhaps unprecedented action, the residents were relocated off of the island to the town of Rock Hall five miles to the north. There were approximately seven farms located on the island at the time.

The island seems harmless enough until the western shore is viewed from the opposite side of the Chester River from Tilghman Neck Road. From that vantage point, our researchers were able to see an array of eight towers ranging in height from 200-300 feet. These towers are nearly impossible to see even during the deciduous winter months due to the expanse of water separating the island from the mainland over in Queen Annes County. They appear to be located on the southeastern section of the island's interior which is restricted from the public.

According to an employee of the local airport, helicopters

fly around the island on occasion. Perhaps they are part of the wildlife management program. It should be noted however that 3.5 miles to the northeast lies Pioneer Point, a site occupied by the Soviet Union.

S U M M I T A I R P O R T

Located on the Delaware/Maryland border north of Centerville lies Summit Airport. The former zoning commissioner of Kent County states that the Central Intelligence Agency owns four large hangars situated on the grounds of the airport. These hangars are locked and are sometimes under armed guard. Supposedly used to house light planes and helicopters, they are believed to be used for training and surveillance purposes.

THE BOHEMIAN GROVE BY THE BAY

Somewhere in the redwood forests of Sonoma County, California lies an enormous secret compound utilized by the powerful, both political and corporate. The facility has been hidden from public view for decades. On May 26, 1987 The LOS ANGELES TIMES ran a front page story on the Bohemian Grove. A 1983 book, WHO REALLY RUNS AMERICA, notes that virtually all major economic policies are formulated at the Bohemian Grove compound.

If an argument can be made that corporate America may be financing the efforts of an administrative cover-up, or MAJI, in exchange for technological advances and certain, tax breaks, then could the Bohemian Grove be an MJ-12 type "Country Club"?

Does corporate America derive and develop alien technology which is contract bid by the government? Is it a situation of give and take? And is it now of the utmost importance to the Soviets to align themselves with the United States. This desire possibly explains an unprecedented reform program and a warming of relationships with the United States. As Timothy Good pointed out in ABOVE TOP SECRET, did Reagan's remarks to Gorbachev, "...if suddenly there was a threat to this world from another species from another planet outside in the universe," suddenly stimulate the Soviet leader to implement "glasnost"? Perhaps so along with economic revitalization, the Soviets may want to combine defenses. Is this why the US Navy conducts Top Secret EMP tests in the shadow of the US/Soviet compound?

Does corporate America know there are aliens? Do they aid and abet the government cover-up with or without this knowledge? Is that why the Duponts, Sheaffer, Textron, and Remingtons appear connected to Pioneer Point? Don't forget that before the Soviets and Charles Rist, Pioneer Point was owned by wealthy and powerful John Jacob Rascob the builder of the Empire State Building. And before the Soviets, Howard Hughes and Resorts International were interested in Pioneer Point. Why is corporate America so interested in the Bay area?

What would happen in this country alone, if an alien presence were admitted? Was, as John Lear implies, the Stock Market correction of two years ago really a test of public reaction from an economic perspective? Has corporate America been informed that the cover-up might cease? Do the people who really run this country fear not only the collapse of social and religious institutions if we learn the truth, but the collapse of their delicate USA/Alien economic inspired arrangement as well? Do they fear public scrutiny?

Is it any coincidence that some 20-40 miles west of the Bohemian Grove facility, lies the little town of Annapolis, California within a map minute of its east coast predecessor? Has corporate America created the east coast equivalent of the Bohemian Grove somewhere 20-40 miles east of Annapolis, Maryland and just south of the Bohemia River, for the specific purpose of determining economic policy in regards to our defense?

Just look at the names Martin/Marietta, Westinghouse, Dupont, Bendix, Gould, McDonnell/Douglas, Honeywell, ARINC, ITT,

and lots more. These are the corporations that provide alot of the defense technology for the government.

The Pioneer Point/Eastern Shore area attracts the global power elite like a magnet. There is the striking National Security Agency presence. And according to Bob Woodward's VEIL, upon speculating about his retirement from the government, one thing that Admiral Bobby Ray Inman wanted to avoid was "...hustling real estate on Maryland's Eastern Shore, a depository for retired high ranking retired military officers."

THE WYE & ASPEN INSTITUTES

On Thursday March 23, 1989 researchers Debby Regimenti and Kathi Perkins set out to observe a Navy facility, Bloodsworth Island. Taking Route 50 toward Easton, MD on the way to Deale Island, the pair decided on the spur of the moment to make a side trip. We had noted the odd presence of two "Institutes" on local maps, but had not attached too much significance in light of our Centreville discoveries. But suddenly it seemed time to investigate the Wye and Aspen Institutes.

Our preliminary research revealed that the Wye Institute is provincial in scope; dealing with the cultural, educational and agricultural issues of only one place in the world - Maryland's Eastern Shore. It is supported by Corning Glass and Dupont. We would learn later that Corning Glass is mentioned more than once in the biographical data one researcher has collected on the original MJ-12 members. The Aspen Institute has relocated a significant amount of its operations from its Colorado origins. Described as a "corporate think tank" it seeks to promote a global understanding of issues through teleconferences and informal seminars and forums. It is self-described as interested in "humanistic studies".

Last year the Aspen Institute gave their Corporate Award to John Phelan. He is the President of the New York Stock Exchange. John Lear claims that the stock market correction of 1987 was a test created to measure public reaction to a possible announcement of an ongoing interaction with an alien culture. Is there a connection?

Vast expanses of farmland and quaint structures marked the fact that we were heading into a carefully planned multi-million dollar compound designed by the power elite of corporate America. Almost by accident we had ventured into a place that may in reality be the elusive "MJ-12 Country Club". It was here on Maryland's Eastern Shore that we would find a link with Roswell, New Mexico and the UFO cover-up.

Our oil man from Roswell, New Mexico appears as the moving force behind the Aspen Institute with whom he has served as President, now Honorary President for decades. He appears to be a prime player in the role the corporations play in perpetuating the cover-up. Without the decades of help corporate America has provided, no cover-up could exist. Could the technologies received in exchange for government co-operation with aliens have been developed and applied for the benefit of society? This could only have been made possible with the co-operation and support of corporate America.

All of a sudden a years worth of UFO activity, military buildup, National Security Agency interests, helicopter traffic, secret Navy testing, and unprecedented Soviet/American interaction began to make sense. This little area by the Chesapeake Bay may well be the command post for corporate America and the cover-up.

Visitors notice first the brand new split rail fencing extending the length of the road. On the vast acreage beyond, graze a genetically pure breed of "super cattle", bearing yellow ear tags. The tags contain computerized information that

automatically supplies data regarding the animal and determines the amount of food required. The herd was purchased by Arthur Houghton of Corning Glass and brought to his opulent estate on the shores of the Wye River decades ago. An annual auction thins the super herd of Angus cattle which provides the source material for genetic studies undertaken by The Institutes and the University of Maryland at the Farm.

Across the road a sign identifies a one story, white farmhouse as the Administrative Office. One researcher entered while the other remained outside and observed a steady stream of Northern Telecom trucks. It is always our policy to obtain any brochures or booklets available. When the first researcher returned empty handed, it was our first sign that YOU AREN'T SUPPOSED TO KNOW ABOUT THIS PLACE.

"They hold conferences", the researcher announced. They wouldn't elaborate and claimed not to have any available literature. We noted that walkie talkies sit on the desks. However, what was most unusual was the enormous poured vault (bank type) that could be seen from the reception area. During a subsequent visit another concrete vault was observed concealed in an equipment and vehicle shelter.

Despite the researcher's further queries as to forum sites and employee retreats, based on her position as a bank Vice President, it was made crystal clear that whatever interest she might represent was of no interest to them. It would make perfect sense to us later on that these people don't bother with local banking or any local businesses. These people represent

institutions like the Chase Manhattan Bank, Citicorp, IBM, ARCO, Dupont, Corning Glass, EXXON, AT&T, Coca Cola, Ciba-Geigy, General Motors, Xerox and The New York Stock Exchange, to mention just a few. But why were they here on the Eastern Shore? And what were they doing here?

Researcher Mandy Johnson, briefcase in hand, visited the Aspen/Wye Institutes' Administrative Office one morning. She had previously contacted the Colorado office and learned that the Aspen Institute awards research grants. Phoning the Colorado office resulted in a recorded message telling her to call the Maryland location. Upon hearing this from Mandy, the secretary claimed that she was mistaken about research grants. Mandy, however, was prepared with specific information received from a Colorado based scientist associated with US WEST, one of the corporate sponsors whose Vice President, Solomon D. Trujillo, serves on the Aspen Board of Trustees. Grudgingly the secretary turned over two brochures and a copy of a newsletter. We had struck gold.

