A photographer from Los Angeles, Baron Nicholas von Poppen, supposedly spent days taking hundreds of photographs of a flying saucer and four dead occupants at an air force base.

The aliens he apparently described had pale faces, soft, child-like hands and wore shiny, black, one-piece outfits.

Poppen's films are said to have been taken from him at the end of each day,

THE bodies of aliens from outer space are being kept "on ice" in a closely-guarded vault, according to two writers.

A flying saucer is said to have crashed near Roswell, New Mexico, about 140 miles from the American border with Mexico, on July 2, 1947.

On board, say the authors, were six humanoids, about 4ft. tall, and all were killed.

The area was sealed off and the wreckage was taken to the Wright-Patterson US Air Force base in Ohio. The bodies and remains of the craft are said to be still there.

The claims are made by authors Charles Berlitz and William Moore in *The Roswell Incident* (Granada Publishing, £5.95).

They imply that other

bodies, also preserved in formaldehyde, were the victims of UFO crashes which happened after the Roswell incident.

According to Berlitz and Moore, American Air Force investigators have been called out to several flying saucer crashes.

Secret information on UFO activity over America is kept in military computers they say.

incident really happen, or was it all a hoax?

The authors allege that statements from witnesses and their families provide "rather convincing proof that this crash of a spaceship was definitely not a mass delusion but an actual event."

WITNESSES

One of the witnesses was said to be Barney

Barnett, a civil engineer engaged on field work.

He is said to have arrived at the site the morning after the crash and found "some sort of metallic, disc-shaped object between 25ft. and 35ft. across."

Barnett allegedly saw bodies lying around the craft. He described them as "like humans but they were not humans. The heads were round, the eyes

were small, and they had no hair. The eyes were oddly shaped.

"They were quite small by our standards and their heads were larger in proportion to their bodies than ours."
