

How to tackle a UFO.

What should you do if you spot a UFO? The current issue of *Police Box*, the North Yorkshire police magazine, gives you the drill.

Close you eyes, walk a few paces and open them again. then look long and hard at what you see. Take as many photographs as you can and at different apertures and speeds. Get UFO researchers to develop the film for you.

And tell the police — for only 10 per cent. of UFO spotters bother.

The advice comes from Mr.

Graham Birdsall, co-ordinator of Contact International, who recalls some of the UFOs seen over North Yorkshire.

The area around Darley and Brimham Rocks had several sightings in 1978, he records.

On one occasion, an object like a light bulb lit up the whole sky and made the hills visible. The glowing object then turned brilliant red for 20 seconds before racing off over Brimham Rocks.
