

IS SKEGNESS being observed by silent beings from another world?

Since the report of a UFO sighting by Marshall Adams in last week's Standard new information has come to light.

The Skegness police received another report of the UFO from Miss Birtles of Longhurst House, Roman Bank, and one woman, who wishes to remain anonymous came to The Standard office with news that she had also seen the UFO hovering over Wainfleet Road.

Skegness Coastguard Mr. Bernard O'Reilly probably had the best sighting of the mystery craft over the Derbyshire Miners' Holiday Centre. He confirmed the description given last week by Mr Adams that it was triangular but said

he had at first thought the object to have been Harrier jet.

However, the peculiar absence of sound from the craft on a night when there was only a light wind, coupled with the report from Squadron Leader Sam Curtis of RAF Wainfleet, that there were no aircraft out after 5 pm rules out the possibility that it was a jet from this area.

Mr O'Reilly also states that it was definitely not a weather balloon, and that it was flying no higher than an aeroplane would.
