Occult, E.T., land here

Occultists 80 miles south of Mexico City are building an airport in preparation for the arrival of the first extraterrestrial beings on Earth.

Witches marked spots on the site on the slopes of Oriental Mountain where they said red lights would signal to spaceships from other galaxies.

The target completion date for the project is November, and an encounter of the "third kind" will occur sometime after that, said Antonio Vazquez Alva, president of the Mexican Futurology and Imagination Group.

Vazquez, who is overseeing construction, said the lights would help the spaceships land on top of the mountain and that the small airport also would serve as a center for natural medicine.
