**THE** annual skywatch by more than 100 UFO spotters will take place at Cradle Hill, near Warminster, on August 27.

In 1973 The British Unidentified Flying Objects Society studied local sightings and decided that August 27 was the most likely date for visits.

One of the best years for UFOs was 1981. Soldiers from nearby Battlesbury Barracks, Warminster, saw a large object shaped like a rugby ball glowing in the sky.
