

Lights puzzle

THE mystery of the "flying floodlight" deepens. The bright oval shaped light "as big as a floodlight" which was seen at 5.45 p.m.; on November 16 at Clayton Heights, was also spotted, quite independently, by Mrs. Jean E. Gibson of Bullroyd Drive, Bradford.

She saw it at 5.43 p.m., about 150ft. to 200ft. high, hanging over the ground at Arctic Parade, Great Horton Road. It was visible for about a minute and she estimates that it was two thirds larger than the Scholemoor Playing fields floodlights, which were switched on at the time.

"I was puzzled, wondering what it could be," she says. "I watched it glow and pulse, then all at once the light got smaller as it moved south, then it disappeared."

Mr. Graham Townsend of the Yorkshire UFO Society tells me that there have been two other sightings this year of strange aerial objects at Clayton and Horton Bank Top, one described as a large orange red oval, rotating, with three smaller white objects nearby, and the other a black, grey blue ball which rotated as it moved.
