Strange old world . . . OYSTER IN THE SKY

THE MYSTERY of the Bedhampton UFO deepens. The "oyster" in the sky has also been sighted hovering over Hambledon.

Disabled man, Mr. Bernard Brown (56) is convinced "we are not alone" after following the progress of the strange airborne craft for 45 minutes.

He woke his wife Doreen at 5.15 a.m. and they watched as the object cruised overhead. "There were four or five lights or burners coming from it, and I would estimate it was more than 2,000ft. up," said Mr. Brown, of Old Barn Crescent.

Two Bedhampton men reported seeing the oyster-shaped object over their homes on Monday at about 6.50 a.m.
