# 'UFO killing' mystery is probed by police

**POLICE** launched an official probe into claims that aliens from outer space killed a man.

Unidentified flying objects were reported to have been seen around the Yorkshire town where the body was found.

And there were burns on the man's neck and head . . . which could not be explained by forensic scientists.

But the amazing inquiry was dropped when no connection could be established between the death and the sightings of the UFO spotters.

An inquest returned a verdict of "natural causes" on miner Zygmunt Adamski, 57, whose body was found on a tip at Todmorden. Mr Adamski, of Thornfield Crescent, Tingley, Leeds, vanished from his home five days before.

The inquest heard he suffered from angina. His widow Lottie believes he was kidnapped.

And West Yorkshire police say: "Our file on the case is still open."