The Institute literature provides a list of Trustees that reads like a Who's Who in corporate America, the scientific community, the academic community and the government. Najeeb Halaby (King Hussein's father-in-law) is there, so are an abundance of former ambassadors and government officials. We noted Henry Kissinger, Karl Menninger, Robert McNamara, ARCO founder Robert O. Anderson and Maurice Strong. Maurice Strong? Where had we heard that name before?

In a conversation with a fellow researcher and expert on the

cattle mutilation phenomena on April 23, 1989, the researcher mentioned that the Aspen Institute had a facility on the Baca Grant Ranch property in Crestone, Colorado. The ranch, owned by Aspen Institute Trustee Maurice Strong, is the location of numerous "lights in the sky" accounts as well some of the earliest reports of cattle mutilations for biogeochemical reasons.

Biogeochemistry is the process by which analysis of salts contained in cattle tissues can pinpoint areas that contain underground oil or mineral reserves. The Institute boasts a strong membership among oil executives. Mr. Strong is a Canadian and an environmentalist. He is also a current Undersecretary of the United Nations, who is associated with the UN World Food Bank Program.

The researcher's information also indicates a possible oil related interest in the mutilations for biogeochemical reasons. But something even more sinister might be taking place. Another harrowing incident was related. In the early 1970's two men from Missouri went on a hunting trip to the Crestone area. The Baca Grant Ranch occupies most of the property in and around the tiny town. The men suddenly found themselves facing an unbelievable sight. Lying against a chain link fence bearing "US GOVERNMENT PROPERTY" signs and topped by barbed wire, were stacks and stacks of skeletal animal remains, all neatly arranged. The pair who had only months before hunted in the same Baca Grant Ranch area had not seen any fencing or signs indicating that any of the area was US GOVERNMENT PROPERTY. A second researcher traveled by

motorcycle to the site at a later date and confirmed that the government property exists. One of the hunters has undergone regression due to an abduction experience in the same Crestone area.

The researcher also indicated that there existed the possibility of a smokescreen. Research strongly indicates that the mutilations are really performed by extraterrestrials. It is possible that corporate and government inspired activities are suggested to divert attention from the real predators. What are the real connections here? Is the "corporate think tank" Institute somehow involved with the government and aliens and cattle mutilations and the cover-up?

It became clear after a trip to the Queen Anne County Tax Office and data received in public information booklets that the Institutes occupy vast acreage (2,500 plus) which house several different facilities. The most accessible facility is the Farm which is jointly managed by the University of Maryland and the Institutes. The Farm sits on beautifully manicured grounds fronted by a pond and an orchard and two helicopter landing pads.

A fence surrounds a weather station used for the collecting of related data. Inside the Farm a wet chemistry lab performs aquaculture and agriculture experiments. They perform plant genetic engineering in an effort to make our planet's food source more disease resistant. Most of all they stress their program in cattle genetics. That's right! The University of Maryland in association with the Aspen Institute and the Wye Institute are

engaged in cattle breeding and genetics! Why? We noted that John Toll, President of the University of Maryland is a Trustee at the corporate "think tank".

Then there is the Manor House about a mile away. The Manor House is an elegant brick mansion set on approximately 1,000 acres of land. A red wind sock indicates a helicopter pad, but that is about all that is visible through the heavily wooded area. A "PRIVATE PROPERTY" sign warns visitors off. A "WILLOW CONSTRUCTION - EASTON, MD" sign indicates that work is underway. We observed that Northern Telecom has installed a housing for cables and wires by the surprisingly rickety entrance gate. Prized Wye Angus graze in close proximity to the electric fencing.

On one occasion researchers observed a fleet of five stretch limousines enter the drive toward the Manor House. On another occasion we observed a jet black "gunship" helicopter land beyond the grove of trees. Still another time we observed two stretch limousines parked further down the road past the Office. Liveried drivers seemed to be waiting for the signal to proceed.

Although it isn't visible we know that further down the main drive and toward the left, on the river, sits the new multi-million dollar Georgian mansion, The River House. The University literature describes the mansion as a joint project of the Aspen Institute with Northern Telecom. Its purpose is to provide a setting for global tele-conferences. The Institute has outposts in Germany, Japan, Italy, England, Korea and France.

Travelling into the woods about one mile away, past the Farm, we observed a country club type compound belonging to the Institute. Tennis courts and bikes could be seen. Paths link numerous contemporary cottages. A huge rustic wood and glass facility centers the property which extends for 62 acres to the water. This place is described as the "Conference Center". Once again security "appears" almost non-existent. However, during one surveillance trip in April 1989, a helicopter repeatedly buzzed the researcher's car then took off for the river. On another occasion two researchers photographed a fleet of four, dark unmarked helicopters pass over the trees at a low altitude. Corporate executives playing tennis didn't seem to notice.

Seminars and forums take place on the premises. The topics participants discuss here and at other Institute locations include: Indochina relations, Pacific Rim concerns, Law & Literature, how to make the most out of philanthropic gestures, the moral and ethical questions raised by advances in biogenetic research, environmental concerns, "strategic realignment of political and economic alliances" and even "How to Think About God".

Our research group has wondered how to think about God as well. Eminent theologians meet at national conferences to re-work our basic concepts of God and Christianity according to a news article headed "Prediction Not Christs",... . Could the rumblings in our national religious community and the personal upheaval of individual religious precepts experienced during "the Age of Aquarius" be in any way linked to the progressive,

humanistic teachings and policies of this Institute?

GNOSTIC GOSPELS is a collection of historical texts which advance a truly divergent theory of God and Christianity. This book written by Elaine Pagels, a Fellow at the Institute, was researched in depth last summer by two members of our group, Mandy Johnson and Mike Regimenti. When their findings were presented to our group we found them a provocative theory in light of claims that Christ was created by extraterrestrials.

In addition to Elaine Pagels' ties to the Institute her husband, Heinz Pagels, was a member of the Board of Trustees. Dr. Pagels was an eloquently gifted theoretical physicist who authored the COSMIC CODE in which he showed that ... "physics is moving toward a new understanding of the Universe." Last July while in Aspen, Colorado attending a Physics Institute seminar, Dr. Pagels died in an unusual climbing accident on Pyramid Peak. His obituary in THE NEW YORK TIMES was written by Walter S. Sullivan, who wrote WE ARE NOT ALONE. This book brought to light the amazing NASA/Brookings Institution study that will be detailed later in this report. Coincidentally in Aspen that same weekend, the Aspen Institute had presented its "How to Think About God" seminar.

According to THE ASPEN IDEA by Sidney Hyman, Robert O. Anderson initiated an executive seminar in 1961 entitled "Understanding of the Role of Science in Society". Notable attendees included Major General William J. Ely (Director of Army Research), Harrison Norton (President of The National Security Agency's "think tank", The Insitiute for Defense Analysis"), Dr.

Eugene Fubini (Deputy Director of Research, Department of Defense) and Walter Sullivan (New York Times Science Editor who three years later would author WE ARE NOT ALONE). The record clearly shows an early and involved connection between the Government Defense establishment and private corporate controlled institutions with a mutual interest in the development and dissemination of technology.

Other participants at these forums and seminars no doubt include other prominent Trustees such as Henry Kissinger, Robert McNamara, William Nitze and Karl Menninger. Menninger's father William, treated Secretary James V. Forrestal (MJ12) in Florida when the decision was made to have Forrestal flown to Bethesda Naval Hospital for psychiatric treatment. Forrestal's subsuequent death was reported to be suicide. At the time of the Roswell, New Mexico crash Karl Menninger was Assistant to the Army Surgeon General. Could he have been involved as a pathologist in the retrieval operations? And then there is seminar attendee Dean Acheson. Acheson was Secretary of State in 1952 when President Harry S. Truman quietly began the National Security Agency. Only two memorandums announcing the NSA's birth were sent and Dean Acheson was the recipient of one of them.

Other Institute seminar attendees include Soviet delegates, State Department officials, Department of the Army officials, corporate leaders, union leaders, artists, actors and literary greats. This is a group of the power elite of the world who have created their own arena for the express purpose of solving world

issues, becoming "enlightened" and to learn how to relate more effectively to the work forces they command. Is it possible that the problems and policy decisions regarding the cover-up of a relationship with an alien culture are of paramount importance?

On the main road bearing right past the Manor House continue to Wye Island. This little island is peculiar. The University/Institutes own acreage on the Island, where agricultural experiments are conducted. There are a handful of private owners and the State of Maryland Department of Natural Resources owns the rest. That same Department of Natural Resources owns the unusual property on Cox Neck Road.

