Alien UFO base found on moon

A Soviet space probe has spotted a city complete with a UFO base and tall, strangely-designed buildings on the dark side of the moon, according to a Swedish scientific journal.

Kremlin leaders are trying to hush up the startling discovery until they can analyze the photos and other data they have collected, sources say.

But the Swedish magazine, *Leydn*, says thousands of photos taken by the space probe were transmitted to a Russian space station.

Launch

The photos graphically depict a city of tall buildings of a "strange architectural design," says an insider.

"Nobody knows who lives in the city, or anything about this outer space civilization, until one of the photo TV shots showed a UFO taking off from what appears to be a launch pad," he adds.

"This is apparently a base on the moon's dark side, staffed by some outer

space civilization using UFOs, and which may serve as a UFO base for a society that dispatches them all over the Earth."

Dr. Adam Suznovic, an expert on Soviet affairs who divides his time between Moscow, Paris, and New York, says the Russians have apparently made a "major discovery" on the lunar surface and are very excited about their find.

He adds, "The Soviets are curious about the source and function of this strange base on the moon."

"They are looking at it closely with their space probe and are considering sending in an expeditionary force."

The Kremlin refuses to comment on the reported sighting.

"This is the biggest space story since the lunar landing," says Dr. Abraham Wills, editor of the Soviet space journal, *Outer Limits*.

"The Russian government is having problems deciding how to handle it."

Suspicious

"They want credit for the discovery, but are afraid to tell the rest of the world what they've found."

"Soviets are very suspicious of other nations. They don't want to share their knowledge with anyone."

The Russian space probe, known as *Gorky 1*, was able to send back more than 2,000 laser photos of the city, which is circled by a giant wall, says Dr. Suznovic.

The unmanned Soviet spacecraft has been on its mission since launched by powerful rockets last Jan. 14, say space experts.

Although Soviet officials refuse to comment on the

mission, international sources say the Russians were embarrassed by the U.S. lunar landing and other space successes and want to achieve a space 'first' designed to put the Russians ahead of the U.S.

Reveal

Sources who have seen the Russian photos say they are remarkable in their clarity and what they reveal.

"The pictures are unbelievable," claims Suznovic.

"They can show clearly an object the size of a golf ball and even the writing on the ball."



The buildings are reportedly visually exciting, "with dramatic soaring lines and planes."

"The base appears large enough to hold up to 1,000 alien creatures."

"The Soviets, and everyone who has seen these amazing photos, are crazy

to learn what advanced technology was used to build, and may be contained within, these unique structures."

An inside source with the U.S. space program says, "It's possible the Russians have found something on the moon."
