U F O s probe in mystery death

Top men ask for sightings help

TOP experts in UFO sightings are to start a hunt for witnesses to the "lost five days" of a man found dead in West Yorkshire.

After a special meeting in Leeds three leading figures in the UFO research world decided to co-ordinate their investigations into the disappearance of Mr. Zygmunt Jan Adamski, 57.

Mr. Adamski's body was found on a tip at Todmorden on June 11, five days after he went missing from his home in Tingley, Leeds.

A number of UFO sightings were reported in West

Yorkshire about that time, and several UFOs have been spotted since in the Baildon and Ben Rhydding areas.

Mr. Walter Reed of the British UFO Research Association told the Telegraph & Argus: "We are most anxious to contact anybody who saw either Mr. Adamski or a UFO in the five days leading up to June 11.

We cannot rule out the possibility that a UFO may in some way have been connected with the disappearance."

Associated with Mr. Reed in the search are Mr. Graham Birdsall, also of the British UFO Research Association, and Mr. Nigel Mortimer of the Northern UFO Network. Mr. Mortimer lives in Meagill Rise, Otley. Information can

be sent to Mr. Birdsall, telephone Leeds 484345.

Meanwhile, a mystery silver saucer-shaped object has been sighted hovering above Bradford city centre. It was spotted at lunchtime on Friday.

Two employment advisers are appealing for witnesses or anyone who can explain what the unidentified flying object was.

"We just hope there is a logical explanation," said Lilian Golding, 30, of The Lilacs, Guiseley.

"We are both quite sane, ordinary people. I have never even really thought about UFOs before.

"But this was incredible. Really strange. It has completely thrown us," she said.

She said she was working in the Job Centre, Provincial House, when colleague Wendy Leach called her to the window.

"There was this strange silvery object which seemed to be above the police station.

"We couldn't tell how big it was nor really how far away it was.

"It didn't have any windows, or wings or propellers and it wasn't a reflection or a balloon or helicopter.

"It hovered for a while, then plummeted and disappeared behind some buildings and we didn't see it rise again.

"We rang the police to see if they knew what it was but they didn't. It's just really strange.

"I'm mystified as to what it was. There must be some explanation so if anybody knows please let me know."
