

# UFO SIGHTINGS BAFFLE RAAF

PERTH — Four unidentified flying objects sighted over Perth between 8 a.m. and 11 a.m. on Thursday have the RAAF baffled.

The UFOs were seen by Mr. Graham Moyle, an air traffic controller at Perth Airport, and the Department of Transport confirmed they had been tracked on radar from a height of 24,000 feet to 60,000 feet.

Then they disappeared.

The administrative staff officer at Pearce Air Base, Wing Commander Ian Lindsay, said yesterday the RAAF had eliminated all sequences of events in its air space and could not account for the UFOs.

It also had sent up a Macchi jet after Perth Airport reported

the first of three visual sightings, but the pilot had seen nothing.

The Regional Director of Transport, Mr. Ellis Keil, said the silver tumbling discs had been tracked on radar at more than 24,000 ft. until they disappeared at more than 60,000 ft.

There were no balloons or aircraft in the area to explain the sightings.
