

Amazing proof that we are not alone!

A Soviet space probe photographed the foil-clad body of a dead extraterrestrial as they passed within 75 feet of each other in deep space, a leading astrophysicist reports.

In a letter to the Yugoslavian science journal *Universe*, Dr. Tomislav Zivkovic said the silvery 6-foot object shot by the top secret craft last summer but was not positively identified until December.

Photographs of the object are blurry and ill-defined, he said. But computer enhancement clearly shows the helmeted object to be wrapped in foil and man-like in form.

"The actual key to iden-

tification is a series of military insignias and decorations on the corpse's arms and chest," said the expert.

"They are bluish black and look like starbursts. The corpse is also wearing a large helmet with tubes leading from front to back. The undeniable implication is that the alien was a starship officer who died and was buried with full honors in space.

"The thing we will never know, of course, is where the alien came from and how long the body had been traveling through the void.

"It could have been ejected the day before it was photographed — or 100,000 years ago, when cavemen were still walking the earth."

Soviet officials would neither confirm nor deny Dr. Zivkovic's report but they did ac-

knowledge that he worked closely with Soviet scientists "on a space-related project"

last fall. According to Dr. Zivkovic, that project was the analysis of more than 75 photographs the Soviet space probe took of the space-borne corpse before it drifted out of range and vanished into the emptiness of space.

"These photographs are a dramatic development in man's exploration of space," said the expert. "If nothing else they are yet more solid proof that alien civilizations do exist."

Although the Soviet officials have been mum about

the photos to date, at least one observer believes they might make some of them public later this year.

Edward Landeau, a leading Soviet newspaper analyst, said a four paragraph story that recently appeared in the *Moscow Truth* newspaper suggested that the Soviets had indeed found something of staggering importance in space.

"The article was couched in typical Soviet double-speak," said the Paris-based expert. "But it alluded to an extraterrestrial life-form and said more information was expected to be available by late May.

"Exactly what that means I don't know. But it's certainly possible that they intend to confirm and possibly elaborate on the Zivkovic report."
