

Astonished police witness starship's awesome power!

Police responding to an emergency call watched in stunned horror as the town they had come to assist glowed an eerie orange — and vanished before their eyes!

Three officers assigned to the provincial police in Chichiang, China, reported that the village of Wufeng disappeared from the face of the earth along with its inhabitants, domestic animals and even its plants, according to an account in the *Kweichow People's Press*.

"There was nothing but bare rock and soil there," officer Su Piao said in a report on the bizarre phenomenon.

"Where there were once 752 people there was nobody. The site where the village stood is stripped of every building and every living thing."

Although the government of the People's Republic of China has moved quickly to seal off the area and put an end to news reports of the event, early publicity paints a terrifying picture of events leading up to the mysterious disappearance of the village.

According to these accounts,

police in Chichiang reported receiving an emergency call from the head of the Revolutionary Committee of Wufeng, the local government body that ran the small town.

The official, Chairman Fang Ulanfu, appeared very upset and demanded immediate assistance.

"He said blinding white lights had descended from the sky and hovered over his village," a dispatcher recalled.

"The lights were powerful and appeared to be something man-made, not natural. He was very frightened and asked for a large force of officers to come quickly with heavy weapons."

The dispatcher sent three officers — Su Piao and two subordi-

nates — to the village. They made the 20-mile drive in less than a half hour, police say.

During that time, Chairman Fang called twice sounding more and more upset each time. He said a large black cylindrical object could be seen behind the lights and that he thought this object, which hovered in the air, was some type of airship or spacecraft.

"Later he said the lights were even more numerous and that the villagers had assembled together and were waiting for help," the dispatcher said.

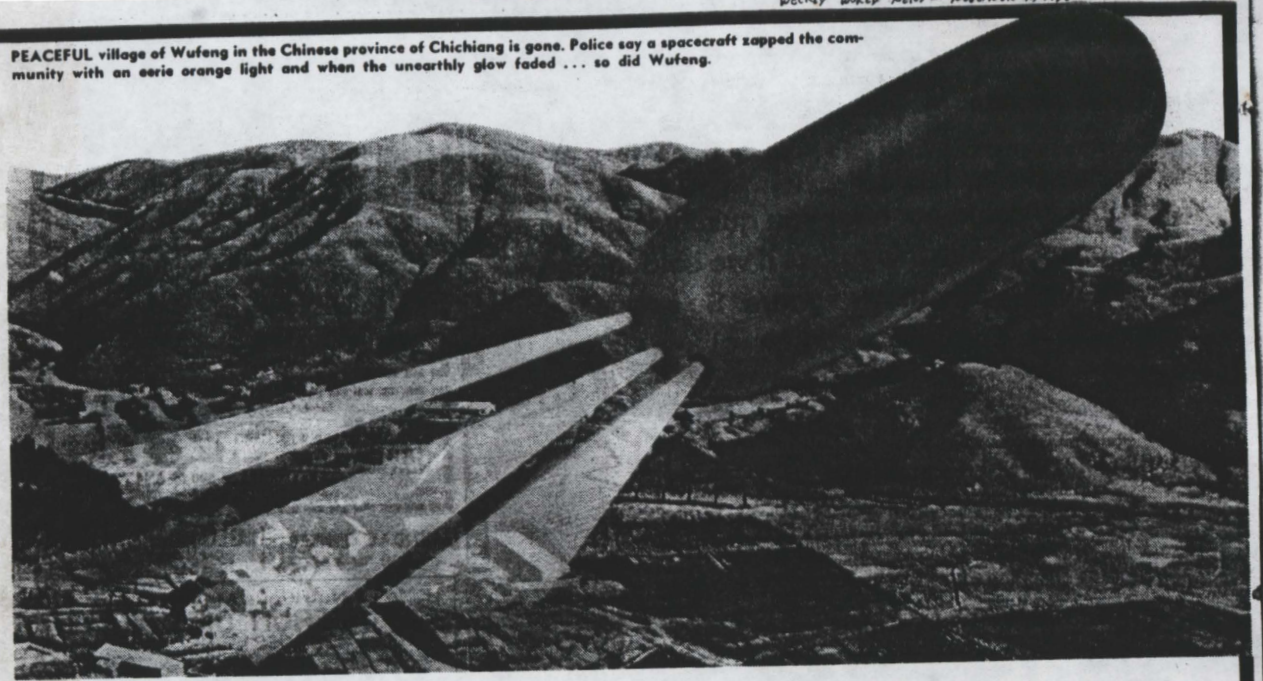
Officer Piao and his party arrived at 10:34 p.m., according to later reports, topping a ridge near the mountain town that offered a view of Wufeng below. Almost im-

mediately they saw the buildings of the village light up with a blinding orange glow.

The officers watched, stunned, as the glow increased and then gradually faded — leaving an

inky black nothingness in its place.

"We heard nothing," Officer Piao said in his official report.

"We saw nothing but the glowing light. We rushed down there but by the time we arrived everything was gone.

"We were sent to investigate UFO activity — we didn't expect to see the entire village disappear before our eyes!"

The Chinese government has refused comment on the incidents and news from the area has been censored, according to foreign correspondents in Peking and Hong Kong.
