

# HUGE BLIMP-LIKE SPACE CREATURES FOUND ON EARTH!

A herd of space animals, the size and shape of the Goodyear blimp, grazed for three hours on cattle pastures near the remote Argentine ranching settlement of Villa Iruya.

The alien animals, appearing semitransparent and resembling "gigantic bags of gas" according to several witnesses, soared into the sky and slowly vanished from sight when they had finished their browsing.
