Flying saucers warning of nuclear war, believer says

Flying saucers are more numerous than ever in the Earth's skies because "a greater intelligence" is trying to deter this planet from all-out nuclear war, according to a former Army colonel who has been in the forefront of the UFO movement for 36 years.

"More than 13 million people in the U.S. have seen them," said saucer specialist Wayne Aho, "but those who report Unidentified Flying Objects are often ridiculed, so many people don't tell what they see."

Aho was in Seattle yesterday arranging for the 21st annual convention of The New Age Foundation, which will be held in the Seattle Center's Nisqually Room today and Sunday from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.

He is founder and president of the foundation which, he said, is dedicated to recording flying saucer reports, and studying the nature of these "visits."

He said flying saucer reports were recorded in ancient writings — even the Bible. But the sightings increased greatly after the atom bombs were exploded at Nagasaki and Hiroshima, and they are increasing again.

"These so-called UFOs were involved in the Bible's parting of the Red Sea, the delivery of the 10 commandments to Moses, the "taking up" of the prophet Elijah, and

the ascension of Jesus who disappeared in a cloud," said Aho.

"And Christ will return in what we call a flying saucer," said Aho. Aho said the Bible and Roman writings referred to flying saucers as "host of heaven, wheel of Ezekiel, fiery chariots, and whirlwind clouds."

Aho insisted that the beings aboard the visiting space ships are sending messages in the form of thought communications with the minds of persons on earth.

"These messages are telling us to put away our nuclear weapons of war, or we will destroy our own planet," he said.
