## UFO lights up sky

LOUISVILLE, Ky. (AP) — An object looking like “a ball of fire with streaks of blue and red” streaked across the night sky, prompting hundreds of frightened phone calls to police, radio stations, airports and the National Weather Service.

One caller told state police that the bright light at about 10 p.m. Sunday was a jet plane on fire. A nervous man in Bardstown claimed the Soviets were invading or a space ship was landing on Earth.

But a forecaster at the National Weather Service in Louisville said it probably was a meteor, based on the descriptions. No one at the weather station saw the object, said the forecaster.

Some people reported the object looked like a “ball of fire with streaks of blue and red,” said state police dispatcher Jack Lewis at the Elizabethtown post.
