Local woman organizes UFO conference

The North Shore will play host to the first National UFO Information Week this August, according to organizer Marge Christensen of Beverly, a high school English teacher and public relations director for the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON).

The kick-off event, at the Beverly Golf and Tennis Club, is a two-day UFO Forum which will feature

some of the leading scientists and UFO researchers in the United States, including Dr. J. Allen Hynek, Professor Emeritus, former head of the astronomy department at Northwestern University and founder of the Center for UFO Studies in Phoenix, Arizona.

This forum, on August 17 and 18, is already drawing registrations