DNR Rangers manage the area. A little ranch house is identified as the Office but on four separate trips we were unable to find anyone there. The Maryland Historical Trust records indicate that Wye Hall has a rich history. It is located in an area marked with a sign that reads "RESTRICTED AREA, AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY". No one will tell us what the estate is used for. It backs up to the Narrows where nautical charts indicate that three submerged piles provide a hazard in the Narrows between the Wye Hall and the back edge of the Institute property. The two properties practically touch each other. Signs on the island bridge and posted elsewhere indicate that "LAUNCHING OF BOATS IS PROHIBITED". This, however, does not apply to those connected to the Department of Natural Resources or the Institutes. We noted that all related properties sport docks and boats.

On one trip to the Island two researchers viewing the fleet

of four helicopters over the woods, watched as a DNR ranger sped from the Island to the middle of the bridge. The ranger then jumped out of her truck and proceeded to view the Institute property for several minutes through binoculars. Something had clearly attracted her interest, or perhaps it is her job to observe the activities at the Aspen Institute.

The researchers continued onto the Island which we later learned served as the recreational compound for Soviet diplomats in the late 60's prior to their purchase of the Pioneer Point property they use today. Travelling down the isolated road a facility called the "DNR CONFERENCE LODGE, NO PUBLIC ACCESS" was discovered. Researchers ignored the signs during one trip and drove to the lodge. Several tiny clapboard cottages sit on the water. A main building centers the secluded area. Trucks and cars filled the parking lot. At the present time a women's international sailing team is housed there courtesy of Maryland's taxpayers. Further on we noted a preponderance of telephone housing at intervals along the road. Bob Oechsler examined one unit and was surprised to find wiring indicating 52 telephone lines. All of this for five residents, a tiny lodge and, at the end of the Island, another "RESTRICTED AREA" called Wye Point Farm. What is this Island really used for?

As of April 1989 the State of Maryland is about to replace the wooden bridge to the island. Phone lines are being replaced and sunk into the Narrows in preparation. Red flags denoting line tracks appear on University/Institute and DNR property that appears vacant. Apparently someone is anticipating a buildup for

some reason. Why? Does it have anything to do with the Institutes' activities?

What extra-ordinary circumstances would lure intellectuals, philosophers, corporate power brokers, diplomats and scientific researchers to Maryland's Eastern Shore? Its strategic benefit is obvious, it is only a short helicopter ride from Washington DC and a five minute drive from the Soviet compound on Pioneer Point. Could it be that this elite group is engaged in advising the world powers on how to educate or sensitize the public to a profound truth that will affect all of humanity? Does such sensitization begin first with the executives and political leaders then trickle down to the rest of us? Do they accomplish this ultimate goal while sponsoring research to improve the world food source, a necessary and humanistic effort to improve conditions worldwide?


Is it a co-incidence that a revolutionary micro-wave scalpel capable of the sort precise incisions associated with the cattle mutilation phenomenon, was invented by a University of Maryland doctor? Are they also attempting to sate the appetite of the alien culture with whom they inter-act, one in need of particular derivatives found primarily in animal tissues? Is this possibility suggested by an impressive collection of evidence that indicates an extraterrestrial explanation for the cattle mutilations? We note a consistent interest regarding cattle breeding and genetics with the principals involved with both the Wye and Aspen Institutes.

Perhaps this long co-operation fraught with complexities and

complicated by an imposed covertness, finds its nerve center on Maryland's Eastern Shore. Perhaps the principal players seek now to lift the veil of secrecy. Advances in communications technology, satellites, micro-electronics, computers, fiber optics, laser technology and much more provide now almost anyone in any part of the world access to information. But what information do the players in this intricately tangled web wish to convey? In the final equation is this information the truth about ourselves and our place in the cosmos? Time will tell.

A BREED APART

Wye Black Angus attract breeders from across the country

Beef on our dinner tables is leaner and beef cattle are more efficient meat producers thanks to research conducted on the Wye Angus herd raised by the University of Maryland Foundation Inc. And the university likes to share its knowledge with breeders across the state and country.

Angus cattle breeders from across the country bid on 55 cattle from the world-famous Wye Angus herd Monday at the institute near Queenstown.

The quality of research and the purebred, genetic lineage dating back 40 years earned the herd its reputation, said Robert Smith, president of the university foundation which owns and operates the Wye Angus Program.

The records on the herd provide cattle farmers with the performance of the animal — how efficient it is at converting feed to beef, how large its young are and how fast they grow.

"The herd, as it now stands with all its records, is probably worth \$4 million to \$5 million," Smith said.

There are about 300 animals in the herd.

Considering the dedication of the man responsible, the reputation of the herd is not surprising.

Arthur A. Houghton, chairman of Corning Glass and founder of Steuben, donated the herd to the foundation in 1979. Houghton lives in Queenstown.

"His whole life's been dedicated to quality. He founded Steuben, the finest quality crystal, he lives in the finest part

of the country and created the finest herd in the world," Smith said. Houghton also created the Wye Institute and is responsible for the think-tank, Aspen Institute for Humanistic Studies, located on the Eastern Shore, he said.

Houghton was the auctioneer at the first auction in 1979. Sales totalled more than \$1 million because it was the first time Wye Angus were offered for sale, Smith said.


The \$141,050 brought in at the 11th annual sale was much less than the first sale because the cattle are not as rare, he said.

Cows with calves were sold for about \$5,200 while yearling bulls went for \$1,000 each. Heifers or females that haven't born calves yet went for \$3,100.

But price is not everything. "Part of the university's outreach is to get better cattle producers throughout the state and across the country. It doesn't make any difference whether they make money," said Paul Gunther, University of Maryland Extension agent for Queen Anne's County.

The herd is not given any growth regulation drugs, but is fed grain grown on the 850-acre farm, Gunther said. The herd is bred to produce cows with good maternal instincts, docile temperaments and a more rapid daily weight gain.

Instead of gaining one pound a day, the Wye Angus gain about two pounds a day, Gunther said, pointing out the computerized grain feeder system that constantly reads the animal's ear tag and weighs its feed.

T H E B R O O K I N G S I N S T I T U T I O N

In our earlier focus on Roswell, New Mexico and our review of William Moore's research, we decided to take a closer look into the referenced Gerald Light letter of April 16, 1954. Moore had indicated that the most interesting thing about Light's letter was the reference to President Eisenhower's visit to Muroc. We contacted Borderland Sciences Research Foundation director Thomas J. Brown in order to obtain more details on Meade Layne and the Gerald Light letter. Brown indicated that the letter was indeed genuine, but that he tended to agree with Moore that the content of the letter was in question as a result of Light's philosophical bent toward ether physics. He was kind enough to send us a copy of the original two-page letter, only one page of which was published in THE ROSWELL INCIDENT.

In spite of prior analysis, it became our opinion that the detail surrounding the Light visit to Muroc and the particular individuals in that party make a great deal of sense when viewed from another perspective. First, it is doubtful that Light could have developed such an emotional opinion about the events from the plane of an astral projection as has been suggested by one researcher. Second, in light of the details arising out of the abduction phenomena, his assertion about categorizing the extraterrestrials as Etherians may not be that far fetched. And lastly, if you wanted to survey a microcosm of differing factions of society in order to develop a profile on public reaction, why not select representatives from those factions such as Gerald Light (an esoteric writer), Franklin Allen (a major publications journalist), James F.A. McIntyre (Bishop of the local diocese,

later Cardinal), and Edwin Nourse (A Brookings "think tank" Vice President and Presidential Financial Advisor).

Our interest centered on Edwin Nourse. The only question mark we could find in the Light letter was his reference to Nourse's Brookings Institute attachment. The reference seemed to indicate a current affiliation. We subsequently learned that his affiliation with the Brookings Institution had to be terminated in 1946 when he took on the post of chairman of the Council on Economic Advisers for President Truman. He held the post until 1949 when he disappeared from public view. As an economic advisor, his reaction to exposure to an extraterrestrial environment might be most valuable. Nourse also had an expertise in cattle breeding. His papers on cattle breeding suggest a concerted interest in genetics, an issue all of the Institutions we researched shared.

On April 8th of 1989, we learned of an upcoming lecture at St. John's College library in Annapolis, Maryland. Louis W. Cabot, chairman of the board of trustees of the Brookings Institute, a Washington-based public policy think tank, was to speak on the institute. We attended the lecture hoping to get Mr. Cabot's reaction to the Light letter claim regarding Nourse. Cabot, who has been a trustee of the institute for thirty years might have some knowledge as to any papers written by Nourse relating to his visit to Muroc. Although he was unable to provide us with any answers regarding Nourse, he was kind enough to request our references and promised to research the issue. Taking advantage of the opportunity, we also inquired about Brookings with respect to other related issues and studies. He

indicated that Brookings has never conducted any studies other than overt and that he did not take the issue of "otherplane aeroforms" and extraterrestrials seriously. He began to recant when it was pointed out that the President of the United States apparently did take the issue seriously, he indicated that he was uninformed and could not qualify an opinion.

