Official help for the great UFO hunt

UFO watchers will soon have some official help in discovering more about those strange lights in the sky.

The Ministry of Defence's reports of unexplained phenomena are to be declassified and released to the public.

The move means a lot to the British UFO Research Association which has been fighting for access to Ministry records for years.

The association has already received details of eight sightings in South Wales but has been unable to get any help over an incident in 1980 when a large triangular object was seen in a forest near RAF Woodbridge in Suffolk leaving holes in the ground and traces of radiation.
