

Green light in sky may have been rare meteor

OKLAHOMA CITY (AP) — A bright green light that streaked across the night-time sky may have been a rare “fire ball” meteor that landed in Oklahoma, a Texas astronomer said.

Two Fort Worth residents reported seeing the green light traveling north said Jonathan Wilkendorf, assistant director of the Nobel Planetarium in Fort Worth.

“One report stated that the green flash of light was like an explosion when it hit the ground,” Wilkendorf said. “The caller thought maybe it was an airplane crash.”

If the streak was in fact a meteor, it could have landed somewhere between Oklahoma City and Denton, Texas, Wilkendorf said.
