

Mystery of UFO over Murdoch

Strange flashing lights gave a young couple a shock as they were driving home early today.

Neil Bezani (21) and his girlfriend Yvette (18) were driving home along South Street, Murdoch, about 3am when they saw what they claim was an Unidentified Flying Object.

"We both saw it hovering just above the pine trees near Murdoch University," said Mr Bezani. "As we drove closer, two bright lights seemed to be at one end of an elliptical ring of flashing lights, like a neon sign, with alternating globes going on and off, so the lights seemed to move around the ring. "I saw an orange-ish glow around a couple of wing shapes at the tail—the opposite end to where the two very

bright lights were—and there were coloured lights, blues, greens and red, flashing around the shape. "The object stopped for about 30 seconds, hovered over the pines, then flew off very fast, faster than a plane. "Yvette was scared and urged me to drive home straight away," he said. The operations room at the Perth Airport reported another unidentified aerial sighting (they do not use the

term UFO) in Girrawheen at 8.45pm yesterday, but the Coastal Surveillance Centre said it probably had been a flare. No planes were flying in the Murdoch area at the time of today's sighting. • Hundreds of people in Victoria last night reported seeing a glowing, brightly coloured object, streaking low over the State soon after 6pm.
