

Giant UFO Buzzes Pennsylvania Town

In astonishing UFO sightings, three Pennsylvania residents reported seeing a huge craft silently hovering overhead — and almost a dozen homes had their TV reception cut at the very moment that two of the sightings took place.

What's more, a voice analysis "truth detector" used on each of the three witnesses absolutely ruled out deception!

The most spectacular of the eerie sightings began just after dark on October 23

near Tyrone, Pa. Skip Morrissey, a 37-year-old reservoir maintenance worker, was out looking for deer on a secluded mountainside.

"I saw an object coming down across the valley, from the northeast, at about tree-top level," Morrissey told **The ENQUIRER**.

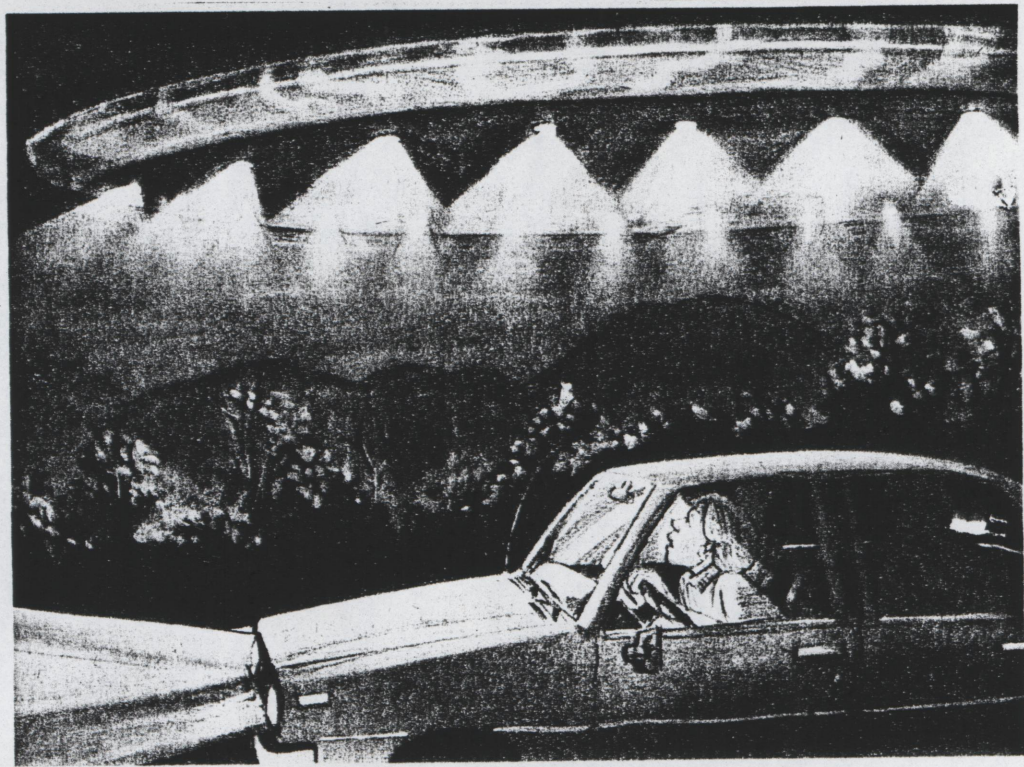
"I realized it didn't have the kind of lights a plane has. On the bottom the lights were amber — and on top they were red, going completely around the craft.

"The thing was shaped like a circle, and was so big it could fill a whole football field.

"It didn't stop. I'd say it was going about 40 m.p.h. It went over behind the hill, and couldn't be seen anymore. I went back to my house and called the police."

At about the same time and nine miles away, the wife of a bank vice president was driving home from a school committee meeting.

"I was coming up a hill,

and saw flashing lights in the air," said the woman, who asked not to be identified. "It was a craft, but it wasn't moving.

"I was almost under it. The flashing lights were very, very bright, but I could detect a dark mass — a rounded shape, about the length of two large airplanes.

"There was no noise. It just hovered. After about two minutes, I turned off on a dirt road to head home."

Nearby, people were having TV reception problems

at that very time, area residents say. In fact, up to a dozen homes were simultaneously left with no TV picture for about four minutes.

But that wasn't the first report of a UFO appearance in the area. About two weeks earlier, Sonia Musso, 45, a motel dining room employee, said she was driving to work when she spotted a massive silver UFO shining in the early morning darkness.

The **ENQUIRER** asked Charles McQuiston, a code-

veloper of the Psychological Stress Evaluator (PSE) truth-detecting device, to analyze tapes of UFO descriptions made by all three witnesses.

"Each and every one of them is telling the truth about what they saw," McQuiston said.

Added John Bowser, a retired Pennsylvania Bureau of Aviation official who helped police investigate the sightings, "Skip Morrissey, who spotted the UFO, is reliable.

"I'd never discount that it was a UFO!"
