

Family's space invaders puzzle

SPACE invaders may be more than just video games if a Middlesbrough family saw what they think they saw.

Mrs. Terry Adamson, her husband Keith and their 13-year-old son, Adrian, saw two strange lights hovering in the sky over Cleveland which they think were UFOs.
