# Cattle mutilations: Satanic cult is guilty

**THE TRUTH** behind mysterious, blood-curdling mutilations of cattle in the American Midwest has been uncovered at last.

Lawmen in Iowa believe that since 1968 a coven of satan worshippers has been responsible for the gruesome night-time slaughter of more than 8,000 head of cattle worth \$2.4 million.

And by an amazing coincidence, one of the world's top psychics, Simon Alexander, has come to the same conclusion about similar incidents in Alberta, Canada. He claims the cultists are led by a medical practitioner.

After seven cows were slaughtered in Iowa's Polk and Black Hawk Counties,

informants told the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigations (DCI) that satanists have hired Iowa medical school students.

"These students have the know-how and expertise to perform these mutilations," DCI chief investigator Gerald Shanahan told *The Globe*.

"We believe the sleeping cows were

stunned by a muscle relaxant or by a powerful burst of electricity from a cattle prod.

"The mutilators drained the blood out of the cow with a battery-powered pump much like the one used to embalm humans.

"Then they would cut off the genitals, the left ear, the left eye and the upper lip of the cow. Finally the satanists bore a 9-in. tube into the rectum of the cow to remove the entrails.

"Then the cultists would meet at an isolated farmhouse and there they would perform the Black Mass ceremony.

"One informant said these nuts actually ate the organs of the cow. The blood of the cow was used in a baptismal ceremony to initiate new members into the cult.

"In one place we thought someone had been murdered because the floor was covered with dried blood. But when we analyzed the blood it turned out to be from an animal."

Police are in the dark on cult members, but psychic Alexander, from Britain, says: "The guy who leads the cult is tall, thin, about 45-to-50 years old and writes books on the occult.

"The way to pinpoint him is that in the Midwest area where he lives, there were a lot of small pets missing, maybe 12 to 13 years ago."

To learn more about the cults, the police went to the main branch of the Des Moines public library to read books on satanism that might explain the meaning of the weird drawings.

They were astonished to find every volume on the subject had been checked out.

What frightens authorities most is the sickening possibility that the satanists might start sacrificing humans.

The Rev. Donald Glazier of the Christian Church in Cedar Rapids said one of his parishioners confessed to him that he belonged to the satanists.

Said Shanahan: "We understand he told the Reverend that to move up in the hierarchy of the cult you must eventually drain the blood out of a human being."

When the mutilations began 12 years ago, some cattlemen pinned the blame on aliens from outer space or some horrible animal predator.

"But the truth is that it's none of those outlandish theories," said Shanahan.

"These killings are clearly the work of sick human beings."
