# 'Snooker triangle' in the night sky

FURTHER to Mr A C Prior's letter (January 9) headed Pink Triangle In The Morning Sky, I should like to add that I also saw an unidentifiable triangular flying object although this was at about 8.30 pm on the following day — Wednesday, January 4.

I was walking through the Kingsdown area of Bristol when I noticed approximately 10 to 12 dim lights moving through the night sky in the formation of which I can only describe as being something like a snooker triangle.

It was impossible for me to guess the height of the object(s) but I would estimate that it was no farther than a couple of hundred yards although, of course, that is only the impression I was given.

## Silent

The object was totally silent and changed its course of direction quite suddenly.

Having already told a number of people that I had watched an unusual triangular object for about half a minute I am relieved that Mr Prior's description matches so closely.

My only difference in observation was that I had the impression that the lights were of a dull silvery sheen — rather like that of a star.
