UFO OR NO? — Apparently, Sandra Downing isn't the only one who saw a strange light in the sky on last Tuesday night. Sherry Watson and her husband, M. Sgt. Clifford Watson, also saw a pinkish or light orange light in the sky.

On Friday, a Killeen Daily Herald article told about the sighting. Downing, a local realtor, said, "It looked like a slow-moving satellite with a cloud moving along with it. It was way off in the eastern sky and was sort of a pinkish red."

Sherry Watson said the light had no form or substance to it. It looked like a sheer piece of material, like chiffon, with a light behind it. The Watsons saw the light through a telescope they had purchased for viewing Halley's Comet.

She said the light floated slowly — from south to north — in the eastern sky for five or six minutes and then just faded away.

"It's like nothing I have ever seen," Mrs. Watson said.
