

Pupils' mystery UFO is a 'Wok-it'

An unidentified flying object which landed by the playing fields of a West Sussex school has puzzled experts.

Pupils at Wisborough Green School saw the object parachute out of the sky and ran over to discover a mysterious round aluminium ball the size of a pumpkin. Inside was a black polythene wrapper sealed with sticky tape.

"We thought at first it was some sort of weather

balloon," said headmaster, Roger Clark. "But the Met. office denied it was one of theirs.

Because the UFO looks a bit like a Chinese wok, it has been nick-named the "Wisborough Wok-it."

British Aerospace took the UFO away for "identification purposes." They later said it did not belong to them and returned it to the school. Pupils are now watching for Martian invaders.