Mr. Cabot offered a variety of literature at the informal symposium which would provide us with a great deal of investigation material. One such publication was a printing of his remarks less than three months earlier on the occasion of the Benjamin Rush awards presentation held at Dickinson College in Carlisle, Pennsylvania on January 26, 1989. The publication entitled "Sci-Humanists Unite - Bridging the Culture Gap", includes some rather provocative comments in light of his more recent commentary at Saint John's College. "I have believed for some years that the next event to really shake the world, assuming we avoid blowing ourselves up, will be when we learn there is some finite being out there ... are there not creatures somewhere able to think and communicate like man ... when we do get the news, who will we think man is then? How will we see his place in the universe then?" These comments are alarming and disconcerting considering that he now says he doesn't take the issue seriously and is uninformed.

He also wrote about genetics and gives a dissertation on human brain genetics, the altering of the genoma (genetic code). He pointed out that in the last million years, the human brain increased in size by only half. When man begins to alter man by his own hand, the rate of evolution can be tens of thousands

times faster. He concludes with the question, "Will transgenic man find a benevolent way to manage his own evolution?"

Within one week of the Saint John's College forum, Mr. Cabot responded and indicated to his surprise that the institute librarian was unable to find any of Nourse's papers. He learned they were on file at the Truman Library in Missouri. He also seemed to dismiss Berlitz as one who chases unsolved mysteries.

By the time we received Mr. Cabot's letter, we were fully prepared to respond having completed a great deal of research on the institute in the interim. Our discoveries had included more connections with the Aspen Institute on the Eastern Shore, an issue we discussed at Saint John's. Mr. Cabot had indicated that at one point there was discussion of a merger, but it died as a result of philosophical differences. The Brookings Board of Trustees is comprised of some notables that didn't seem to coincide with the purposes of the institute. The corporate connections were quite evident with even our oil man's corporate representative present and most of the others we had researched and connected directly or indirectly to the extraterrestrial phenomenon. For example, Levi Strauss & Company whose CEO is a Brookings Trustee has an "America is hosting EBEs" commercial currently running on Cable News Network. Of course the more compelling question is; What is Bobby Ray Inman doing on the Brookings Institution Board of Trustees? Remember, Mr. Cabot told us they don't do covert studies!

Another provocative connection with the Brookings Institution, extraterrestrials, and the government unfolded when Bob Oechsler received a call from Lucius Farish, host of the

Ozark UFO Conference. In a discussion about Brookings, the name Walter Sullivan was referenced in a titled work, WE ARE NOT ALONE, written by the New York Times science editor in 1964. The work included a reference to a study conducted by the Brookings Institution for NASA called "Proposed Studies on the Implications of Peaceful Space Activities For Human Affairs" by Donald N. Michael. This study highly recommended additional research on the possibility of social apocolypse if humanity were informed of contact with a superior extraterrestrial culture.

One of our ever diligent researchers, Mike Regimenti, made a keen observation. Could that be the same Walter Sullivan who wrote the New York Times obituary for Heinz Pagels? While waiting for WE ARE NOT ALONE to arrive, Bob Oechsler called Sullivan at the New York Times to find out more about the Brookings study and to check on the Pagels connection. Sullivan not only confirmed the study, but also went into great detail about how much he loved the Wye Plantation and the Aspen Institute and elaborated on some of the more esoteric aspects surrounding the death of his good friend Heinz Pagels.

Through a MUFON researcher in Michigan, we were able to track down Donald Michael who is now residing on the west coast. He indicated that the involvement in the extraterrestrial phenomenon on the part of institutions and Corporate America was so lengthy and prevalent as to be at this point in time indistinguishable. Once again we note that the cover-up is both subtle and far reaching. The fact is that the environment becomes somewhat unrelated to the phenomenon itself as a result of compartmentalization. Most of the elements involved, don't

realize they are involved and usually distance themselves from such suggestion to avoid notoriety.

By 1957 the United States was hard at work attempting to grasp the roots of the technology windfall from the Roswell and other extraterrestrial findings. On October 4th that year, the Russians launched the first of ten Sputnik (-traveler-) satellites beginning a new era in space. By the time the first Sputnik fell to earth on January 4th, 1958, the U.S. Congress was preparing the final touches on the legislation that would launch the National Aeronautics and Space Act on July 29, 1958. The act called for long range studies of the benefits and problems to be expected from space activities. In November of 1959, with birth certificate in hand, NASA contracted with the Brookings Institution to undertake the design of a comprehensive and long-term program of research and study regarding the social, economic, political, legal, and international implications of the use of space for peaceful and scientific purposes.

The implications regarding the discovery of extraterrestrial life was given the highest priority of recommendation for further study. Many of the less than cryptic references in the study expressed great concern about the possibility of facing social apocalypse resulting from the public disclosure regarding the face to face contact with an extraterrestrial culture. The issue of withholding such information from the public was given credence in light of comparable historical precedence. The study indicated that Anthropological files contain many examples of societies, sure of their place in the universe, which have disintegrated when they have had to associate with previously

unfamiliar societies espousing different ideas and different life ways; others that survived such an experience usually did so by paying the price of changes in values and attitudes and behavior. According to the report, since the consequences of such a discovery are presently unpredictable because of our limited knowledge of behavior under even an approximation of such dramatic circumstances, two research areas were recommended and given the highest priority of the entire study.

1. Continuing studies to determine emotional and intellectual understanding and attitudes - and successive alterations of them if any - regarding the possibility and consequences of discovering intelligent extraterrestrial life.

2. Historical and empirical studies of the behavior of peoples and their leaders when confronted with dramatic and unfamiliar events or social pressures.....

The recommendations go on to explore how to release the news of an encounter to the public - or withhold it, if this is deemed advisable. The influence on international relations might be revolutionary as the discovery of alien beings might lead to greater unity of men on earth, based on the 'oneness' of man or on the age-old assumption that any stranger is threatening. It was pointed out that the positions of the major American religious denominations, the Christian sects, and the eastern religions need elucidation on the matter of extraterrestrial life.

An interesting footnote analogy to the study revealed the perspective on comparison to the alien culture three decades ago. A possible but not completely satisfactory means for making the

possibility "real" for many people would be to confront them with (then) present speculations about the I.Q. of the porpoise and to encourage them to expand on the implications of this situation. Unfortunately, it was noted, the semantics of "animal," at least for Americans, is such that even a human level I.Q. would not be as threatening as a "being" which wasn't an earth animal.

Concern was expressed about the human reaction to the famed broadcast and Hadley Cantrel's study "Invasion from Mars". The overall study covers many issues of concern including the benefits and development of technologies and the intricacies of corporate capitalistic concerns as it relates to the general public. The study was indeed thoroughly comprehensive. It was published in December of 1960 and released in a report to the Committee on Science and Astronautics, U.S. House of Representatives, Eighty Seventh Congress, First Session on March 24, 1961.

How did they know it would imply a high degree of change in world conditions? How did they know there would be by-products without knowing we would take possession of the technology by retrieval? Since high priority research recommendations were noted relevant to the extraterrestrial phenomenon, can we assume that NASA, with or without the knowledge of congress, further contracted for such studies? It would seem less than prudent not to follow-up on the recommendations from a paid study conducted by over two hundred of the country's top specialists. We hope to learn if that was the case through an FOIA request to NASA.

My dear Friend: I have just returned from Muroc. The report is true---
devastatingly true!

I made the journey in company with Franklin Allen of the Hearst papers and
Edwin Nourse of Brookings Institute (Truman's erstwhile financial adviser)
and Bishop MacIntyre of L.A. (confidential names, for the present, please.)

When we were allowed to enter the restricted section, (after about six hours
in which we were checked on every possible item, event, incident and aspect
of our personal and public lives) I had the distinct feeling that the world
had come to an end with fantastic realism. For I have never seen so many
human beings in a state of complete collapse and confusion as they realized
that their own world had indeed ended with such finality as to beggar descrip-
tion. The reality of "otherplane" aeroforus is now and forever removed from
the realms of speculation and made a rather painful part of the consciousness
of every responsible scientific and political group. ← A

During my two days visit I saw five separate and distinct types of aircraft
being studied and handled by our airforce officials---with the assistance and
permission of The Etherians! I have no words to express my reactions.

It has finally happened. It is now a matter of history.

