

'I am possessed by a being from beyond the sun'

JANE ALLYSON didn't believe in close encounters until she met Cytron — the leather-skinned man from the sun.

"I didn't believe in it until it happened to me," the 32-year-old New Yorker confessed.

"I was lying on the couch one night when all of a sudden I couldn't move. When I opened my eyes I saw Cytron," she told the Examiner.

Cytron had "very, very black alligator-like skin" on his hands, his face was smooth, and he wore a uniform and a tight, form-fitting cap "like an old flying helmet," Allyson recalled.

Now after two years and about 20 further encounters with Cytron, Allyson is a confirmed believer in spaceships and extraterrestrial visitors.

She says Cytron revealed to her that alien intelligences are coming to earth in numbers to keep mankind from blowing itself up with nuclear weapons.

Warning

"They are higher than we are and in a sense they feel like we're their children," Allyson explained.

"I believe it's a warning that we're on the verge of a crucial time in history."

Cytron has been seen by some of Allyson's friends, but does not always appear in the flesh. Sometimes he takes over Allyson's body



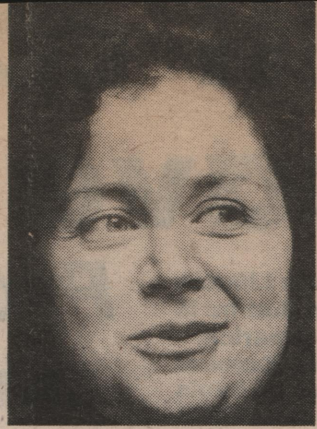
and speaks through her.

"It's very frightening," said Allyson. "The first time it happened I couldn't breathe and I felt I was going to die."

"Then someone else started to talk through me."

"It's a very unnerving experience. I'm glad when it's over," she added.

Cytron speaks very mechanically, without any sign of emotion, leading Allyson to suspect he may be a robot or an android programmed by higher creatures.

He is also gifted with future sight, and the predictions he makes are 90 percent accurate, says Allyson.

He saw that the world was going to be rocked by earthquakes and volcanoes, and forecast the eruption of Mount St. Helens and the end of the California drought.

Cytron also predicts that strange, pollution-related diseases will sweep the planet. On the happier side, he says there will be no winter this year, and that fall will continue right into summer.

Experience

Why did Cytron choose an unbeliever like Jane Allyson to relay his message to humanity?

"I've always been open to the idea that anything's possible," Allyson suggested.

"On the other hand, I never accept someone else's word for something. These are things you preferably have to experience for yourself."

She says that UFO sightings and contact with aliens have become so common "it's no longer a question of 'Do you believe they're real?' but 'Have you ever seen one?'"

Mystery remains

THE Nottingham UFO Investigation Society has released an interim report about a group of sightings in the Ashbourne area of Derbyshire in August, 1980.

Although the report has gone into every detail of the witnesses' reports, no conclusions have been reached.

The first sightings were observed from a camp site at Beresford Dale by two independent groups of witnesses who described the object as large, oval shaped and moving horizontally.

Others described it as being the size of a medium-sized air-craft flying at an estimated height of 1,500 ft.

Another sighting occurred at Shirley, Derbyshire, and was described by a witness as looking like a big jumbo-jet at close quarters with about a dozen lights around it.
