

Spot the UFO

There has been a spate of unidentified flying objects sightings near Weston-super-Mare and a sky watch is to be held by the recently re-formed West Country UFO Research Association.

Association's president Ian Vinten, of Hutton Park, Weston, has reported a series of sightings of white lights in the sky during the Christmas holiday period.

"White lights have been seen between Bleadon Hill and the Mendips," he said.

"There were prominent sightings on Boxing Day at 4.15 pm and 7.15 pm, and we are appealing for more information about sightings in this area."

The West Country association were disbanded last year.

"We ran into financial difficulties," said Mr Vinten.

"The association are now re-formed with David Gibbs as vice-president.

"We will be organising a sky watch at Worlebury Hill and Bleadon Hill in the near future."
