

Dial-a-UFO

Are UFO reports suppressed from the public? Many people believe they are. Others would believe that these reports are best suppressed because of their doubtful status. Now you can be the judge. Dial (213)-976-UFOs to contact the UFO hotline for a daily report of UFO sightings. During the week that this review was written, the recorded message concerned a transcript of a transmission from an extra-terrestrial people from the planet Umo. Since 1950 they have visited our planet to conduct research on the life here and its probable future. A

subsequent day's recorded message concerned the nature of the Umities' spaceship. Its outer surface is composed of an intelligent material, where all molecules

are in communication with each other. As a result, it can open up to admit a boarder, then close up again. The report indicated that pieces of a strange, "organic metal" had been found at certain sighting locations, perhaps corresponding to the Umities spaceship's covering. At the end of the recording, another phone number is given to order a copy of the written transcript of the day's broadcast. According to a report by A. J. S. Rayl in the October 1986 issue of *Omni*, this hotline was started by two Los Angeles residents, Paul Sheperd and Rusty Weaver, a businessman-musician team, who wanted to provide public access to the wide variety of UFO "information."