President Eisenhower, as you may already know, was spirited over to Muroc one
night during his visit to Palm Springs recently. And it is my conviction that
he will ignore the terrific conflict between the various "authorities" and go
directly to the people via radio and television---if the impasse continues
much longer. From what I could gather, an official statement to the country
is being prepared for delivery about the middle of May.

I will leave it to your own excellent powers of deduction to construct a fitting
picture of the mental and emotional pandemonium that is now shattering the con-
sciousness of hundreds of our scientific "authorities" and all the pundits of
the various specialized knowledges that make up our current physics. In some
instances I could not stifle a wave of pity that arose in my own being as I
wrtached the pathetic bewilderment of rather brilliant brains struggling to make
some sort of rational explanation which would enable them to retain their fami-
liar theories and concepts. And I thanked my own destiny for having long ago
pushed me into the metaphysical woods and compelled me to find my way out. To
wtach strong minds cringe before totally irreconcilable aspects of "science" is
not a pleasant thing. I had forgotten how commonplace such things as the dema-
terialization of "solid" objects had become to my own mind. The coming and going
of an etheric, or spirit, body has been so familiar to me these many years I had
just forgotten that such a manifestation could snap the mental balance of a man
not so conditioned. I shall never forget those forty-eight hours at Muroc!

I am now preparing Bulletin #2 for mailing about Monday. I will add my testimony of the Muroc episode, for whatever it may be worth, and then go into some length about the next big move of the Commies to take advantage of the present public concern about the bomb.

My information is that a vigorous campaign will be started immediately to persuade America that Communist domination is much better than total annihilation. This will emanate from various groups of intellectuals who certainly have a case to present.

April 12

Already in TIME/there is this: "In a letter to the N.Y. Times, Author-Critic Lewis Mumford wrote: Submission to Communist totalitarianism would still be far wiser than the final destruction of civilization.... Let us cease all further experiments with even more horrifying weapons of destruction, lest our own self-induced fears further upset our mental balance..... Let us deal with our own massive sins and errors... and have the courage to speak up.... against the methodology of barbarism to which we are now committed. If as a nation we have become mad, it is time for the world to take note of that madness....."

The purpose behind this campaign is something I was warned about nearly 20 years ago. Its particular intent, among other things, is to split the country into as many warring sections as possible. There is, of course, the ancient prophecy of America becoming a land of four separate nations or peoples. These have sometimes, rather simply, been itemized as a north, south, east and west division. And anyone with an ounce of ingenuity can easily fan local differences into a terrible hate.

Then there is the apparent treason of Oppenheimer, and some others. In the next Bulletin I will try to influence as many as possible to dig deeply under the superficial evidence for the real truth--and perhaps this man, and his friends, may not be martyred as others have already been. My instructors assure me that this man is not a Commie, nor even a sympathizer. But overwhelmed with the monster which he had helped to create, he believed that if Russia also had the science to make the bomb it might yet be possible to save civilization, even mankind.

This is a time for a display of that Christian idealism about which we are so proud, lest the jungle consciousness in each of us destroys every vestige of ^{our} sanity ~~in~~

I am working against a deadline to have another pamphlet on Etheria to serve as a companion book to Singa-Skies, when the news breaks next month and mob hysteria follows its traditional course.

This is just a hasty roundup of the matter as it stands now, and I will keep in touch with you for further co-operation. Will you please send me your phone number? It has vanished from my files in the confusion around here.


I have inquired of a couple of people here at Brookings who knew Edwin Nourse and none of them have ever heard of the Roswell incident described in the Berlitz book nor did they ever hear of his interest in "otherplane aeroforms." (Am I correct in understanding that that term is a synonym for UFOs?)

I checked with the Brookings librarian to see whether we have any of Dr. Nourse's papers here at Brookings. The answer is no. The Harry S. Truman Library in Independence, Missouri has a collection of Nourse's papers, but it is not clear from the reference I have whether they cover only his period as chairman of the Council of Economic Advisers, 1946 to 1949, or whether there are papers from other periods in his life. He left Brookings in 1946, which is eight years before the Roswell incident occurred.

Our librarian also gave me a list of other books that Mr. Berlitz has written. In addition to a number of language books, his titles include the Bermuda Triangle; Charles Berlitz's World of Strange Phenomena; the Lost Ship of Noah - In Search of the Ark; the Roswell Incident; Atlantis, the Eighth Continent; Atlantis, the Lost Continent Revealed; the Philadelphia Experiment - Project Invisibility - an Account of a Search for a Secret Navy Wartime Project that May Have Succeeded Too Well; Doomsday 1999; and Mysteries from Forgotten Worlds. It would seem he has a penchant for digging into unsolved mysteries.

I am quite sure no one at Brookings is researching otherplane aeroforms. All of this is not much help to you and I'm afraid we are just one more blind alley. But that's the best I can do under the circumstances. I'm sorry I can't be more helpful.

Dear Mr. Cabot:

It was for me indeed an honor to make your acquaintance last week at Saint Johns College in Annapolis, Maryland. Your comments regarding Public Policy Formulation not only were inspirational, but clearly reflected your depth of knowledge and perspectives on important issues confronting society. In my opinion, institutions such as Brookings bear a critical role in the evolution of our culture by virtue of long range planning and dialectical analysis.

Please accept my commendation for your keen observation at the forum referenced above. The cluster of individuals that you immediately noticed are indeed a special interest group. We are called the Annapolis Research and Study Group and I am the group spokesman and founder. You might recall an inquiry regarding genetics and esoterics from one of our members who specializes in gnostic gospel research. Our group is comprised of scholars, journalists, authors, retired naval officers, NASA engineers, technologists and corporate CEOs. Our primary research centers around the fundamental effects and evolution of our premise which is based on current and historical evidence. That premise deals with the knowledge of the existence of a nonhuman culture or cultures, perhaps ethereal, perhaps dimensional, but certainly physical as impacted by the evidence.

Thank you for your timely response to my inquiries regarding Edwin Nourse. We found it quite curious that a former Vice President of Brookings was named in connection with an alleged exposure to events documented as being two levels above Top Secret. Additionally, his papers on cattle breeding suggested an interest in genetics which we've found to be closely related to this phenomenon.

Your question regarding your understanding that the term "otherplane areoforms" is synonymous with the acronym UFOs is of course supposition, although I do concur with your conjecture. The author of the reference is deceased and therefore cannot be queried on his meaning.

Our investigation into "The Roswell Incident" has revealed that while Mr. Berlitz is the titled co-author, the case research

and all of the interviews were conducted by William Moore (co-author) and Stanton Friedman (nuclear physicist). William Moore was also instrumental in the research behind "The Philadelphia Experiment". The current director of Borderland Sciences Research Foundation testifies to the authenticity of the Gerald Light letter. We will research the Truman Library as funds and access permit to review the papers of Edwin Nourse.

My question related to activities and research of a covert nature was an outcropping of our discoveries. It seems that research and analysis connected with this phenomenon is typically conducted in great secrecy. The reasons and importance for this measure should be obvious to anyone who looks closely enough. In light of the fact that Bobby Ray Inman (Admiral, USN Retired) is one of The Brookings Institution Board of Trustee members and former director of the National Security Agency, it seems pertinent to inquire of his involvement there. I have personal knowledge of his awareness of activities related to issues involving the alien phenomenon.

With all due respect, our research into The Brookings Institution has indeed "not" been a blind alley. Your remarks at Saint Johns College contrast significantly with your published comments less than three months earlier at Dickinson College. We found your belief in some finite being and your commentary on genetics most compelling. Granted that your personal views and the activities of associates and trustees of The Brookings Institution don't necessarily reflect the quest and purview of your organization's current and past objectives.

We noted with interest however the current advertisement on CNN Headline News regarding Levi "Dockers" trousers. There are two versions of the commercial using the same dialogue which approximates the following. 'Does anyone believe in UFOs? (general concensus affirmative) ... America is hosting ebes! What are ebes? Ebes are extraterrestrial beings and America is hosting them! Ooooh, eebees geebees.' The background for this type of dialogue may have come from the October 14, 1987 nationwide broadcast of "UFO Cover-up, LIVE" with the reference by a government intelligence officer. The acronym EBE was coined by Dr. Detlav Bronk in the late 40's or early 50's and stands for Extraterrestrial Biological Entities. You no doubt are aware that the President and CEO of Levi Strauss & Company is on your Board of Trustees.

We look forward to your further response. The enclosed photographic material has been scientifically and exhaustively authenticated. There are over 80 photos taken by various individuals at this locale during the past 18 months as well as videotape depicting the same objects. A gift of our appreciation in thanks for your consideration. We would be pleased to keep you apprised of our findings.

UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

The information contained here has been compiled to respond to queries on Unidentified Flying Objects directed to the White House as well as NASA.

