A RETIRED policeman has sighted a UFO similar to the one spotted recently hovering over Harlow.

Mr Ken Eittle of Alconbury, Bishop's Stortford, wrote to the Gazette after reading about the mystery square-shaped spaceship in our issue

two weeks ago. A motorist saw it on his way home to Harlow.

Mr Eittle says he spotted "exactly the described flying object" on the A120 road between Braintree and Dunmow.

He saw it moving eastwards at about 1,500 feet. And Mr Eittle, who also served in the Royal Naval Air Service, has never seen anything quite like it in his life.

He is convinced the flying object was neither an aircraft nor a satellite. He says it made no noise and had various coloured lights.

He spotted the UFO on Christmas Day, and can think of no logical explanation.

He adds that although it was the festive season when he sited the flying spaceship, it certainly wasn't alcohol that prompted the vision!
