POLICE IN A NEW UFO RIDDLE

A NEW "flying saucer" sighting has mystified a town's police — several of whom saw the unidentified flying object on two consecutive nights.

The latest in a series of 'close encounters' in West Yorkshire came in the town of Pontefract. Former RAF man Gordon Walker called the police when he saw a spherical silver object moving erratically through the sky. One policeman arrived, and after looking at the object through Gordon's high-powered binoculars he called in several other officers by radio to confirm the sighting.

The object was seen again in the sky the following night at the same time — 10-45 p.m. — by Mr Walker, his son, and another policeman.

Checks were made through Jodrell Bank, Manchester Airport and

the Bantry weather centre, but the UFO did not show up on radar screens.

Pontefract is 45 miles from Todmorden, the centre of a bizarre UFO riddle uncovered by the Sunday Mirror.

The body of Polish born miner Zyemunt Adamski, covered in strange burns, was found near the town.

And PC Alan Godfrey later underwent a session of hypnosis during which

he described a horrifying encounter with alien beings.

The new UFO sighting came on Monday, just a day after the Sunday Mirror printed an amazing report on

PC Godfrey's video taped interview.

Mr. Walker, 56, an Age Concern supervisor, said: "I saw a bright light, and it started to tilt and move upwards.

"I could see a kaleidoscopic coloured effect.

"It was surrounded by a red glow with blue and green lights.

"One policeman said he had been on night duty for 20 years and had never seen anything like it."