NASA is the focal point for answering public inquiries to the White House relating to UFOs. NASA is not engaged in a research program involving these phenomena, nor is any other government agency.


BACKGROUND

In July of 1977, Dr. Frank Press, Director of Science and Technology Policy, Executive Office of the President, wrote to Dr. Robert A. Frosch, the NASA Administrator, suggesting NASA should answer all UFO-related mail and also to consider whether NASA should conduct an active research program on UFOs. In a letter dated December 21, 1977, Dr. Frosch agreed that NASA will continue to respond to UFO-related mail as it has in the past and, if a new element of hard evidence that UFOs exist is brought to NASA's attention from a credible source, NASA will analyze the unexplained organic or inorganic sample and report its findings.

Quoting from Dr. Frosch's December 21 letter: "...If some new element of hard evidence is brought to our attention in the future, it would be entirely appropriate for a NASA laboratory to analyze and report upon an otherwise unexplained organic or inorganic sample; we stand ready to respond to any bona fide physical evidence from credible sources. We intend to leave the door clearly open for such a possibility.

"We have given considerable thought to the question of what else the United States might and should do in the area of UFO research. There is an absence of tangible or physical evidence available for thorough laboratory analysis. And, because of the absence of such evidence, we have not been able to devise a sound scientific procedure for investigating these phenomena. To proceed on a research task without a sound disciplinary framework and an exploratory technique in mind would be wasteful and probably unproductive.

GALILEO TO ORBIT JUPITER

The Magellan probe to Venus, launched aboard the shuttle Atlantis early this month, is a trailblazer for a new generation of American robot explorers waiting to be dispatched.

At the same time, five spacecraft launched in the mid-1970s to investigate various planets are still hard at work. Pioneer 10 is the longest-ranging object launched from Earth. Now 4.4 billion miles away, it passed beyond the planets in 1983. Pioneer 11 and Voyager 1 are at least 3.4 billion miles distant. The craft are headed in three directions into interstellar space, sending back information as they move farther away. Scientists hope they will eventually discover the boundary, known as the heliopause, where the influence of the sun's sphere of energy ends.

The Pioneer Venus Orbiter is circling Earth's sister planet, assembling a history of cloud circulation in the upper atmosphere and solar winds in the region.

This August, Voyager 2 is expected to complete its grand tour of the huge outer planets with a major milestone: the first encounter by a craft from Earth with the planet Neptune.

The Galileo spacecraft, headed for Jupiter, is at Cape Canaveral being readied for an October launch. Waiting in line is a joint mission of the European Space Agency and NASA: the Ulysses probe to the sun.

The Mars Observer, scheduled for launch in 1992 aboard a Titan booster, is to orbit the red planet for two Earth years. Also approved, but awaiting funding by Congress, are missions to rendezvous with and "harpoon" a comet, set for launch in 1995, and to study Saturn and its moon Titan, set for launch in 1996. The Lunar Observer, which would orbit the moon for a year, is on NASA's "wish list" but has not been approved by the administration.

C L O S I N G T H E L O O P

Even without immediate proof of a follow-up study to the Brookings Institution Report to NASA and Congress, the evidence in society today is quite clear. The implications were taken seriously and groundwork so painstakingly laid out over the three decades since is quite obvious today. The struggle to maintain secrecy among the elite falls into the category of timing the indoctrination of release program, not in the issue of whether or not to inform the public. S U B L I M I N A L M E D I A

Once it was determined what we were up against and the studies conducted to determine how to handle the problems with the optimum chance for survival as a society, the next step in the process was to indoctrinate the society, to prepare us for

the reality and confrontation to the fact that we are no longer the most evolved and advanced species known to man. The terms intelligence and morality cannot be given credence in this equation as they are a product of our own cultural evolution and not that of an extraterrestrial one.

The indoctrination begins with a series of movies. Movies are a great way to stimulate the creative elements of the human brain and to sow the seeds of subliminal suggestion. A sort of auto-conditioning program. Movies are always watched in darkness, thereby creating a perfectly focused environment essential for optimum subliminal education. Sublimation works best when one is not cognizant of deception. Movies such as "The Day the Earth Stood Still" would be an excellent beginning to show the frailty of human ethics when confronted by the unknown. It demonstrates the epitome of hypocrisy in a society that preaches morality and then shoots the visitor without provocation. The movie was released in 1951, one year before the Flying Saucer flights over the nation's capital, and one before President Truman created the National Security Agency in the last weeks of his administration, an action that ensured the secrecy of the ultimate encounter for mankind. History will show that it was Truman who had the foresight to demand calculated analysis before the creation of havoc could ensue. His financial advisor, Edwin Nourse also of the Brookings Institution, would two years later during the Eisenhower Administration observe first hand the ongoing problems of contact with the extraterrestrials and take part in the efforts to resolve the phenomenon in the minds of humankind.

The subliminal effects of movies like "Star Wars" and "Close Encounters of the Third Kind" and later "Strange Invaders" would serve to acclimate the public to the possibilities of extraterrestrial existence. By the 1980's other uses of subliminal media would come into play. The television offers another such opportunity with a fixed concentration aspect. References to aliens and abductions would show up on popular programs such as Dynasty with a beautiful craft disabling the victim's car on a lonely road and catatonically drawing out the victim with the deftness of a mythological Siren. Matt Houston, another prime-time star, was abducted by little gray aliens with large heads, and even suffered a "Missing Time" experience.

Television commercials are a natural hotbed of subliminally imposed education. Most of us tune out the commercials and do something else during the time transition. As a result the networks automatically increase the audio output to compensate for the added distance from the tube, creating a most effective environment for message implantation. It's no wonder the cost of television advertising is so astronomically high, it is effective. Commercials involving Reese's Pieces, Tropicana Orange Juice, Levi's Dockers slacks, Radio Shack stores, Minolta Cameras, and Edy's Ice Cream have all received substantial play in recent months and all have explicit references and themes centered on the extraterrestrial phenomenon.

Even our children are regularly exposed to the phenomena through cartoons like Gumby and his abduction, and Dennis the Menace, a veritable cartoon institution, with his whole gang abducted by benevolent space beings. These events are not the product of chance or popularity. It is the product of a well thought out indoctrination program. The announcements we've all been looking for have been unfolding under our very noses for quite a number of years. It's more noticeable now because the frequency has been increased and so has the alien presence.

T h e I n n e r C i r l e

On Friday the Thirteenth, in May of 1988 when Bob Oechsler first met with Admiral Bobby Ray Inman at the ground breaking for the new University of Maryland Science and Technology Center, he had but an inkling that the man standing in front of him was in reality the quintessential controller of the present day plans for managing the most important project to face mankind. One year later our research has revealed a closer look at his initiation and involvement in the cover-up.

He was born on April 4th, 1931 and graduated from college at the age of nineteen with a BA from the University of Texas in 1950. He entered the U.S. Navy in 1952 advancing to the rank of Admiral in 1981. Twenty years after entering the Navy, he graduated from the National War College in 1972. He was the Assistant to the Naval Attache in Stockholm from 1965 to 1967. No records are available for his service assignments from 1968 through 1971. From 1972 to 1974 he was the Assistant to the Chief of Staff of Intelligence, Office of the Commander of the

Pacific Fleet. (Petty Officer William Cooper reported access to UFO related documents under this command including the much discussed MJ-12 documents.) Inman was the Director of Naval Intelligence from 1974 to 1976 before moving on to become Vice Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency from 1976 to 1977. He became the Director of the National Security Agency in 1977 holding that post until 1981 when he attained the rank of Admiral and became the Deputy Director of the Central Intelligence Agency. He retired from government service in 1982 and became the CEO for MCC (Microelectronics and Computer Technology Corporation). MCC is a private sector joint venture supported by and share funded by the government and corporate shareholders. The venture was motivated by the Japanese 5th generation Artificial Intelligence Computer Project. The firm's focus was the next generation of VSLI, Very Large Scale Intergration. Inman's current involvement has him presiding over Westmark Systems, Incorporated. He is registered as Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer, a spokesman refers to the firm as a "holding company".

During our research we found a note of intrigue involving Inman's stint at the National Security Agency. We learned that he succeeded General Lew Allen who went on to become the current Director of the Jet Propulsion Laboratory (JPL) in Los Angeles, California. On October 14th, 1988 when the program UFO Cover-up, Live was broadcast, JPL's Dr. Robert' Nathan came on the air in an attempt to debunk the Gulf Breeze photographs by saying that "they just don't check out". Bob Oechsler reported that he had personal involvement with Nathan's attempts at analysis of those

photos and supplied him with all of the evidence necessary to reverse that type of commentary. Nathan instead chose to show old black and white photos giving a self contradictory analysis. It should be clear now that it was only his job to report that he could not prove them to be authentic. After all, it is still a cover-up and balance has always been the order of day.

