

Official silence on UFO report

CIVIL SERVANTS were keeping quiet last night about reports that a UFO with three silver-suited aliens on board had landed in Suffolk.

The Ministry of Defence confirmed that details of a landing had been reported to it, but an official said he could not reveal the contents of the report. "It's a matter of confidentiality," he added.

A Sunday newspaper yesterday printed what it claimed to be a secret report from Lt. Col. Charles Halt, deputy commander of a USAF base at Brentwaters, Suffolk, describing how a mysterious

craft came to earth in a red ball of light at 3 a.m. on December 27, 1980.

About 200 military and civilian personnel, British and American, witnessed the events around a pine forest called Tangham Wood.

The UFO was said to be metallic with a pulsing red

light on top and a bank of blue lights underneath.

The MoD said: "The report is on file. The Ministry keeps these reports for statistical purposes, it does not act upon them."
