## Up in the Sky — A Bird Plane ...

The sighting of a large glowing object in the skies over western Fairfield late Thursday night prompted several calls from concerned residents to the Fairfield Department of Public Safety.

The first reports of the UFO

came in about 10:15 p.m. Thursday, with callers indicating that the object was hovering over the Ash Court area, a Fairfield police spokesman said.

Police officers checking on the reports confirmed that there was some type of round, silvery object in the sky, but they were unable to identify it.

Several residents reported a large, glowing green object in the vicinity of East Travis Boulevard. Another caller described the airborne mystery as "big and glowing with blinking lights," po-

lice said.

A motorist on Interstate 80 who saw the UFO said she followed it along the freeway until it disappeared near Red Top Road in Cordelia. When initially contacted, Travis Air Force Base authorities said they had no knowledge of the flying object. They later began referring all calls to the California Highway Patrol.

The CHP, obligingly referred those calls back to Travis Air Force Base. As of midnight the glowing object was last seen traveling east from Tolenas area and had not yet been identified.