T h e N a t i o n a l S e c u r i t y A g e n c y

Because of its numerous Chesapeake Bay area sites, we decided to probe further into the National Security Agency and its origins. The genesis of NSA as it has usually been called occurred in 1952 with the creation of a memorandum and a secret code word (possibly "Majority") by President Truman. Highly recommended reading for all ufologists and interested parties is **THE PUZZLE PALACE** by James Bamford. Quoting from chapter 1, Birth:

"At 12:01 on the morning of November 4, 1952, a new federal agency was born. Unlike other such bureaucratic births, however, this one arrived in silence. No news coverage, no congressional debate, no press announcement, not even the whisper of a rumor. Nor could any mention of the new organization be found in the **Government Organization Manual** or the **Federal Register** or the **Congressional Record**. Equally invisible were the new agency's director, its numerous buildings, and its ten thousand employees.

Eleven days earlier, on October 24, President Harry S. Truman scratched his signature on the bottom of a seven-page presidential memorandum addressed to Secretary of State Dean G. Acheson (who later participated in Aspen Institute forums) and

Secretary of Defense Robert A. Lovett. Classified top secret and stamped with a code word that was itself classified, the order directed the establishment of an agency to be known as the National Security Agency. It was the birth certificate for America's newest and most secret agency, so secret in fact that only a handful in the government would be permitted to know of its existence. Even the date set for its birth was most likely designed for maximum secrecy: should any hint of its creation leak out, it would surely be swallowed up in the other news of the day - the presidential election of 1952."

Fourteen days later the briefing document to President-Elect Eisenhower was prepared, November 18, 1952. Truman knew at that time that he was no longer to be President and his final action would be to ensure perpetuation of the cover-up by the creation of the National Security Agency.

At the core of the National Security Agency was its "think tank", the Institute for Defense Analysis. During Admiral Inman's tenure there, he fought a long and protracted battle with the scientific community to protect the nation's "crypto" technology secrets and demanded that NSA have access to any and all such technology developments in the interests of national security. It was essential to the cover-up.

His efforts have today developed into an environment conducive to a working relationship between the factions of technology, corporations, government, military, and institutional education. They have all settled their differences and listed their priorities. Here in the Chesapeake Bay area we discovered the Hub for the 21st Century Campus of the Future, the University

of Maryland Science and Technology Center, anchored by the Institute for Defense Analysis.

T h e H u b o f C o n t r o l

Located in the heart of the Chesapeake Triange, called in fact the Golden Triangle, lies the University of Maryland Science and Technology Center with its seven campus complex currently under construction. This is the same location where the dedication took place one year ago involving Bob Oechsler's encounter with Admiral Bobby Ray Inman. Anchored in the Federal Contractors Campus is the Institute for Defense Analysis, the NSA "think tank" whose headquarters is just eight miles to the north. IDA houses the world's largest and most advanced Top Secret Supercomputing Research Center. NSA now plans to make their own micro chips in an in-house facility at Fort George G. Meade which secures the headquarters facility. Bob Oechsler is the MUFON State Section Director for that county. NSA employee Howell McConnel is the MUFON State Section Director for Prince George County, home of the new science and technology center complex housing IDA.

The facilities complex is adjacent to the Air Force Transmitter Station which has undergone major upgrading recently. Space for the 21st Century is the theme at the University of Maryland Science and Technology Center where technology is developed, researched and disseminated. Telecommunications and Agricultural Experimentation facilities will be available there as well as housing for Institutions, Federal Contractors, Laboratories, Schools, and Government Agencies all in one super complex. Typical discoveries from the research include such

things as a microwave scalpel which causes little or no bleeding.

The President of the University of Maryland, John S. Toll is a member on the Board of Trustees for the Aspen Institute on the Eastern Shore. The University of Maryland has helped Ford Motor Company design the Taurus (saving them millions of dollars) with the aid of their famous wind tunnel, they've cloned interferon for Dupont, developed new instrumentation for cutting casting material with Black & Decker, and even developed cattle saving research on their nine research farms covering 3000 acres. They even have a worldwide research effort on every continent and in 22 countries. This is the Hub of the 21st Century.

T h e F i n a l M e r g e r s

Aside from Admiral Inman's multiple involvements with the Brookings Institution, the Navy, The Federal Government Security Agencies, the Educational Institutions and Corporate America, there are other notable mergers taking place frequently. One such merger involves Forbes Magazine which for eight years attacked President Reagan's Defense Programs and focused in particular on Secretary of Defense Casper Weinberger who finally left the administration after the bombing in Libya.


In February 1989, Malcolm Forbes who one researcher claims to have observed on the Aspen Institute grounds, announced that Weinberger would be assuming the position of Editor in Chief of Forbes Magazine, the most elite and influential corporate magazine in the world. On ABC's Good Morning America program, both Forbes and Weinberger attempted to explain to host Joan Lunden the reasons for their unorthodox new partnership. Lunden


pointed out that Weinberger possessed absolutely no journalistic experience. Forbes grinned and explained that although that was indeed true, he thought that Weinberger would do just fine.

The validity of a cover-up involving the government and corporate America may be a justifiable consideration, and the controlled public disclosure of an encounter with an advanced extraterrestrial culture may be a valid alternative considering the historical precedence. However, although we can't determine if Abraham Lincoln ever saw a flying saucer or UFO or whether he had any encounter with an extraterrestrial culture, one thing is for certain - He knew how the complex workings of government are perceived in the eyes of the public.










Moving technology from labs into world

BALTIMORE (AP) — For more than a decade, John F. Dealy has been crusading for "technology transfer" — the process of moving technological breakthroughs from government laboratories to the marketplace.

The 49-year-old Maryland businessman has preached in favor of increased cooperation between scientists and businessmen in boardrooms, classrooms and banquet halls. He has led study groups, ad hoc committees and corporate programs. He also has issued dozens of recommendations, which sometimes have fallen on deaf ears.

Therefore, he was skeptical when Maryland officials asked him to chair a 16-member panel set up in January to advise Maryland's new Office of Technology Development.

"When I was first approached, I said I would only do it if this time we were going to set about to get something done and not just study things one more time," Dealy told The (Baltimore) Sun in a recent interview.

He accepted the post after state officials convinced him they were serious this time.

Dealy's panel advises a division of the state's Department of Economic and Employment Development created in the fall of 1988 to help businesses turn ideas and inventions into commercial ventures. Gov. William Donald Schaefer has asked for \$1.5 million to be added to the office's current annual budget of \$500,000.

Dealy said Maryland appears ripe to become one of the nation's premier breeding grounds for inventions and new companies founded on those inventions. This would benefit

state residents in the form of greater employment, increased tax revenues and greater attention from being a center of entrepreneurship.

Maryland is home to 48 federal laboratories. The state ranks first in the amount of money the government allocates to its labs; \$2.5 billion in 1987, according to the National Science Foundation.

The Free State also is home to Johns Hopkins University, the single-largest recipient of federal research and development funds among U.S. colleges. The university collects \$500 million a year from the federal government.

"The real kind of art in American business and life is making the connections between research policy and products that will work," said Dealy, who makes a living as senior counsel to a Washington law firm and private management consultant. "And if it's like anything else I've ever done, it's a lot more complicated than it sounds."

Without an established chain of organizations in Maryland that link commercial researchers with their counterparts in federal labs, the familiarity needed to circulate new ideas is missing, Dealy said.

"I don't think it's a straight track. In other words, I don't think you can say, 'If you put X amount of dollars into R&D, you're going to get Y to come out the other end in products,'" said Dealy, who also is professor at Georgetown University's School of Business Administration and Law School.

"But if you've got enough things going in enough areas, and if everyone's got a general consensus, good things happen, and they start to develop."

NSA to construct own chip factory

WASHINGTON (AP) — The super-secret National Security Agency has ordered the construction of its own computer chip manufacturing plant, defense officials said yesterday.

Lt. Col. Keith Schneider, a Pentagon spokesman, said that "in September 1988 National Semiconductor Corp. received an \$85 million contract to construct and operate a microelectronics facility for the U.S. government over a period of 45 months."

A Defense Department official, who spoke on condition that he not be identified, confirmed that the plant was to be built at the NSA's headquarters at Fort Meade, Md., located about halfway between Washington and Baltimore.

The NSA is the nation's biggest intelligence agency, with a work force topping 60,000 employees — more than all other U.S. spy agencies combined — and a budget reported to be upwards of \$10 billion a year.

