

'Oyster in the sky' seen as U.F.O.

AN OYSTER-shaped object which cruised over Bedhampton has sparked off UFO claims.

Two men contacted Havant police after the object passed directly over their house on Monday at about 6.50 a.m.

Engineer Mr. Roger Woods, of Winkton Close, said he and Mr. Frank Waters saw the object for a full five minutes before it swept overhead from Langstone and on to Waterlooville.

"It was travelling very slowly just above the dawn. It was very bright with five separate lights attached to it and it was coming head-on towards us," said Mr. Woods (51).

"It was about 2,000 ft. up and, being an engineer, I was interested in its design. In the end, it passed right over our heads."

"If you can picture two straight lines curved at the ends, that was it. It was like a cigar or an oyster shape; but it didn't make any noise."

Mr. Woods said: "I was intrigued. I'm sure someone else must have seen it — maybe a milkman or someone else."
