

# Police baffled by UFO death claim

POLICE admitted yesterday they had investigated the possibility that a man was frightened to death by visitors from outer space.

The day that miner Mr Zygmunt Adamski, 57, disappeared from his home in Tingley, Leeds, there were a number of reported UFO sightings in the area.

The body of ex-Polish soldier Mr Adamski was found five days later on waste land at Todmorden, Yorks—the same spot as some of the sightings.

There were mysterious burn marks on his face and neck. His widow Lottie said: "I can only think he was kidnapped and then tortured."

## Serious

Now police who have never closed their file on Mr Adamski admit they launched a serious investigation into the UFOs but could find no link between them and his death a year ago.

An inquest said he died from natural causes. Forensic experts could not explain the burns.

He had vanished while on a trip to his local shops for a bag of potatoes.