Its main missions are eavesdropping on communications around the globe, encrypting U.S. communications and cracking foreign codes, as well as safeguarding the security of U.S. computers and communications systems.

James Bamford, an authority on the NSA, has reported that computers cover more than 5½ acres at the agency's headquarters complex.

The NSA's basement, which stretches for city blocks, "undoubtedly holds the largest and most advanced computer operation in the world," Bamford wrote in his 1982 book, "The Puzzle Palace."

The *Baltimore Sun* quoted Mary Coady, a spokeswoman for National Semiconductor, based in Santa Clara, Calif., as saying that in addition to building the computer chip plant "we will also train government personnel in the operation of the facility."

She declined to say when construction might start or how many people were expected to work at the plant.

The *Sun* also quoted George Heilmeler, senior vice president and chief technical officer of Dallas-based Texas Instruments Inc., as saying that the new plant would be "a unique facility with a unique purpose."

By making its own chips at Fort Meade, he said, the government gains more direct control, circumvents the bidding process on essential microchips and increases plant security.

Did security risks prompt NSA plant?

Danger of computer chip 'reverse engineering' cited

WASHINGTON — Electronics specialists say the danger of sensitive technology falling into the wrong hands prompted the National Security Agency to build its own top secret computer chip manufacturing plant.

NSA, the nation's biggest intelligence agency, says the \$85 million microelectronics plant — being built at Fort George G. Meade — represents a "unique capability within the U.S. government."

The move comes amid increasing concern about erosion of American chip-making expertise and manufacturing capacity in the face of stiff competition from Japan, South Korea and other countries.

NSA's main missions are eavesdropping on communications around the globe, encrypting U.S. communications and cracking foreign codes, as well as safeguarding the security of U.S. military computers and communications systems.

To carry out those missions, the Defense Department agency makes heavy use of sophisticated, powerful computers. Author James Bamford, an authority on the NSA, has reported that computers cover more than 5½ acres at the agency's headquarters complex at Fort Meade.

According to Bamford, the NSA has a work force topping 60,000 employees — more than all other U.S. spy agencies combined — and a budget estimated at upwards of \$10 billion a year.

NSA's public affairs office said that in September, the agency signed an \$85 million contract with National Semiconductor Corp. of Santa Clara, Calif., "to instrument and train the government to operate a state-of-the-art microelectronics fabrication facility."

Construction of 60,000 square feet of building space to house the chip-making plant was started in January

1988 by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and completed in October 1988, it said.

"Now National Semiconductor is outfitting the 6-inch silicon wafer fabrication line," the NSA statement said. "Operations are scheduled to begin in 1991, and National Semiconductor will train NSA personnel in the operation of the new facility over a period of 18 months."

The agency said that "building such a facility at Fort Meade will enable NSA to have direct control over the production process and the security procedures necessary for safeguarding the plant. This facility represents a unique capability within the U.S. government."

Paul Hazan, a computer scientist at the Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Laboratory in Laurel said the NSA plant is aimed at dealing with the threat of "reverse engineering" — efforts to figure out the functioning of a computer system by scrutinizing its key components.

"That is why they don't want to have a process made elsewhere. . . . You have coding and so on, and if that falls into the wrong hands, the



As your Wye Institute is associated with the famous "think tank", Aspen Institute, do you now or have you in the past engaged in any intellectual forums that might have pondered the possibility of any current or future relationships with extra-terrestrials and the possible scientific/technological advances which might be derived?

Do you personally subscribe to the theory that extra-terrestrials exist? If Corning Glass had the opportunity to engage in a joint corporate/government project in which your company might be in a position to apply alien derived technologies, do you personally believe your company might participate?

You'll note the enclosed news article in which former President Reagan suggests that a possible alien threat might encourage the peoples of our world to unite. We believe that there might be an ongoing inter-action with an alien culture and that such an inter-action might have already led to technologies and discoveries in many scientific fields.

Reagan: Space invaders would unite all nations

WASHINGTON — President Reagan says he wonders what would happen if the Earth were invaded by "a power from outer space," and imagines that it would unite all nations of the world in a common defense.

He made the comment yesterday in Chicago during a question-and-answer session after a speech about human rights and the Soviet Union.

His telling of the story followed one day after the disclosure that Nancy Reagan has consulted an astrologer about the president's schedule and travel plans. Several members of Congress chided Reagan about the use of astrology and a group of scientists complained that it was a discredited practice.

Reagan, asked what he felt was the most vital factor in international relations, spoke of the importance of frankness and about a desire for peaceful solutions.

He went on to say that there had been "about 114 wars" since World War II, including conflicts between smaller nations.

"But I've often wondered, what if all of us in the world discovered that we were threatened by an outer — a power from outer space, from another planet."

"But I've often wondered, what if all of us in the world discovered that we were threatened by an outer — a power from outer space, from another planet," Reagan said;

"Wouldn't we all of a sudden find that we didn't have any differences between us at all, we were all human beings, citizens of the world, and wouldn't we come together to fight that particular threat?!" the president asked.

The president found an analogy in the threat of nuclear destruction.

"In a way, we have something of that kind today, mentioning nuclear

power again. We now have a weapon that can destroy the world, and why don't we recognize that threat more clearly and then come together with one aim in mind, how safely, sanely and quickly can we rid the world of this threat to our civilization and our existence?"

The comment drew applause from the audience, a nonpartisan group that specializes in foreign policy and national security issues, the National Strategy Forum.

As his next summit with Soviet leader Mikhail S. Gorbachev approaches, Reagan has been emphasizing the need for arms control in particular and for cooperation among nations in general.

In light of his past anti-Soviet rhetoric, he offered startling praise for Gorbachev during his speech Wednesday, saying the Soviet leader's reform programs are "of tremendous significance."

"It is my belief that there is hope for further change, hope that in the days ahead the Soviets will grant further recognition to the fundamental civil and political rights of all," Reagan said.

McDonnell Douglas Tops Pentagon List

McDonnell Douglas Corp. easily retained its position as the Pentagon's top research contractor last year, winning awards totaling almost \$2.9 billion, according to the Defense Department.

Martin Marietta Corp. ranked second for the second year in a row with contracts totaling \$2.03 billion, the Pentagon added.

Among educational and nonprofit entities, Massachusetts Institute of Technology continued to hold down the top ranking, winning research contracts during the year worth \$403.7 million. Aerospace Corp. of El Segundo, Calif., was close behind with contracts worth \$367 million, followed by Johns Hopkins University with \$353.9 million.

Overall, the Pentagon increased its

spending on research by just over 3 percent in fiscal 1988, with awards worth a total of \$22.5 billion. By contrast, the department spent \$21.8 billion on research in fiscal 1987.

A great deal of last year's spending appeared to be related to work on the "Star Wars" antimissile defense system. The amount of money invested in research on "missile and space systems" totaled \$7.8 billion in fiscal 1988, or 34.6 percent of the total, the Pentagon said.

Those numbers were little changed from fiscal 1987, when missile and space systems research consumed \$7.9 billion.

The second-ranked program category was research on aircraft. It consumed 22.4 percent of the total, or about \$5.1 billion.

The latest figures are contained in a statistical report prepared annually by the Pentagon to rank the top 500 companies or nonprofit groups per-

forming "research, development, test and evaluation" work. The rankings are based on a review of all contracts totaling \$25,000 or more awarded during the fiscal year that ended last Sept. 30.

McDonnell Douglas, which earlier this year also claimed the overall ranking as the nation's largest defense contractor, had climbed into the top spot for research work in fiscal 1987 when it displaced the Lockheed Corp.

It widened its lead in fiscal 1988, with two of its units ranking in the Top 10 on their own. McDonnell Douglas Aircraft held down first place with \$2.16 billion, while parent McDonnell Douglas Corp. received other contracts worth \$664 million and ranked in 8th place.

Other McDonnell Douglas subsidiaries received \$57 million in research contracts, giving the entire corporation its total of \$2.88 billion.

High-energy laser succeeds in key test

WASHINGTON — An experimental high-energy laser successfully shot down a supersonic missile in flight last week, a first-ever milestone that suggests warships can one day rely on such a defensive system, the Navy disclosed Friday.

The service, in a brief statement, said the classified test was conducted Feb. 23 at the White Sands, N.M., Missile Range using a laser that is being tested both by the Navy and the "Star Wars" program.

The test was an extremely important one, the Navy said, because "for the first time a high-energy laser system successfully engaged and destroyed a . . . missile flying low and fast in a cruise missile profile."

Never before had the laser been tested against a target flying faster than the speed of sound, the Navy added.

The laser "destroyed a supersonic missile in a test designed to show that a laser system could acquire, track and deposit enough energy on a supersonic target to destroy it," the Navy continued.
